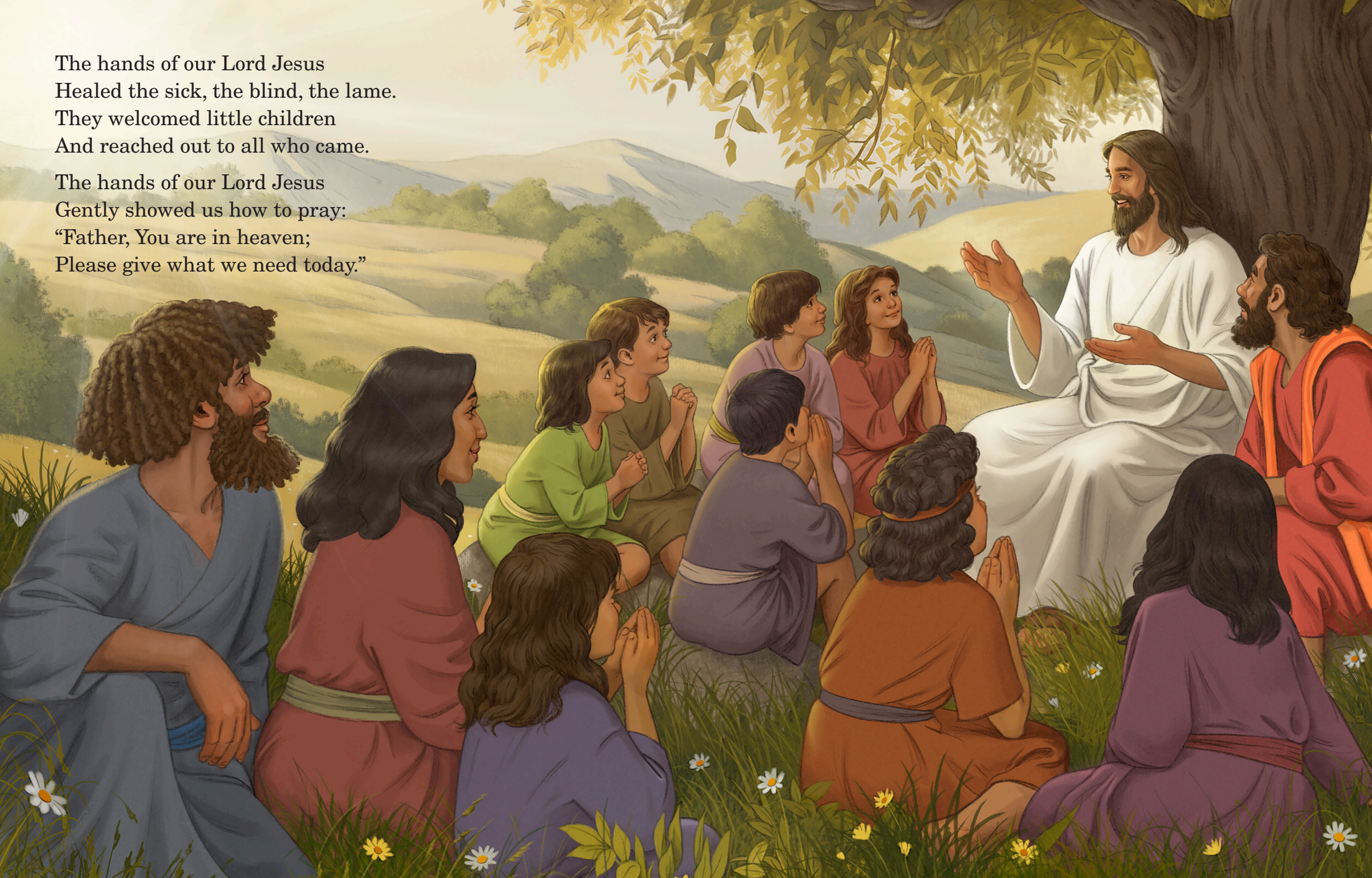

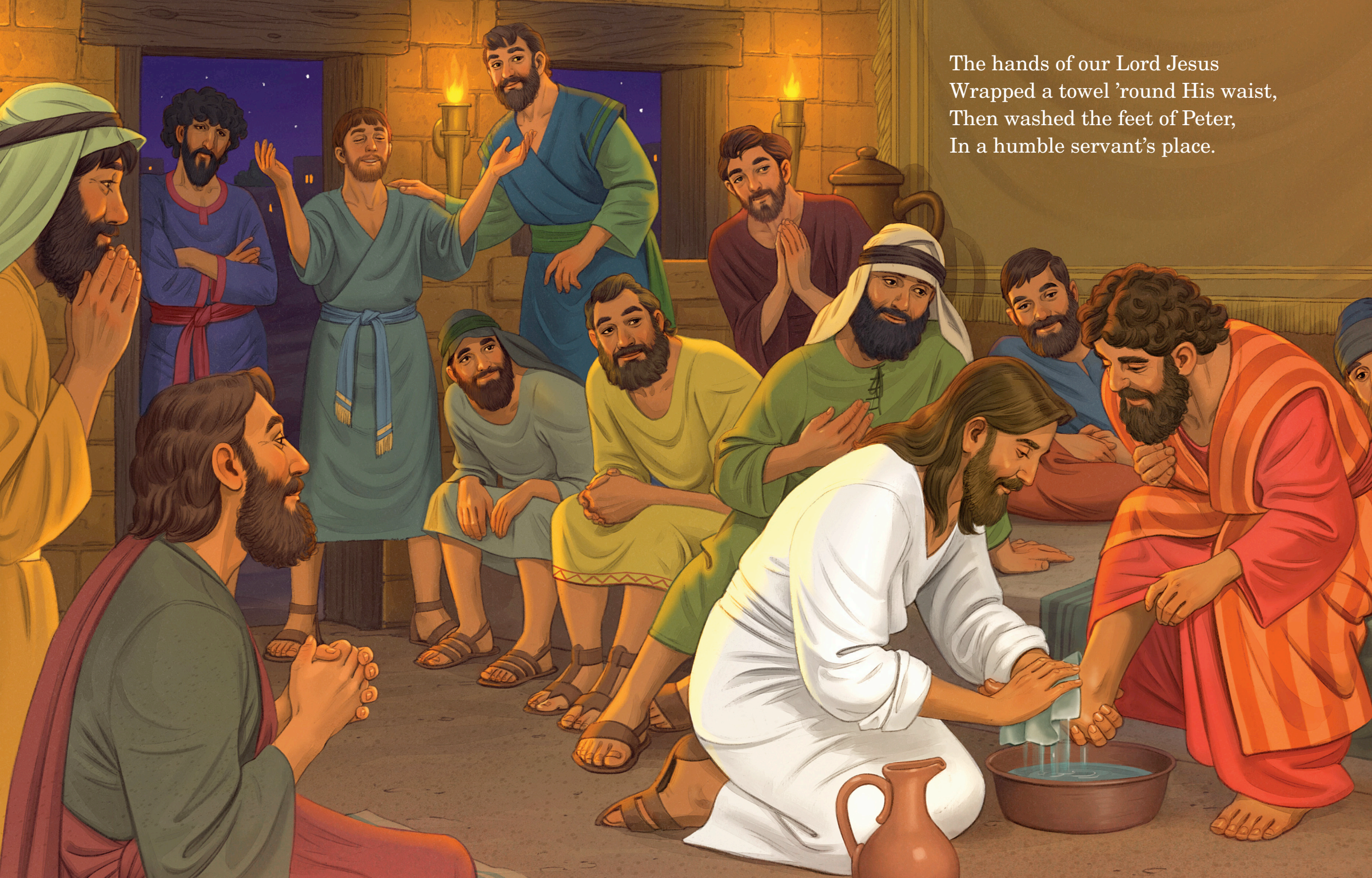
The hands of our Lord Jesus
