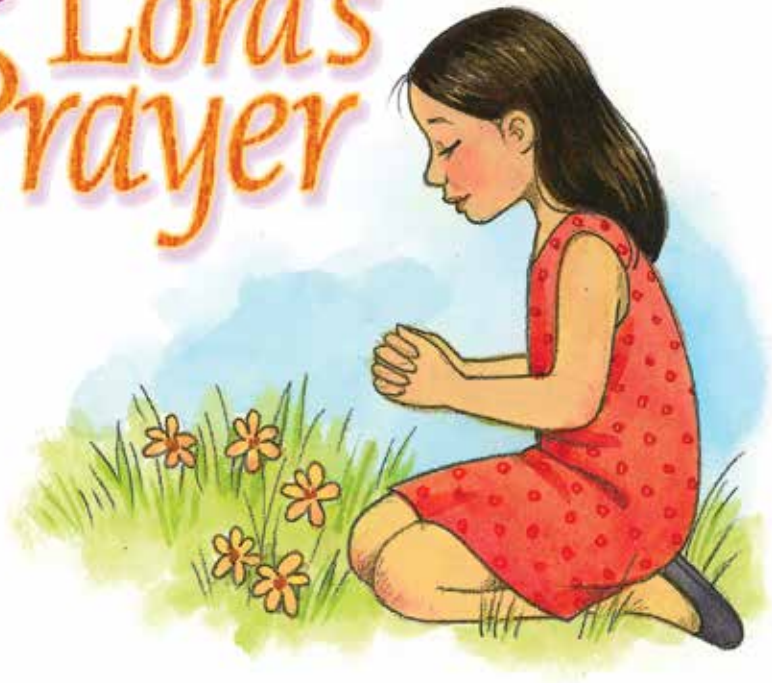
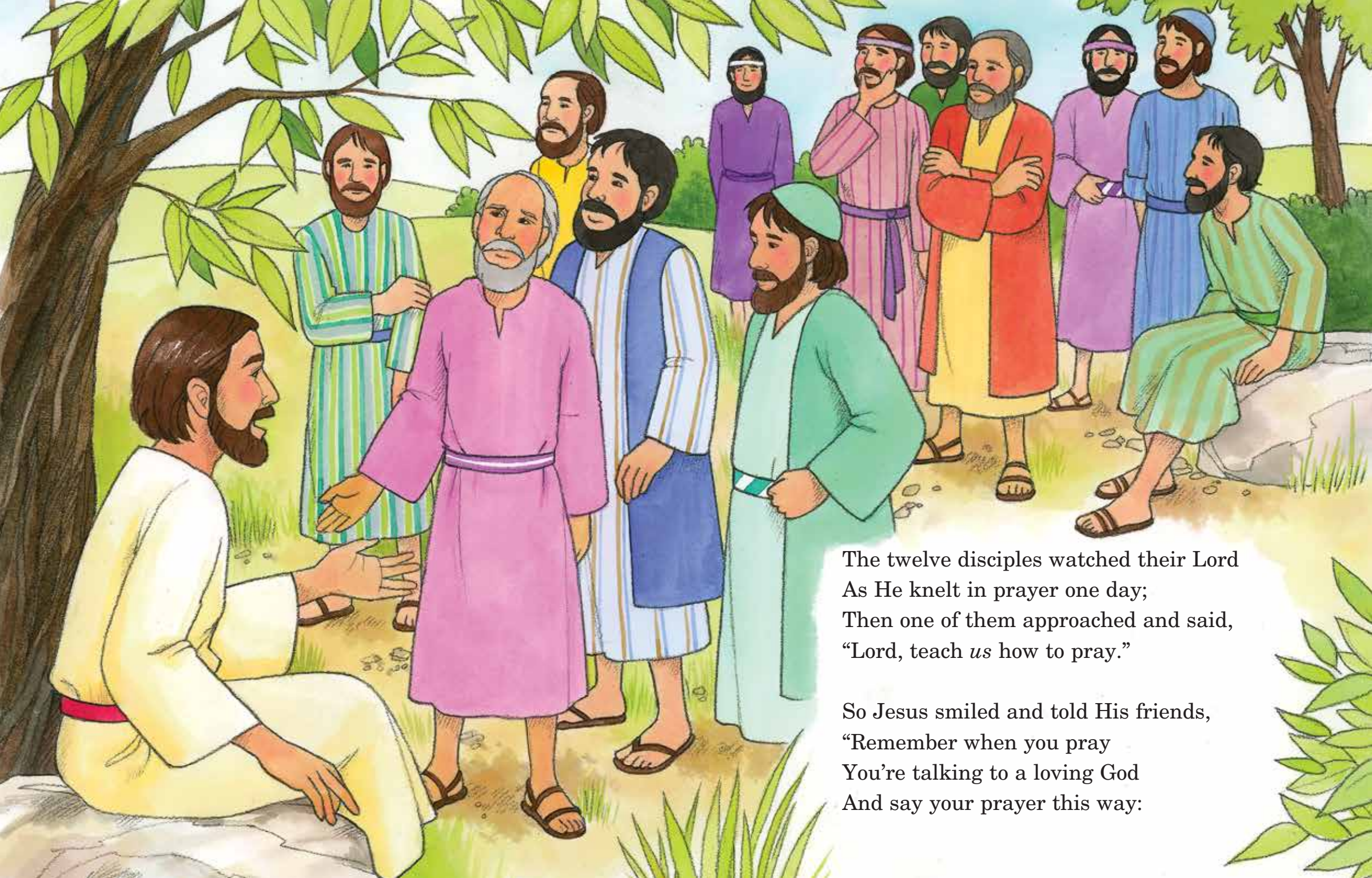


The Lord's Prayer
