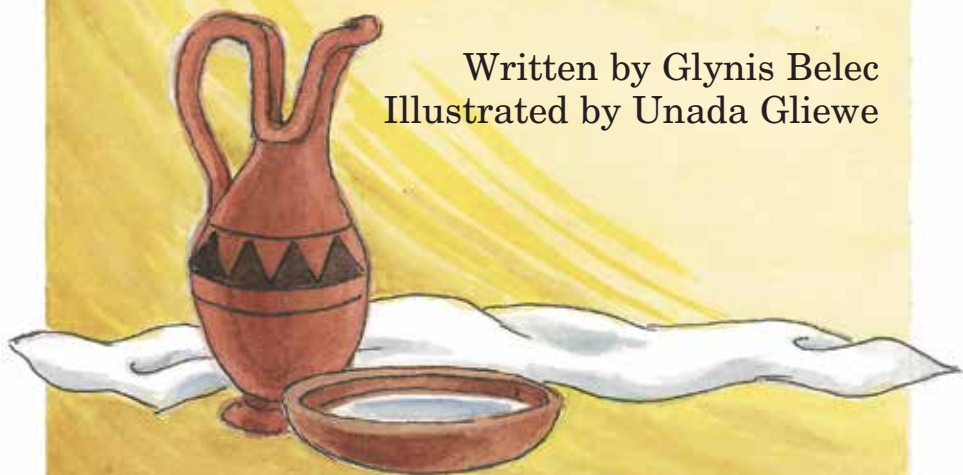
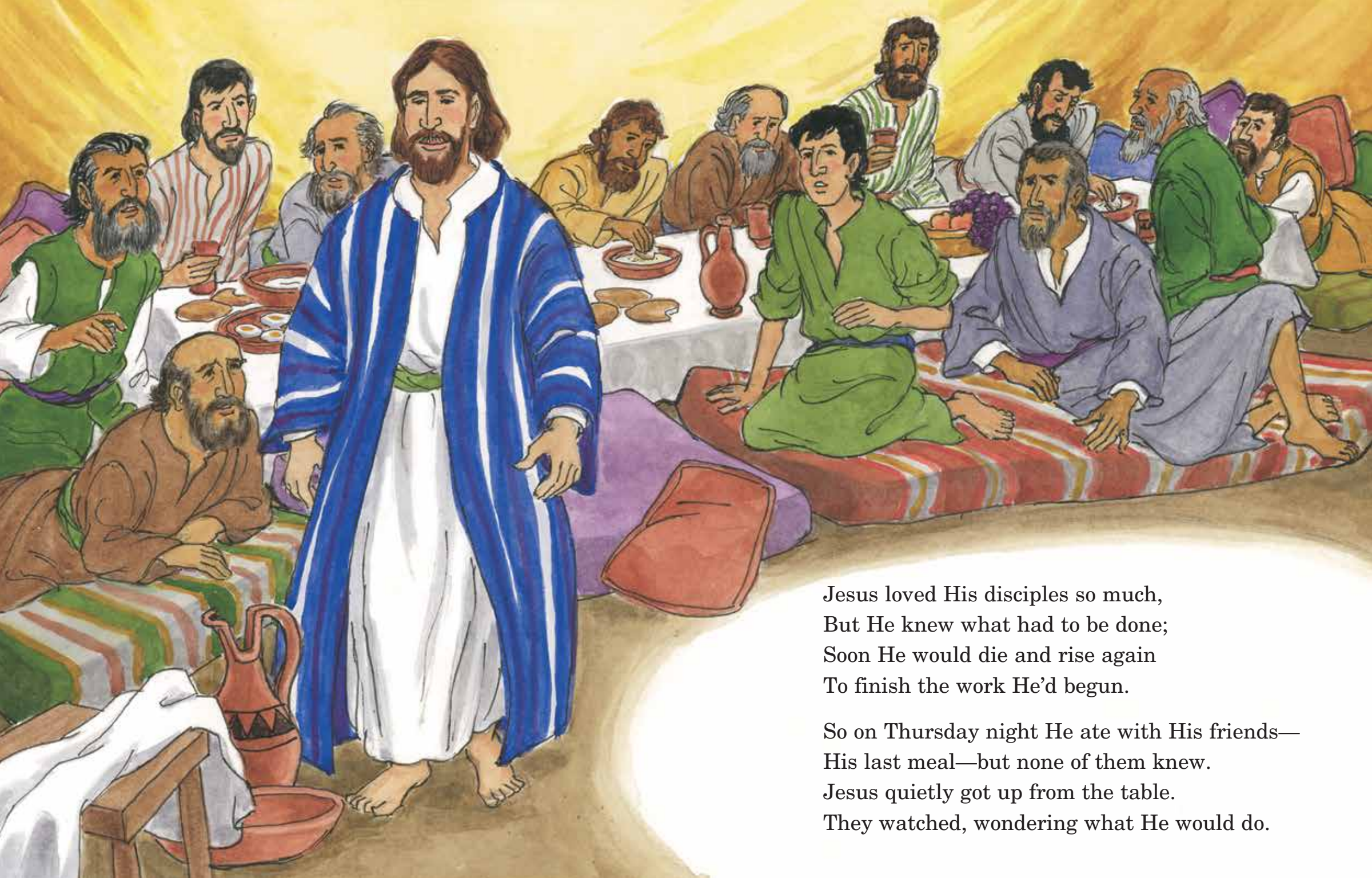


# Jesus Washes Peter's Feet

John 13:1–12 for children

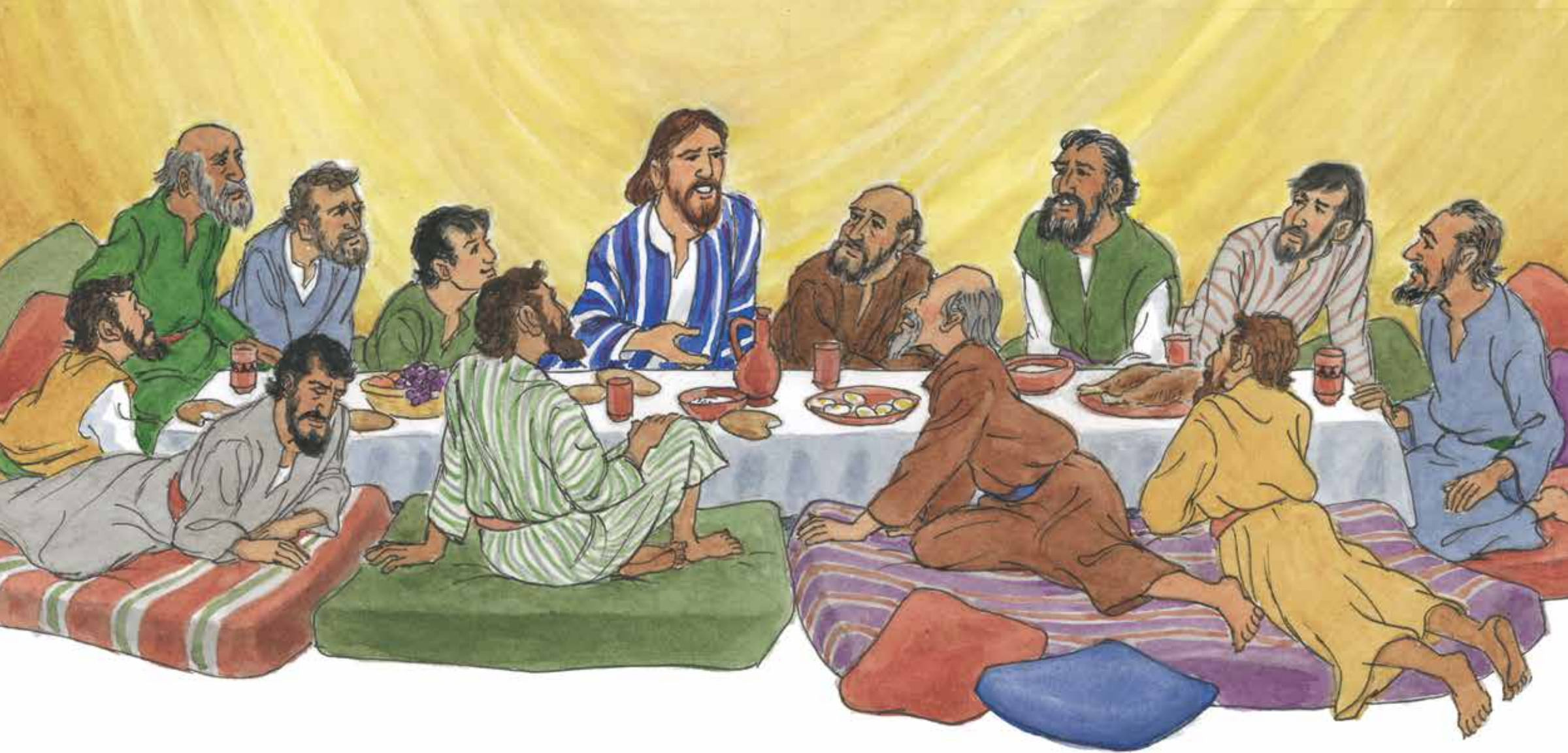
