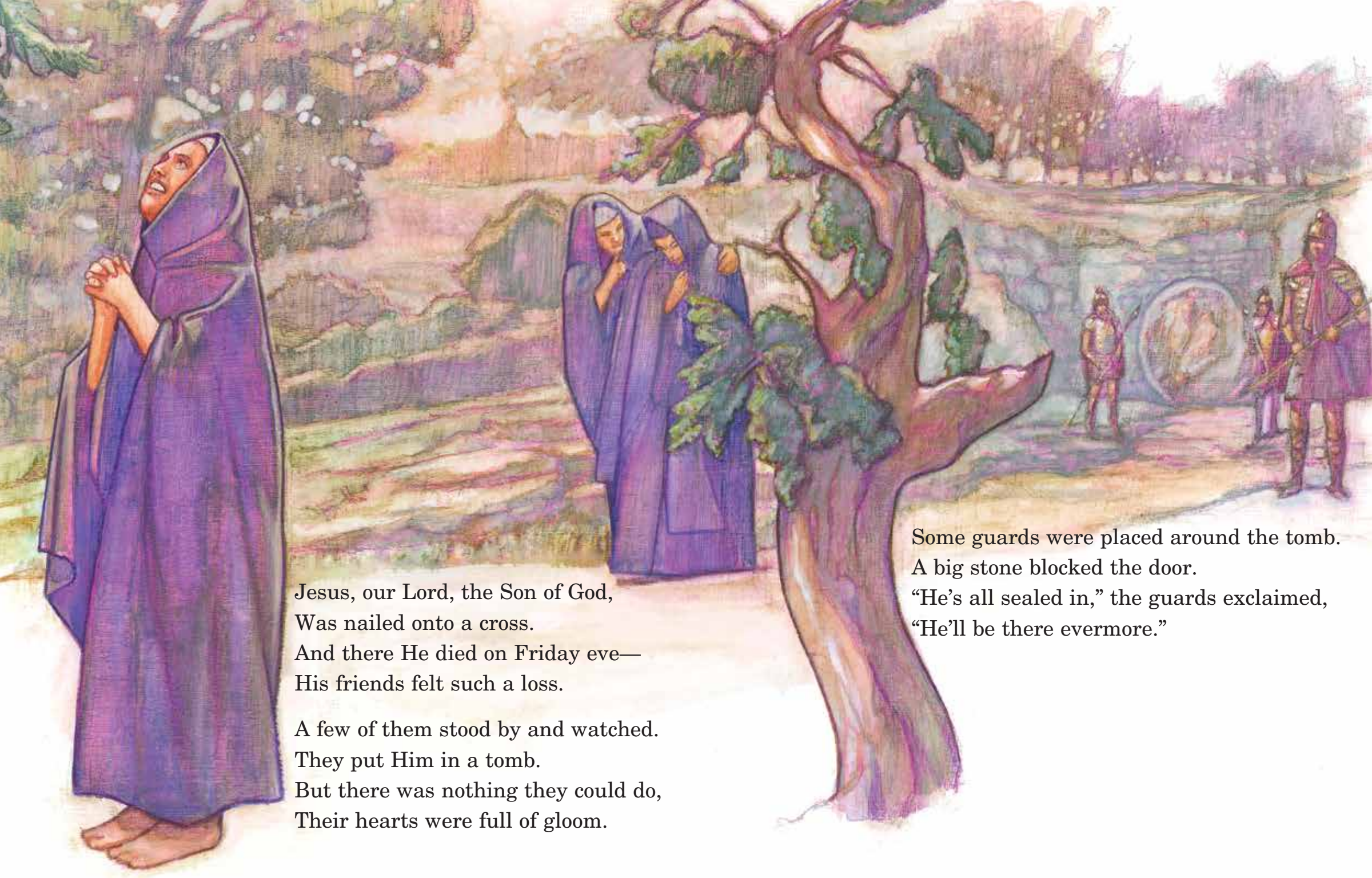


He's Risen! He's Alive!






Jesus, our Lord, the Son of God,
