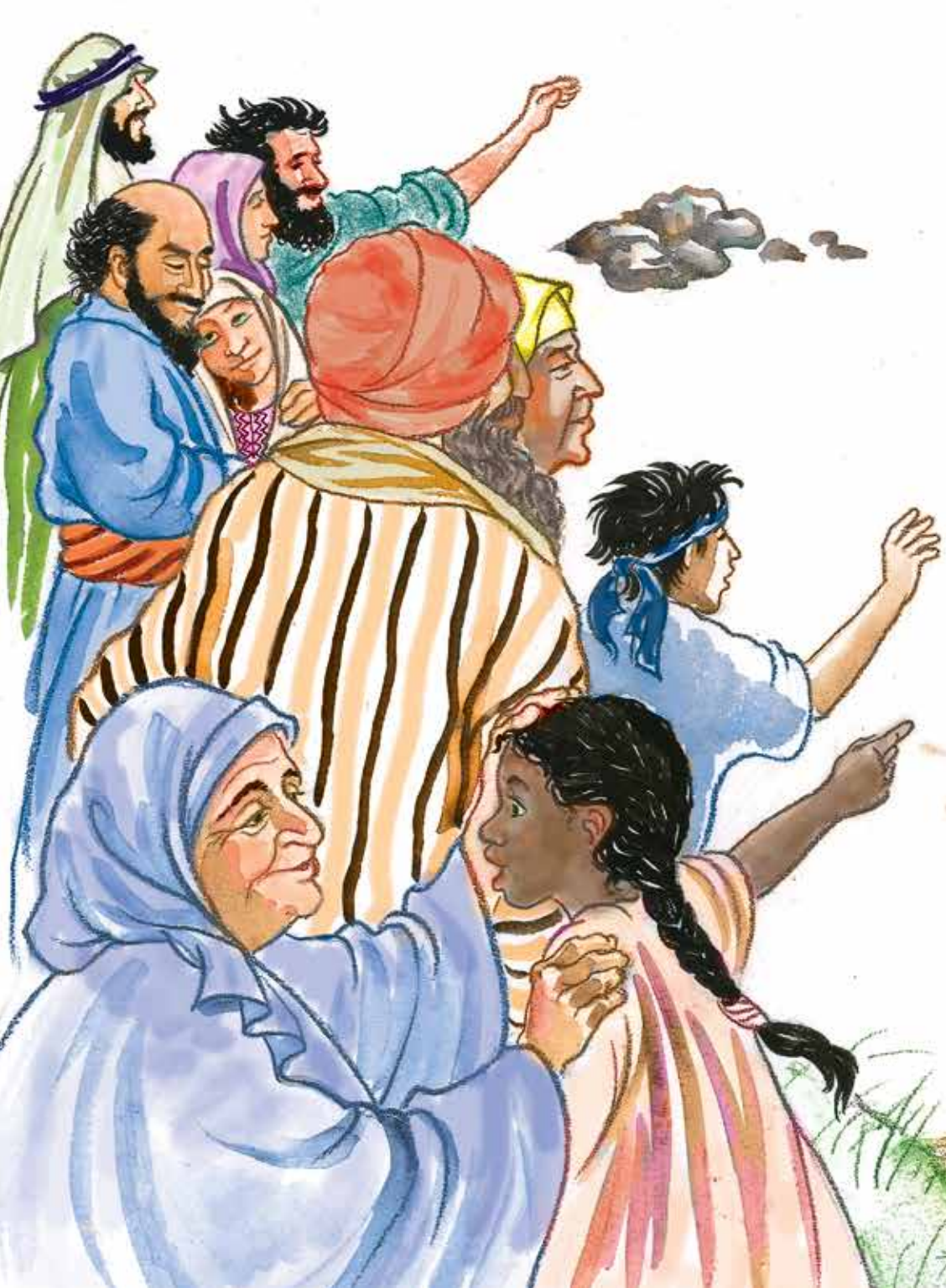


Jesus Calms the Storm

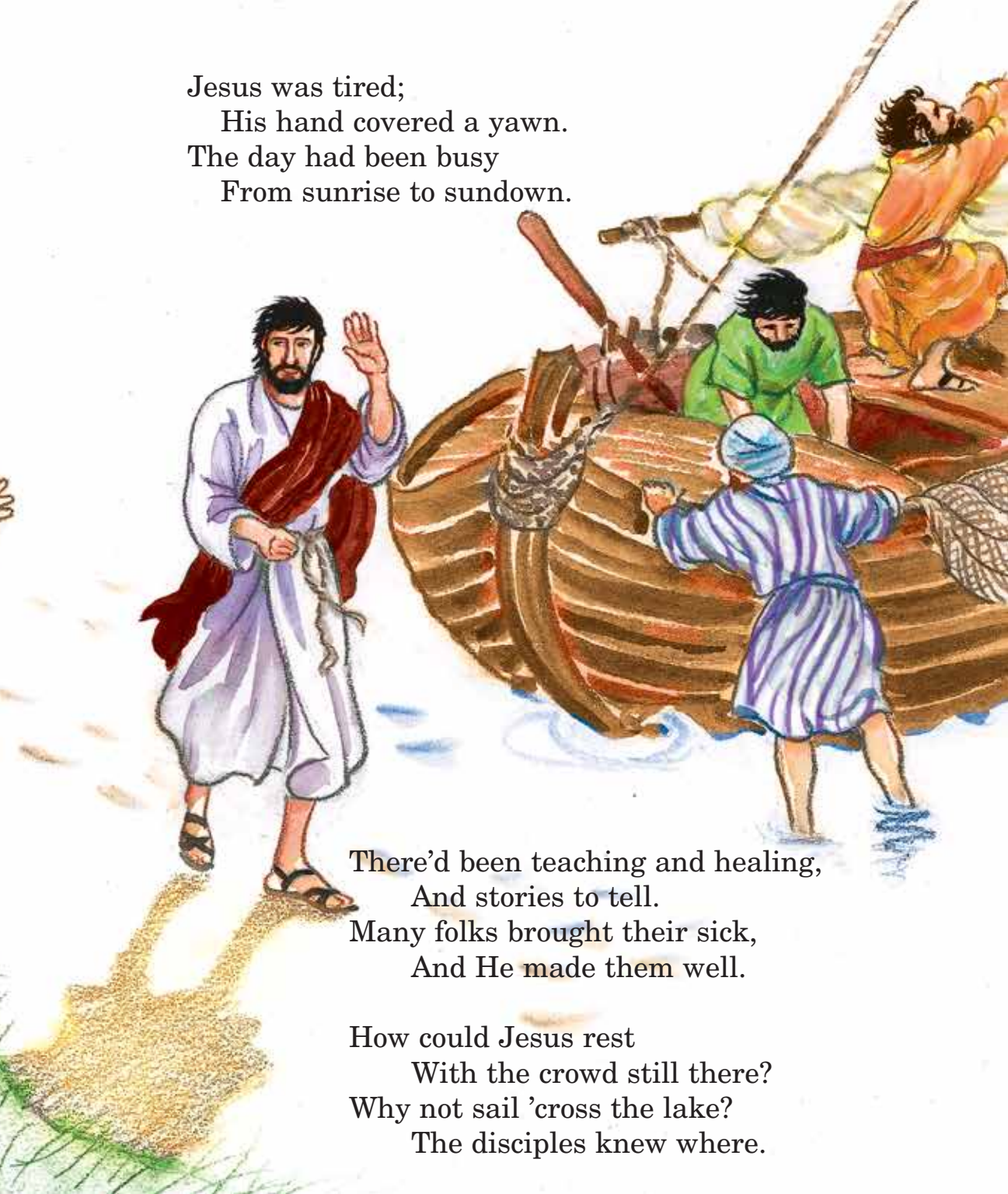
