

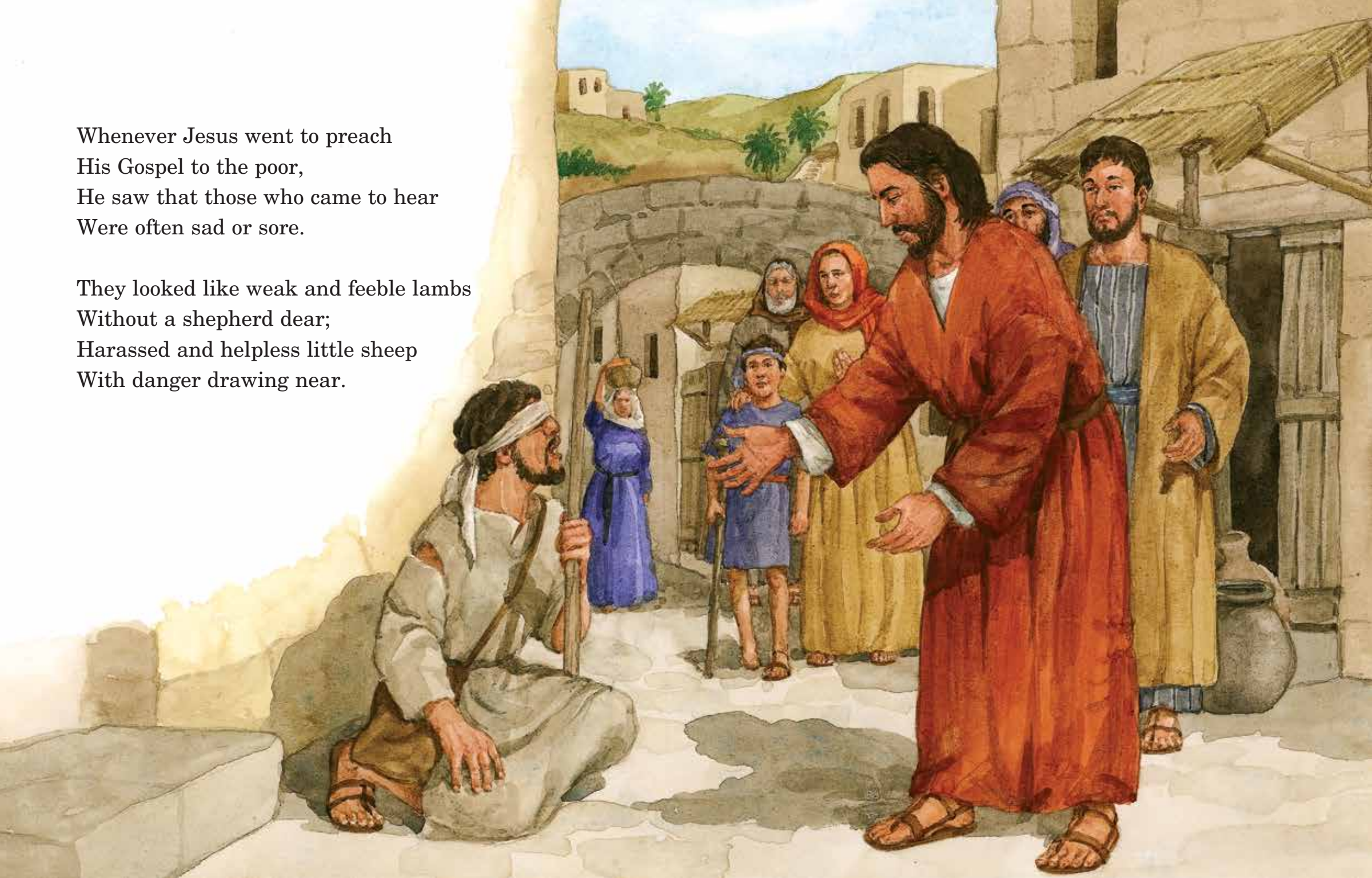
# Jesus, My Good Shepherd
