Luke 22:7–71 for Children

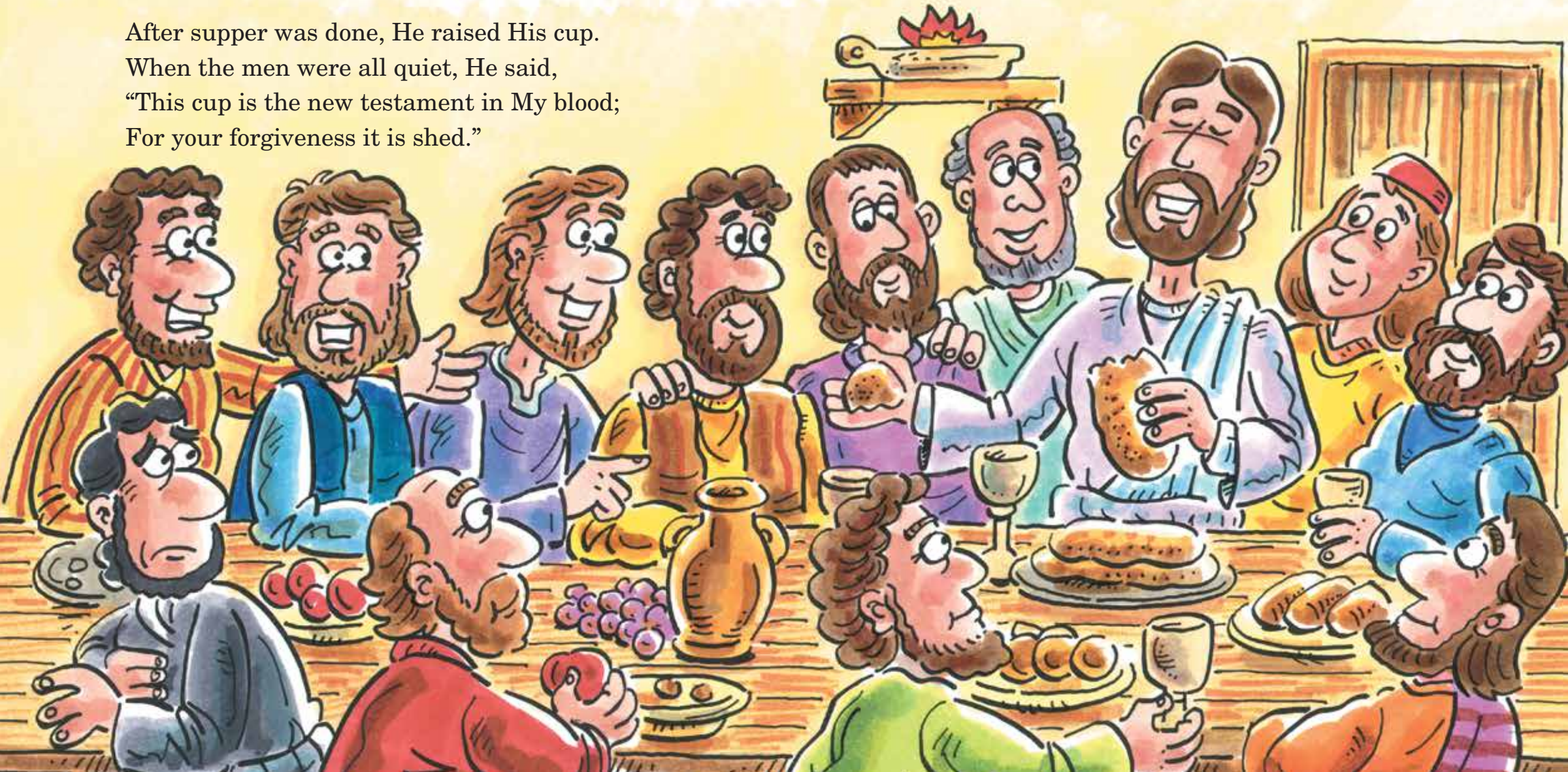
