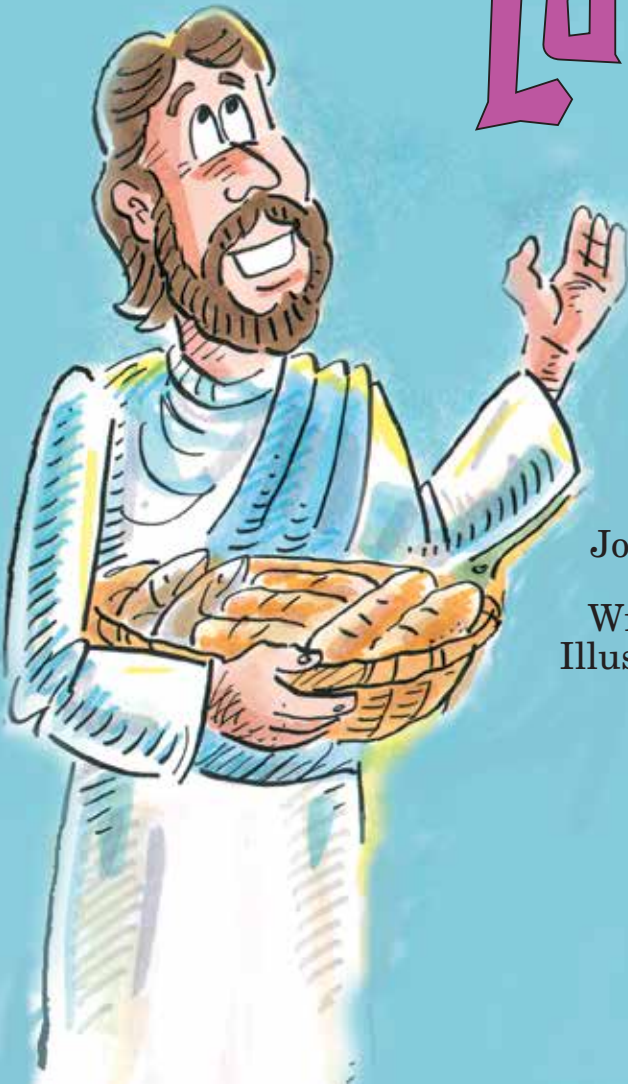

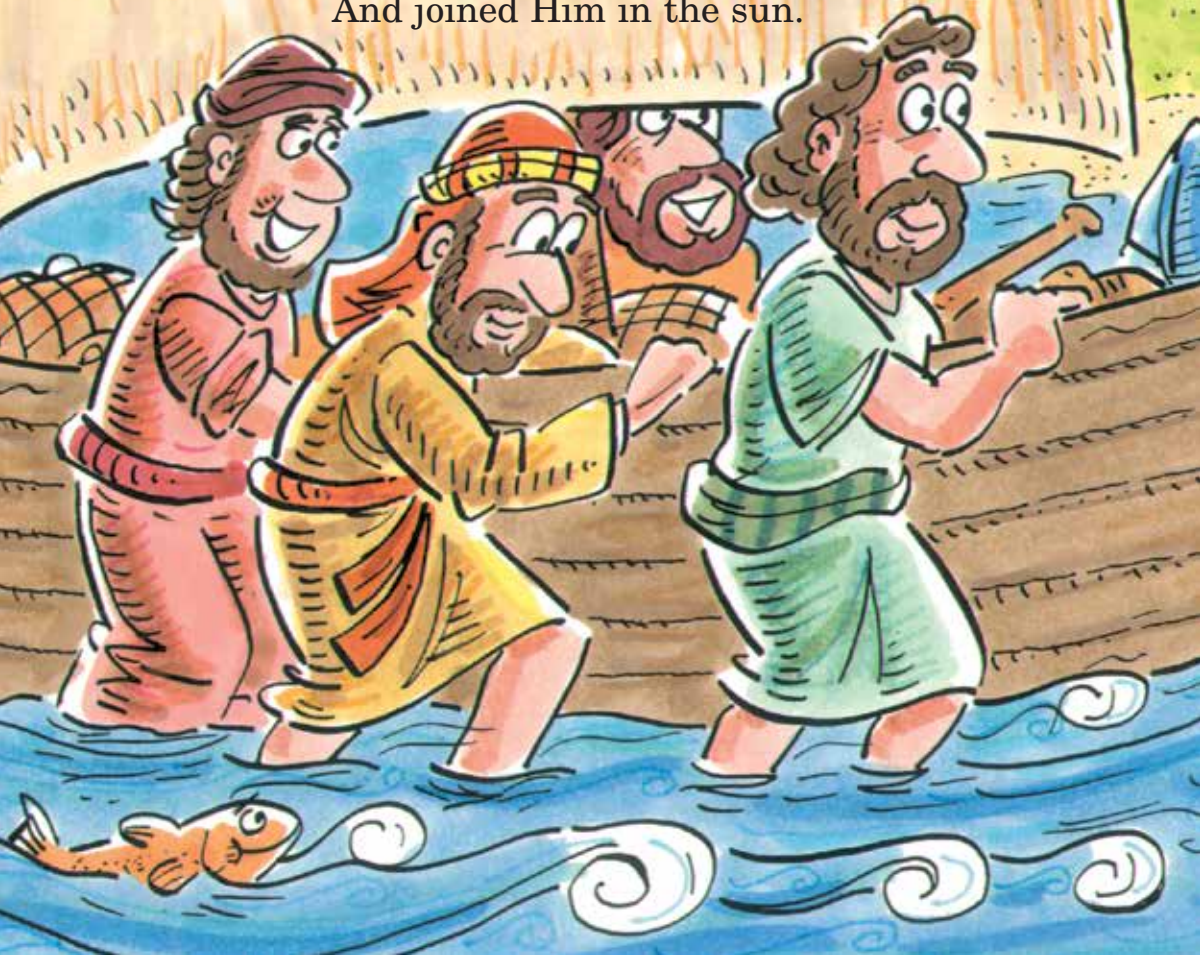

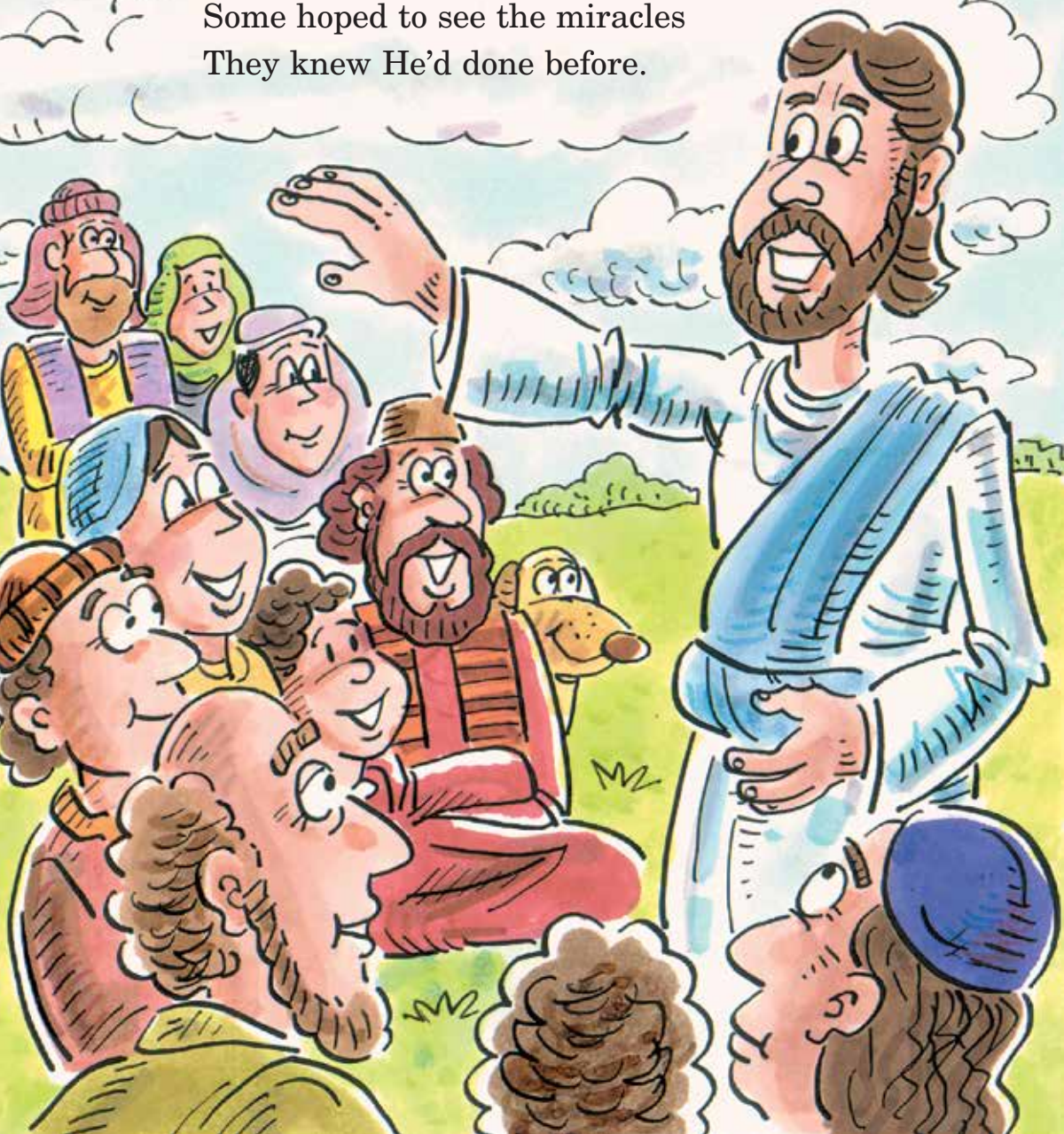
Jesus and His followers

And climbed the mountainside.

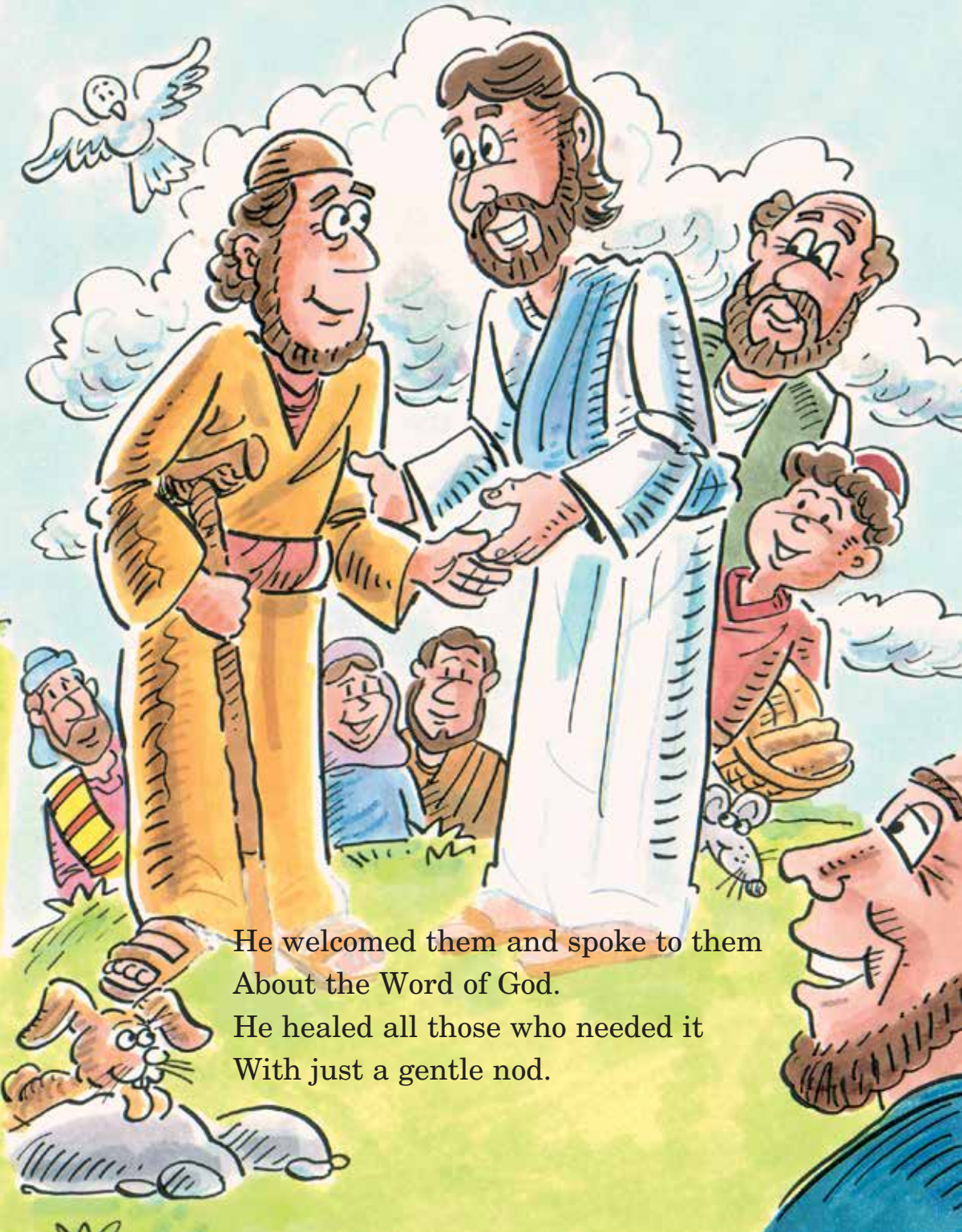
Jesus would have liked to rest

And joined Him in the sun.





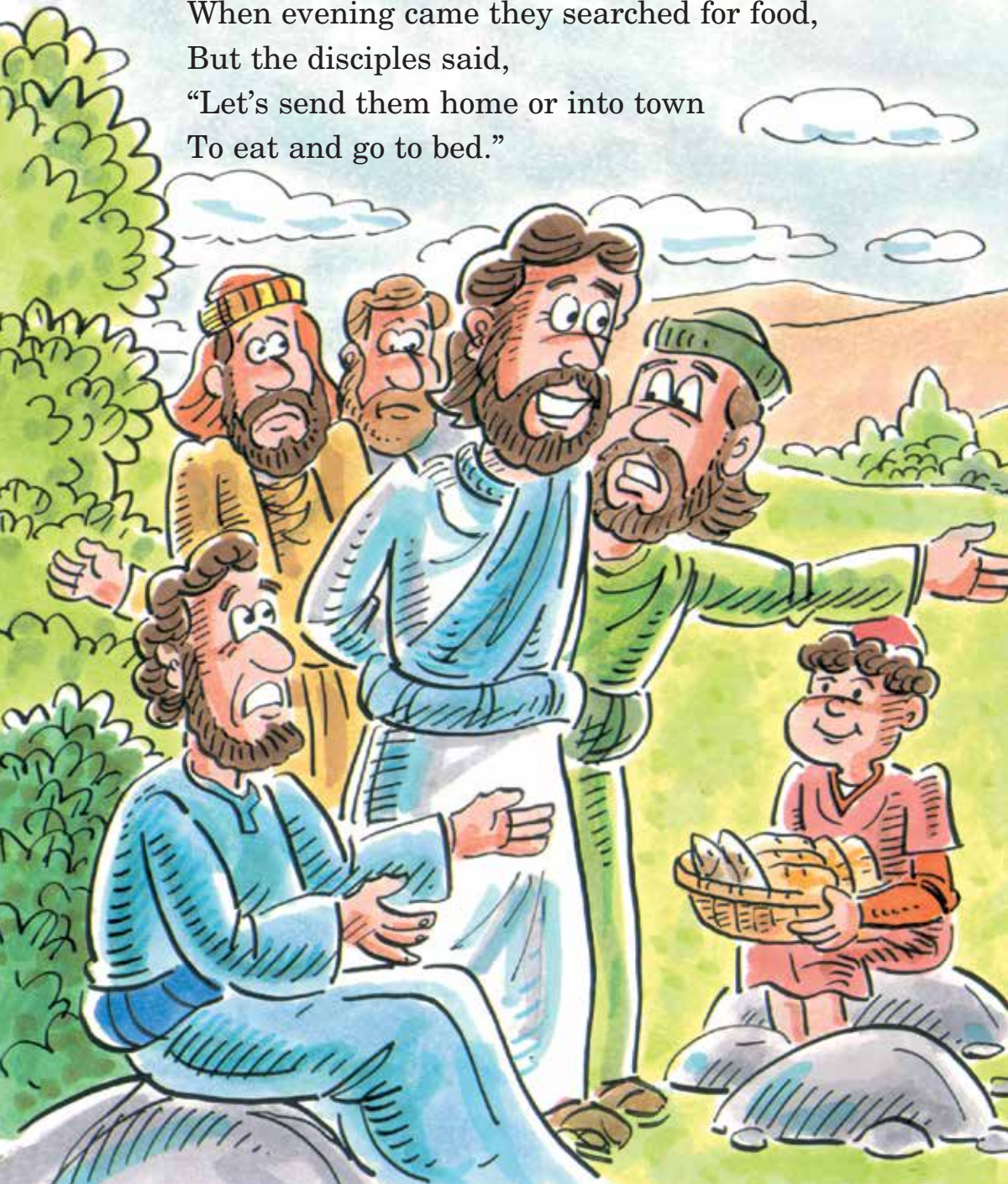
The people loved to hear Him preach.
