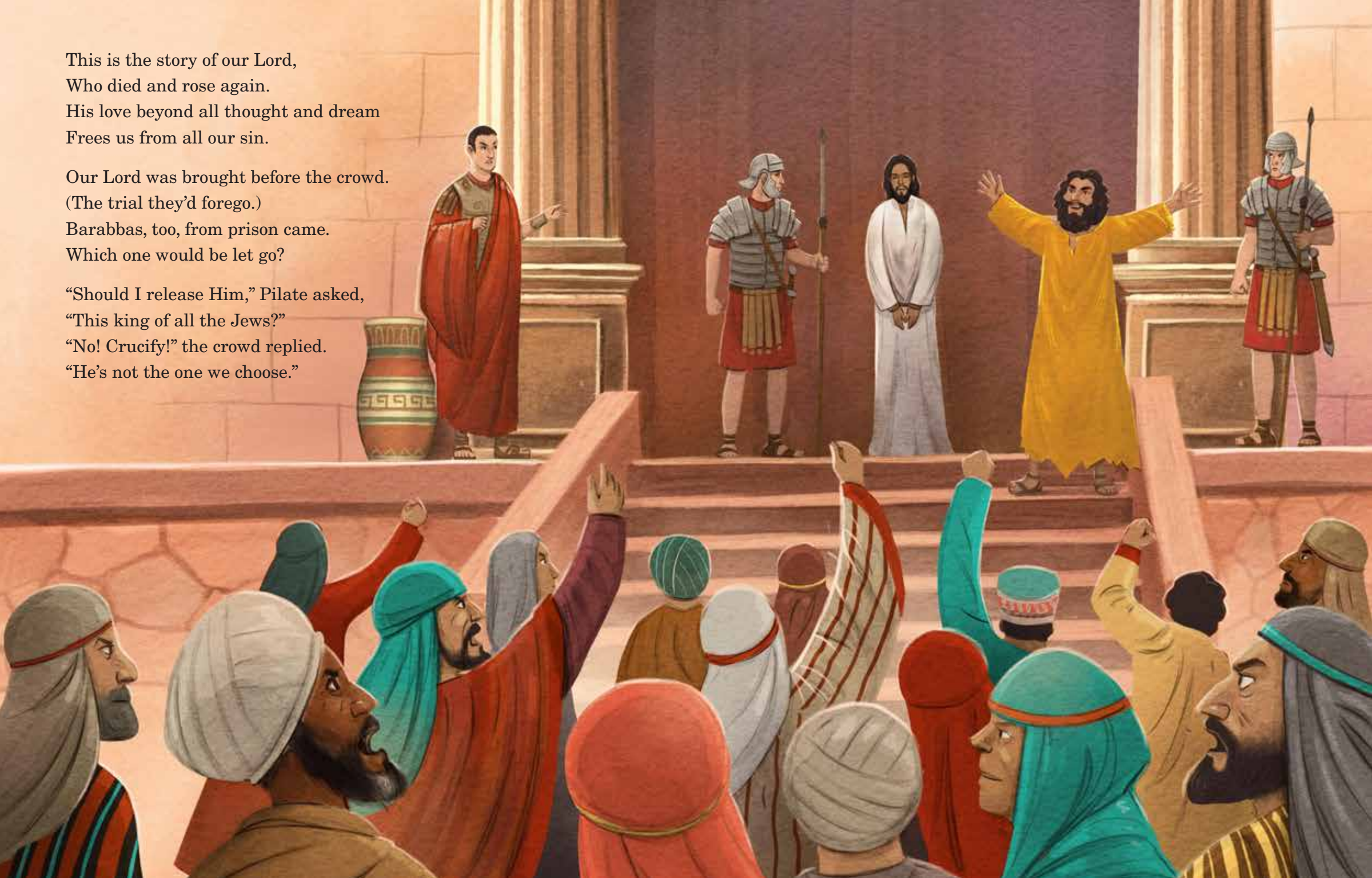

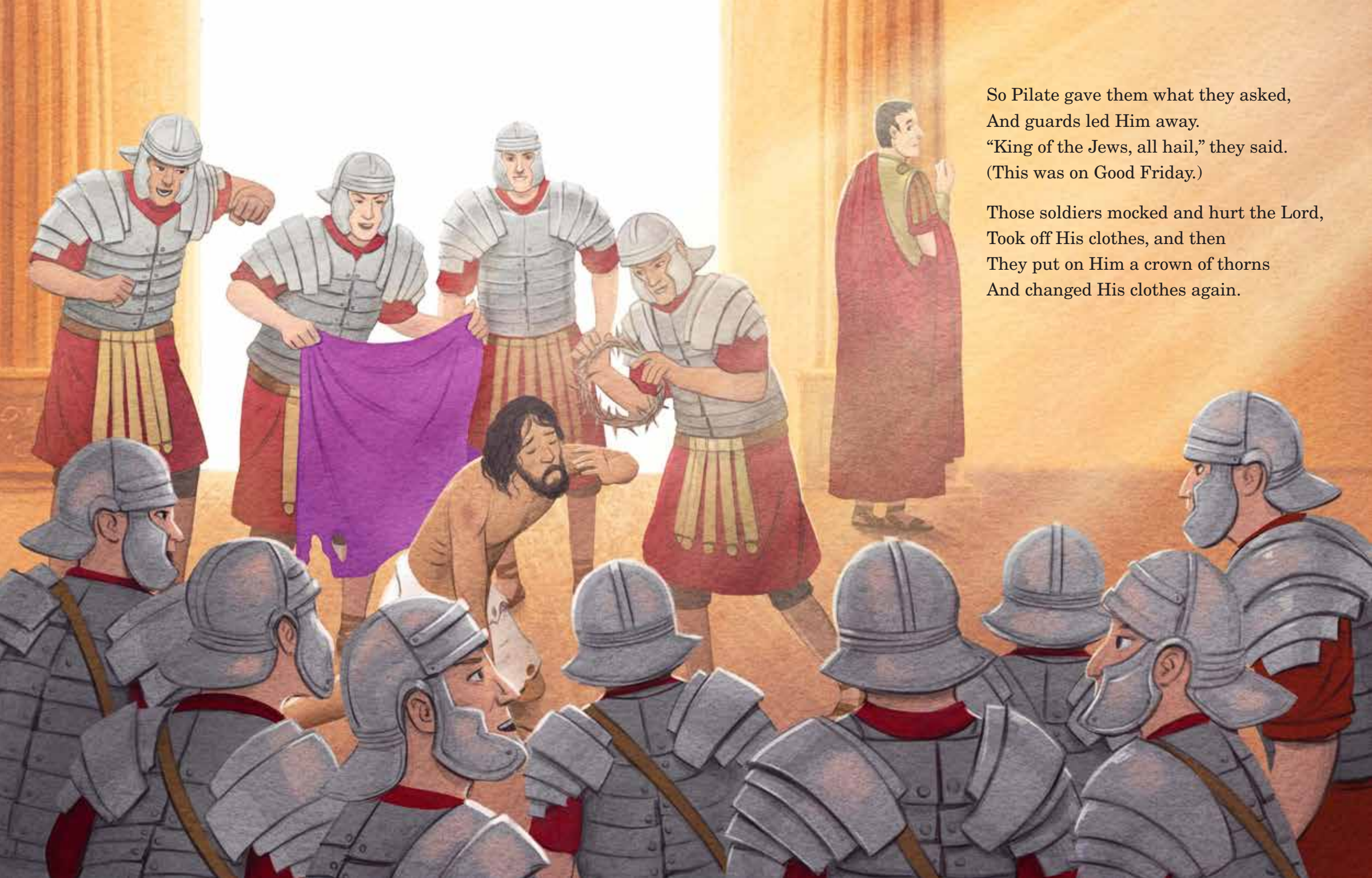


This is the story of our Lord,
