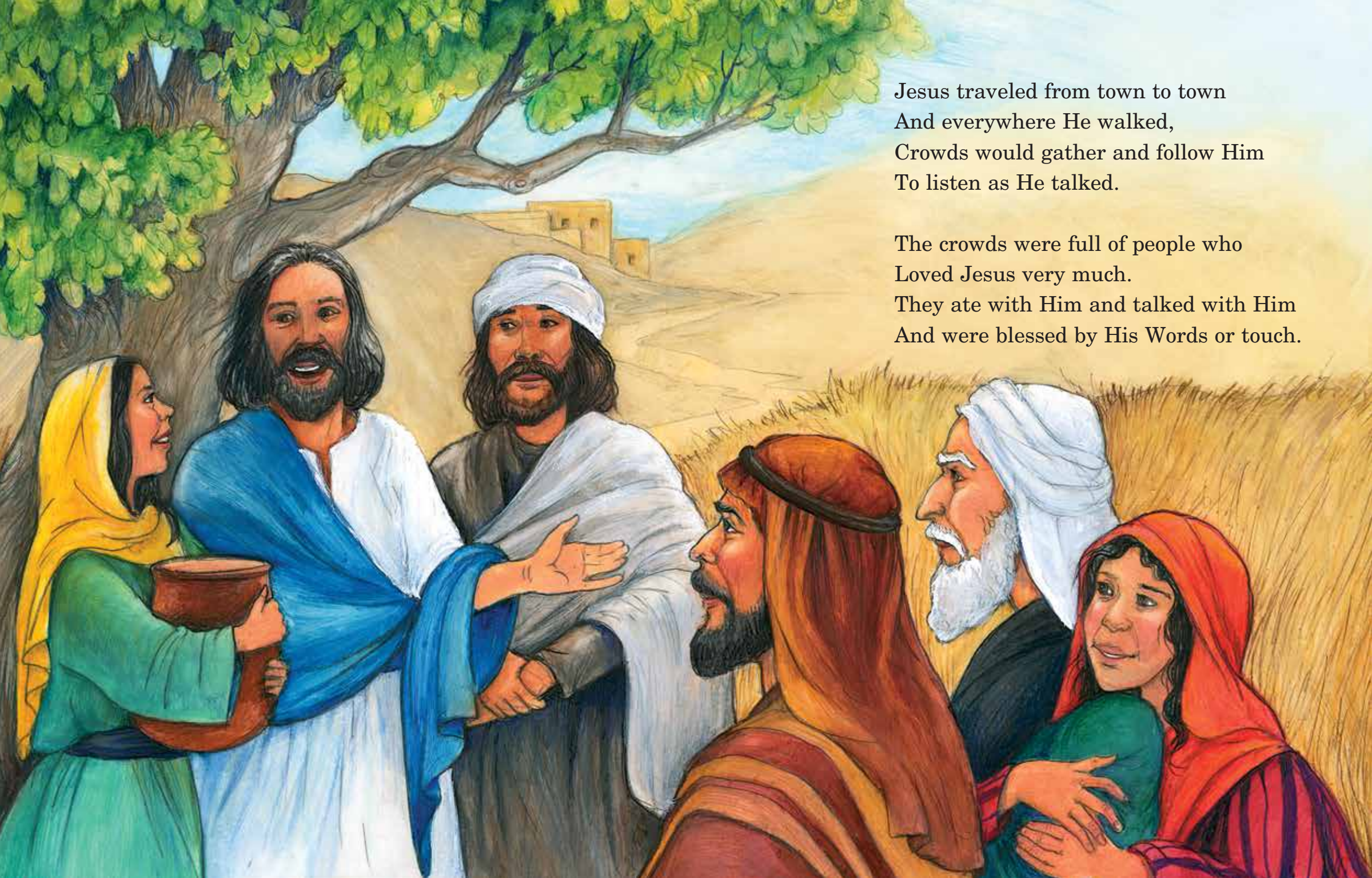


The Lost Coin
