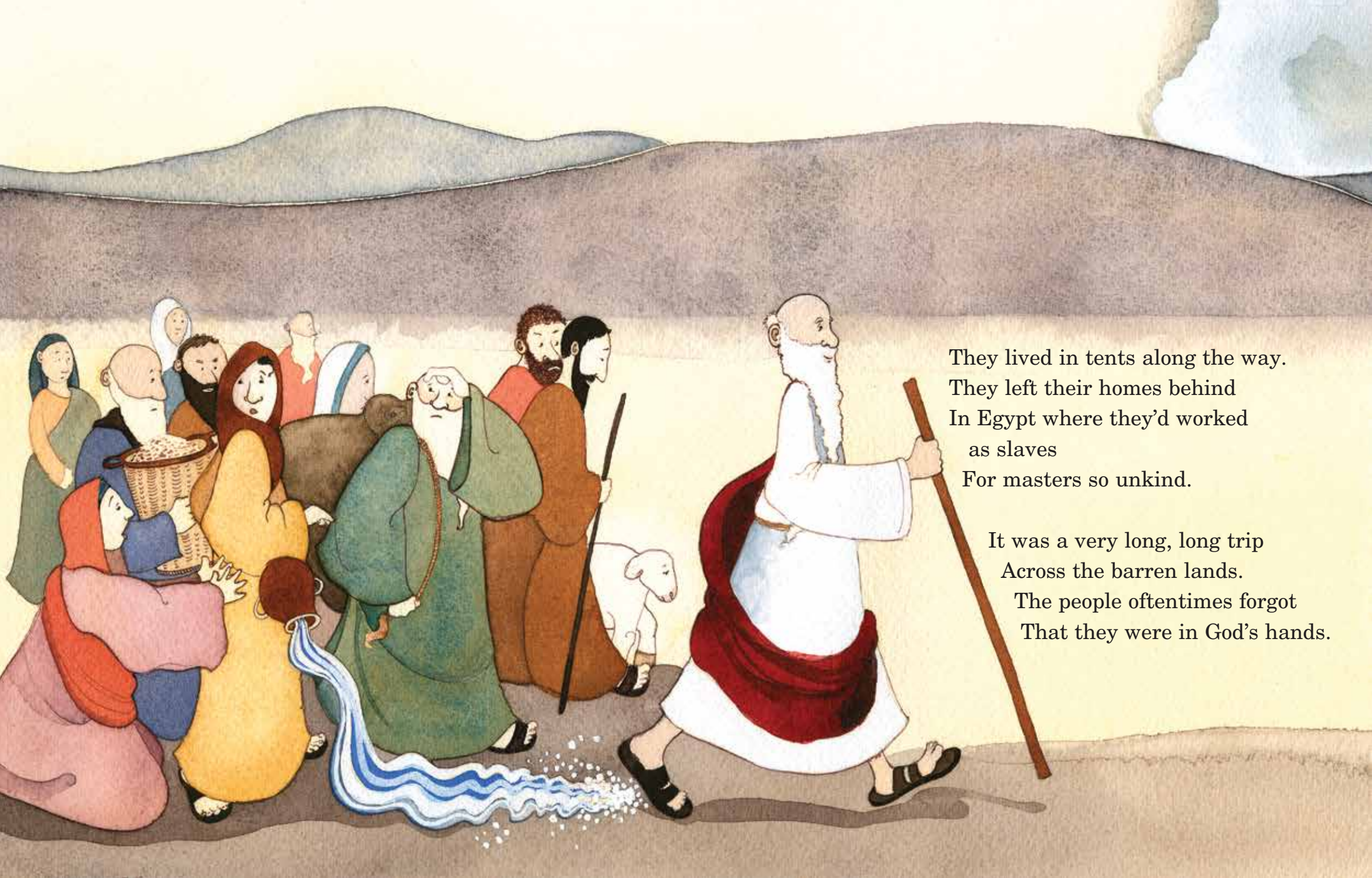


Moses AND THE Long Walk



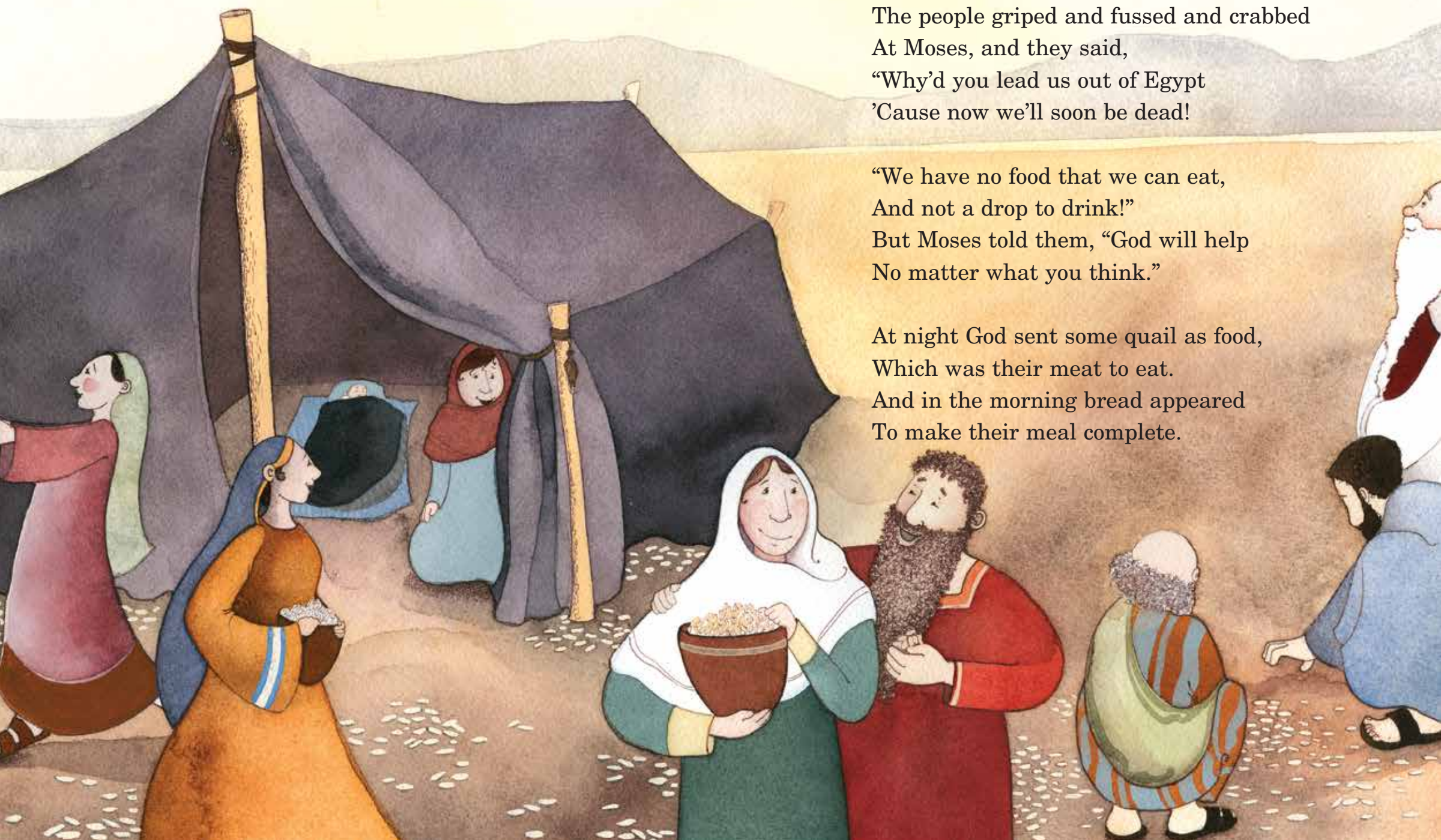
