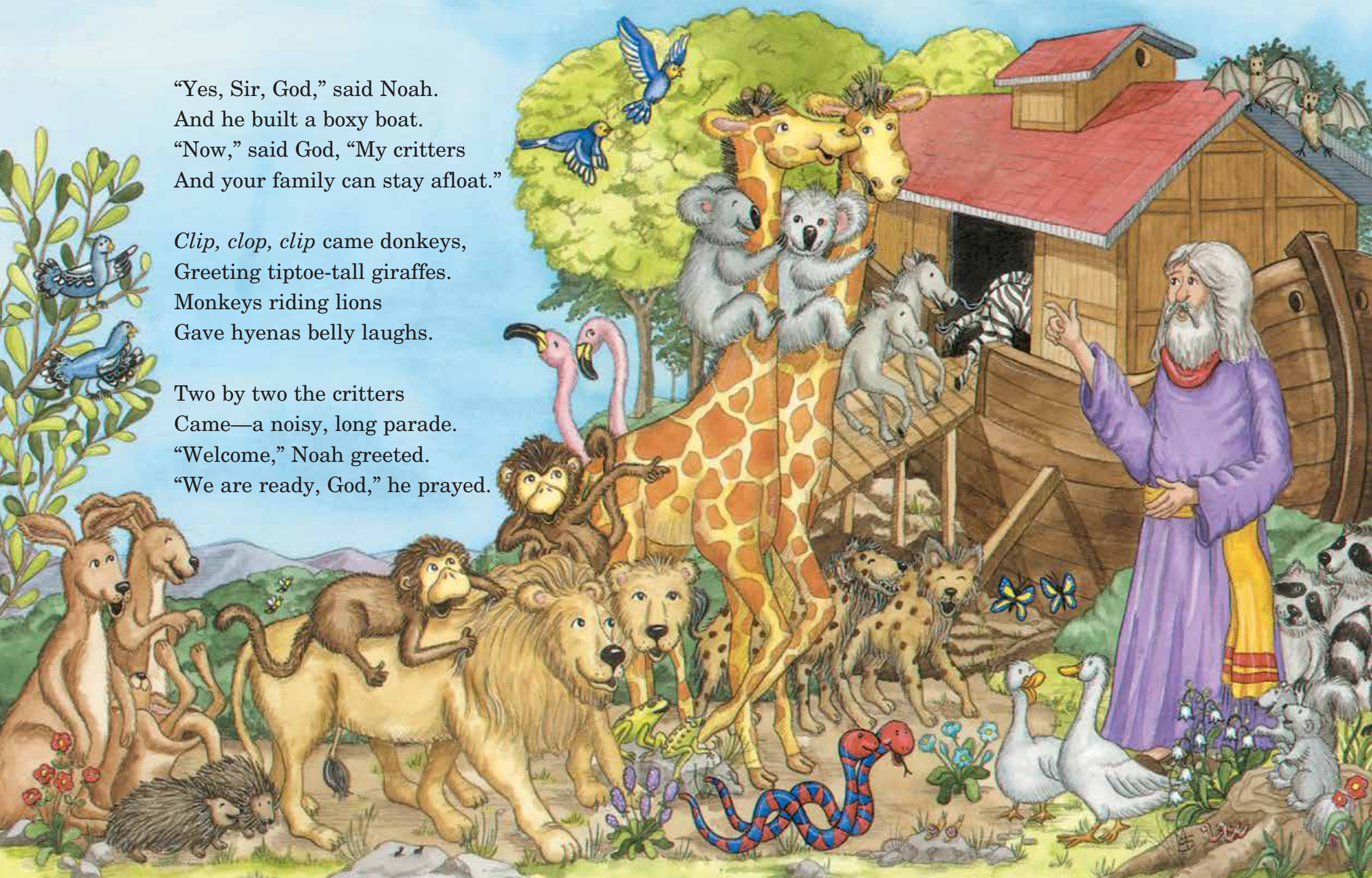

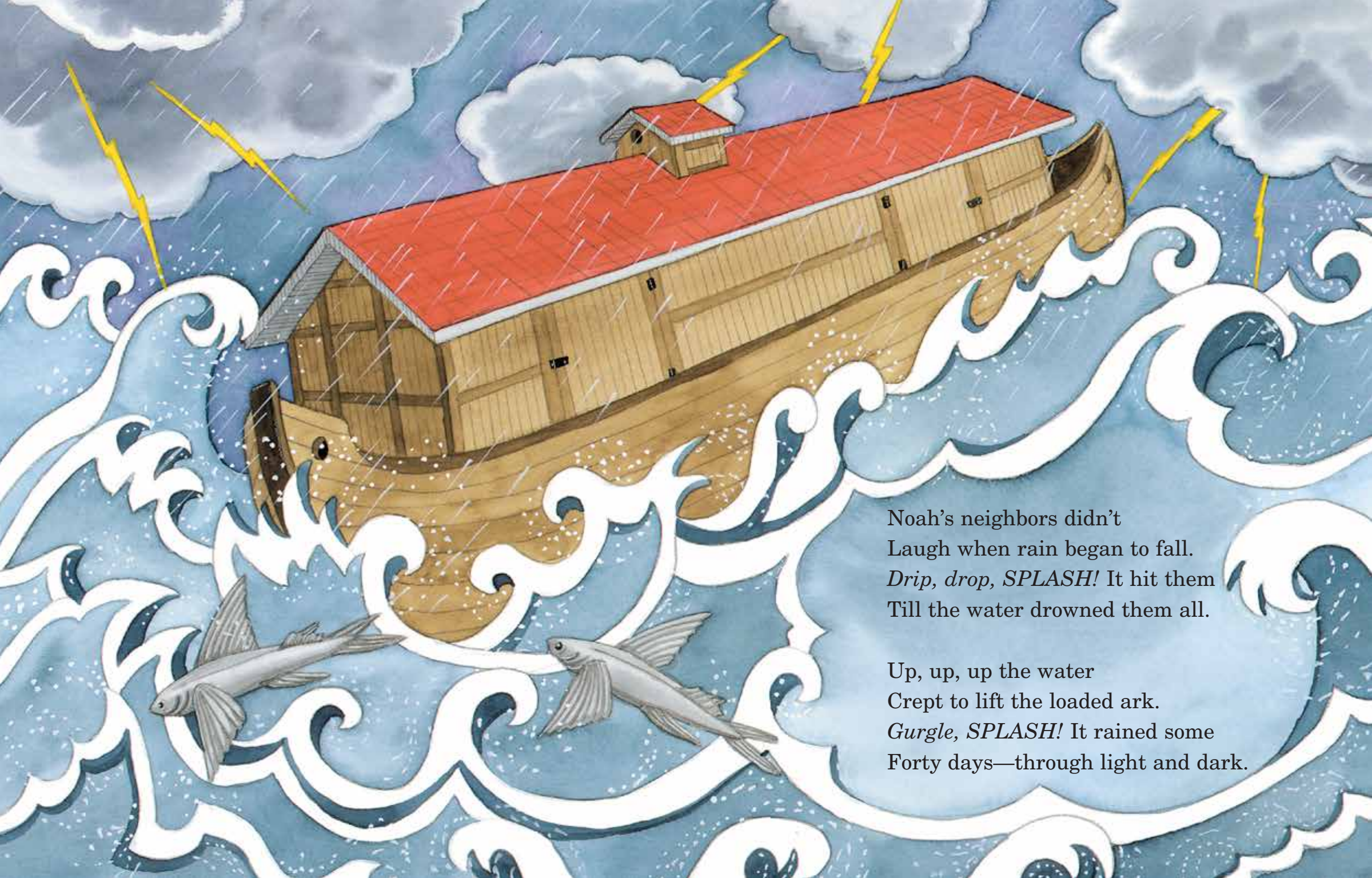


“Yes, Sir, God,” said Noah.
