

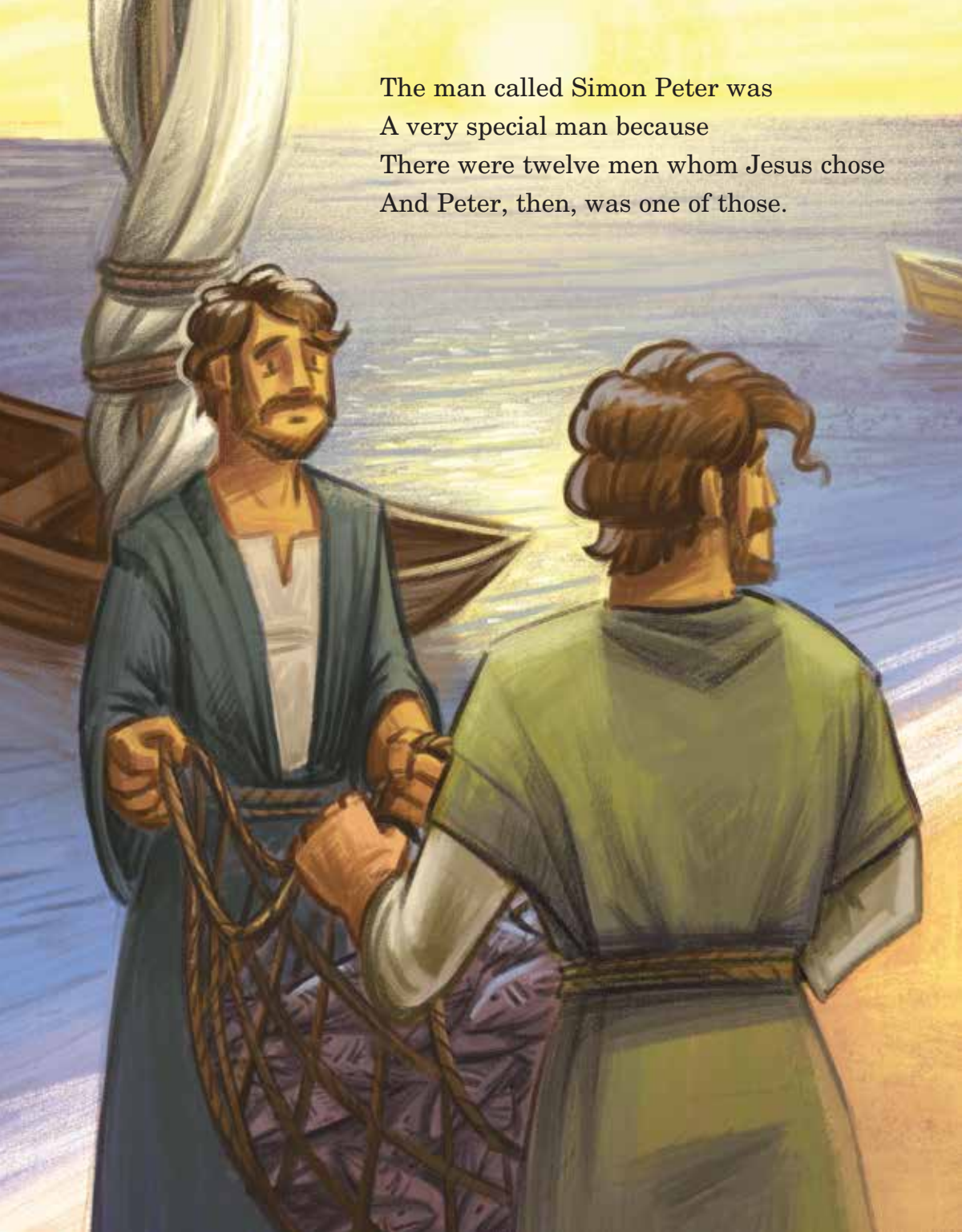
THE NIGHT **Peter Cried**
