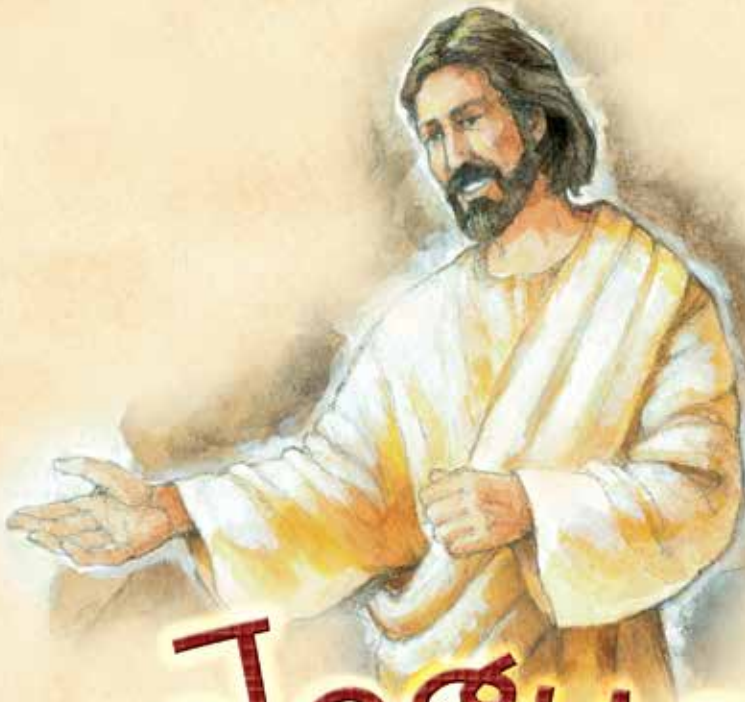

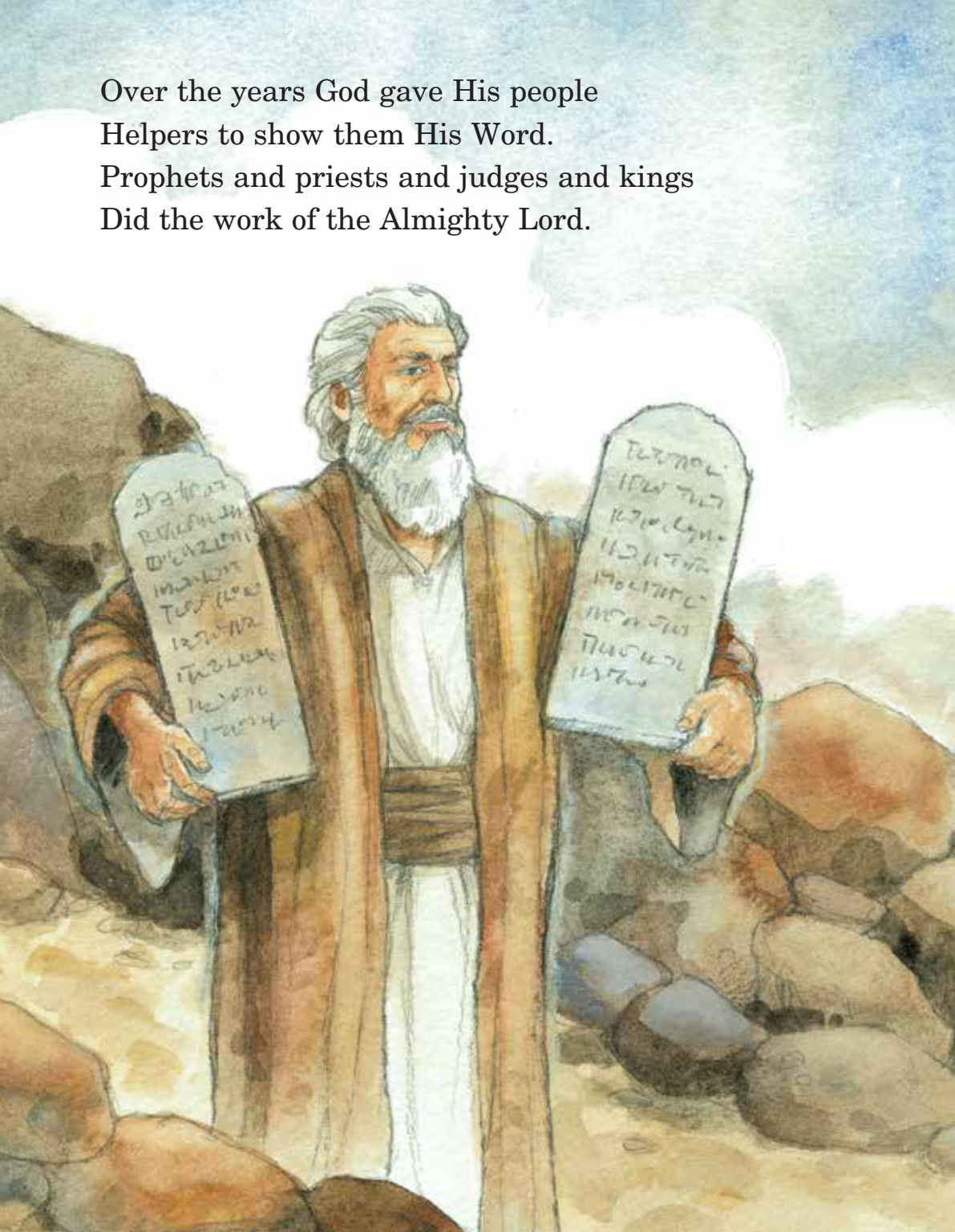


Jesus Shows His Glory

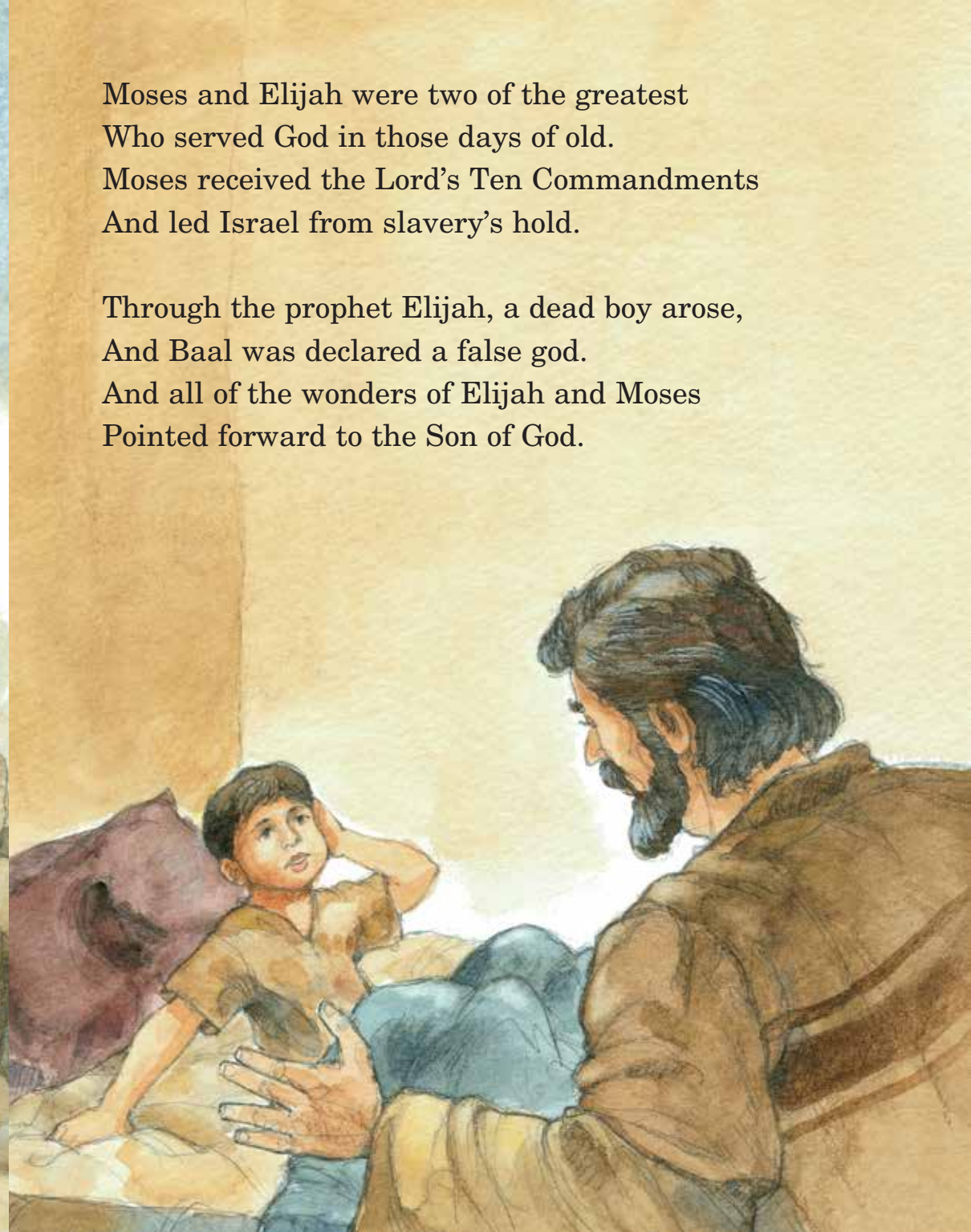
