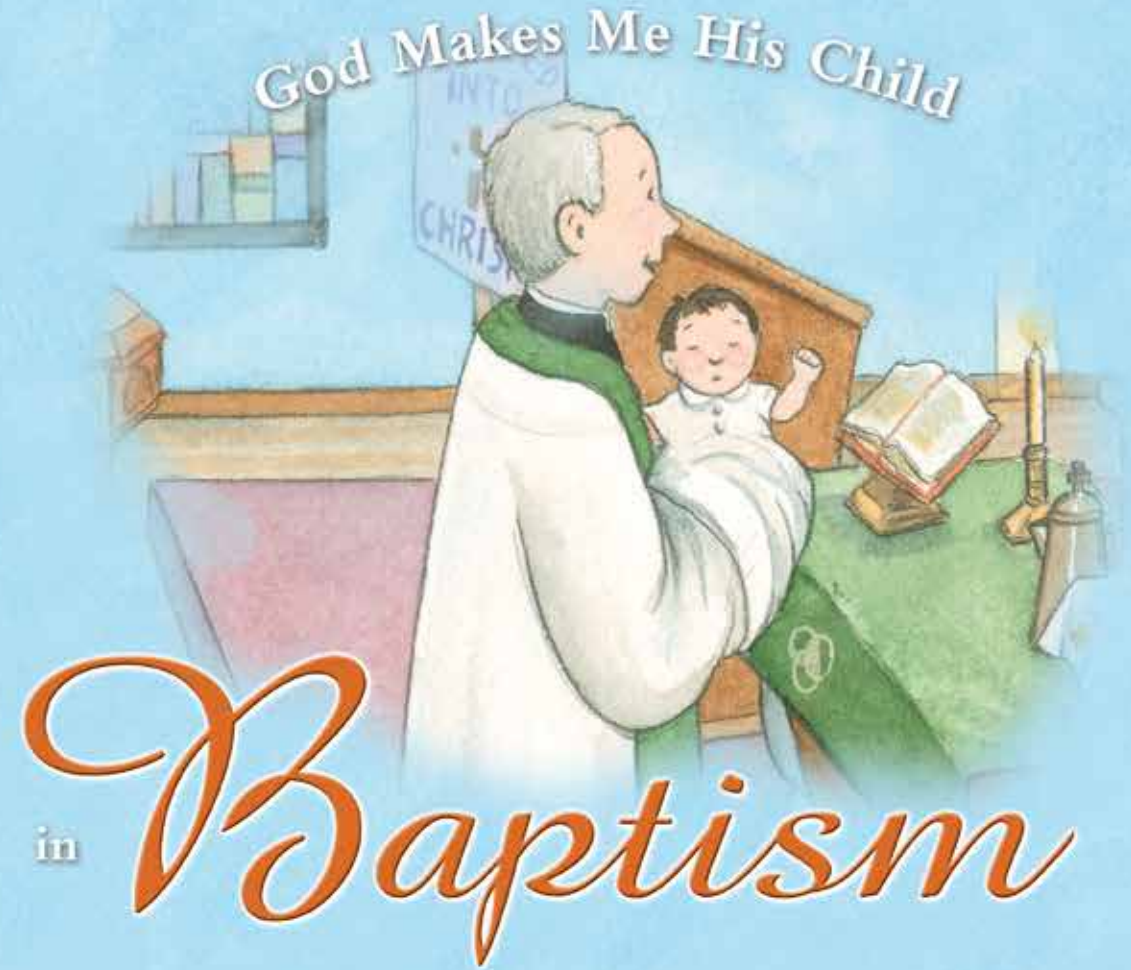

Dad is calling. "It's time to go, now."

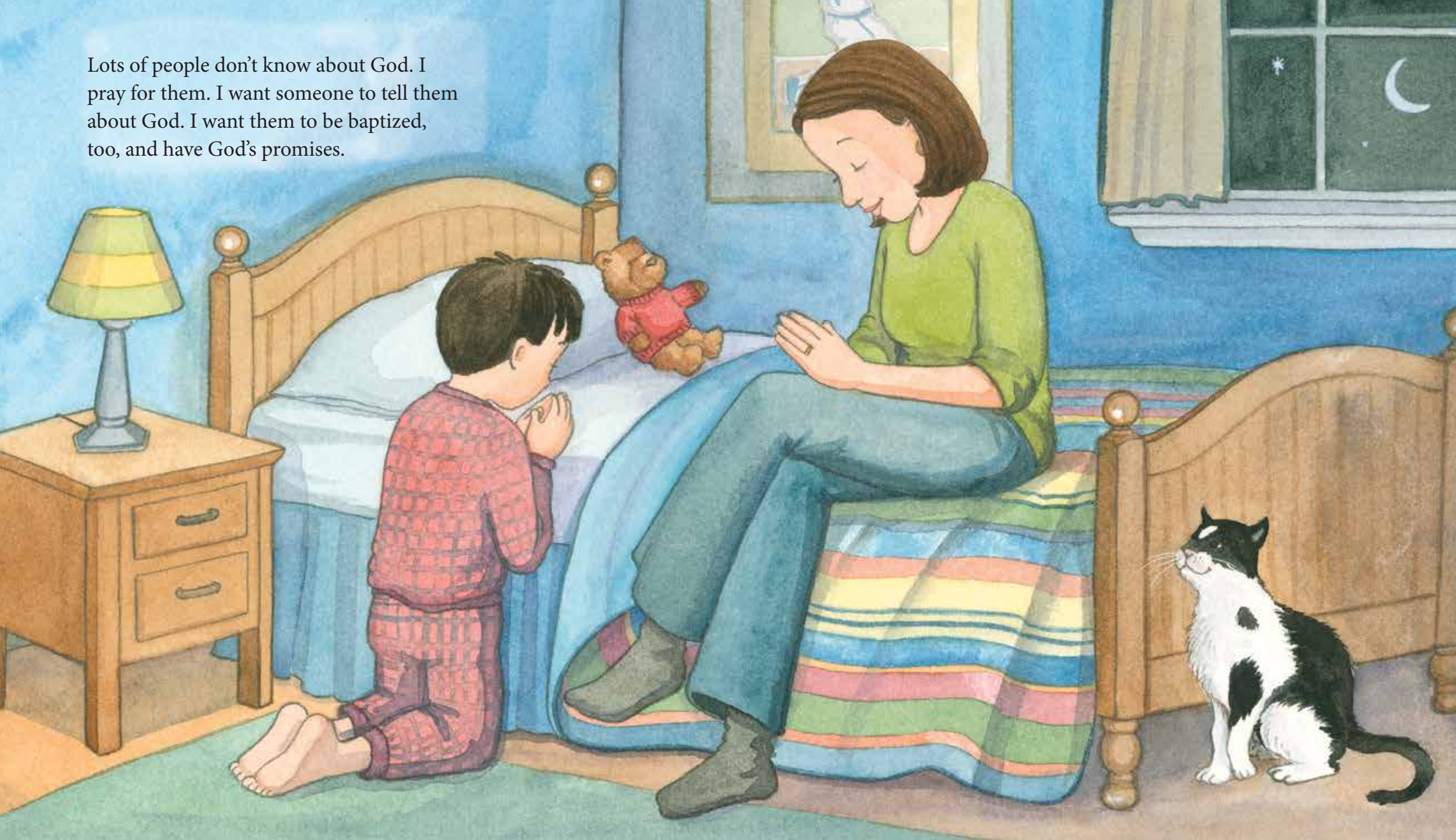
Today is a special Sunday. Today, my baby cousin, John, is going to be baptized.

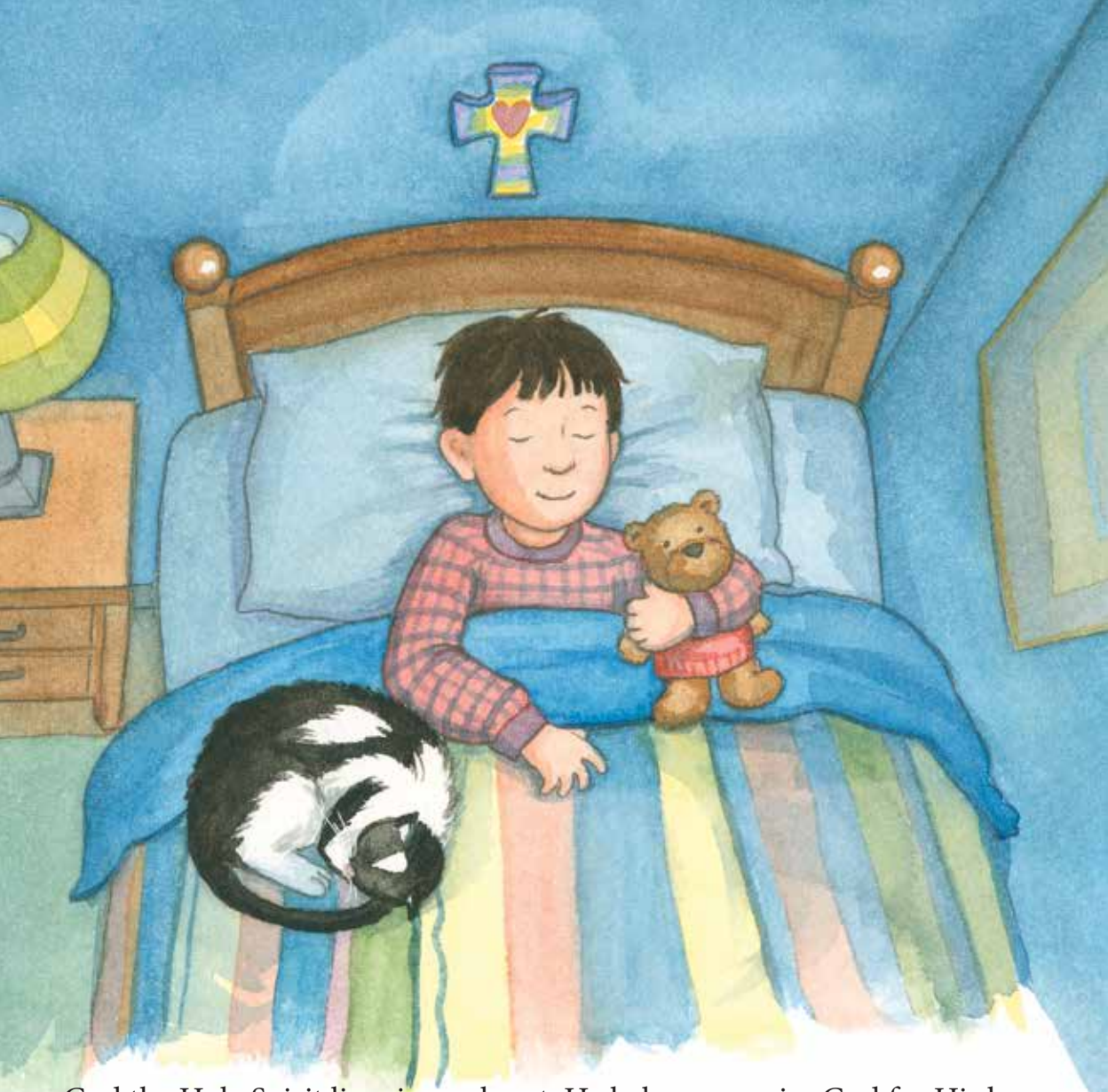


But I am sorry for my sin.
