Directions: Cut out the squares. Put them in order to make a word that means feeling sorry for someone who is sad.

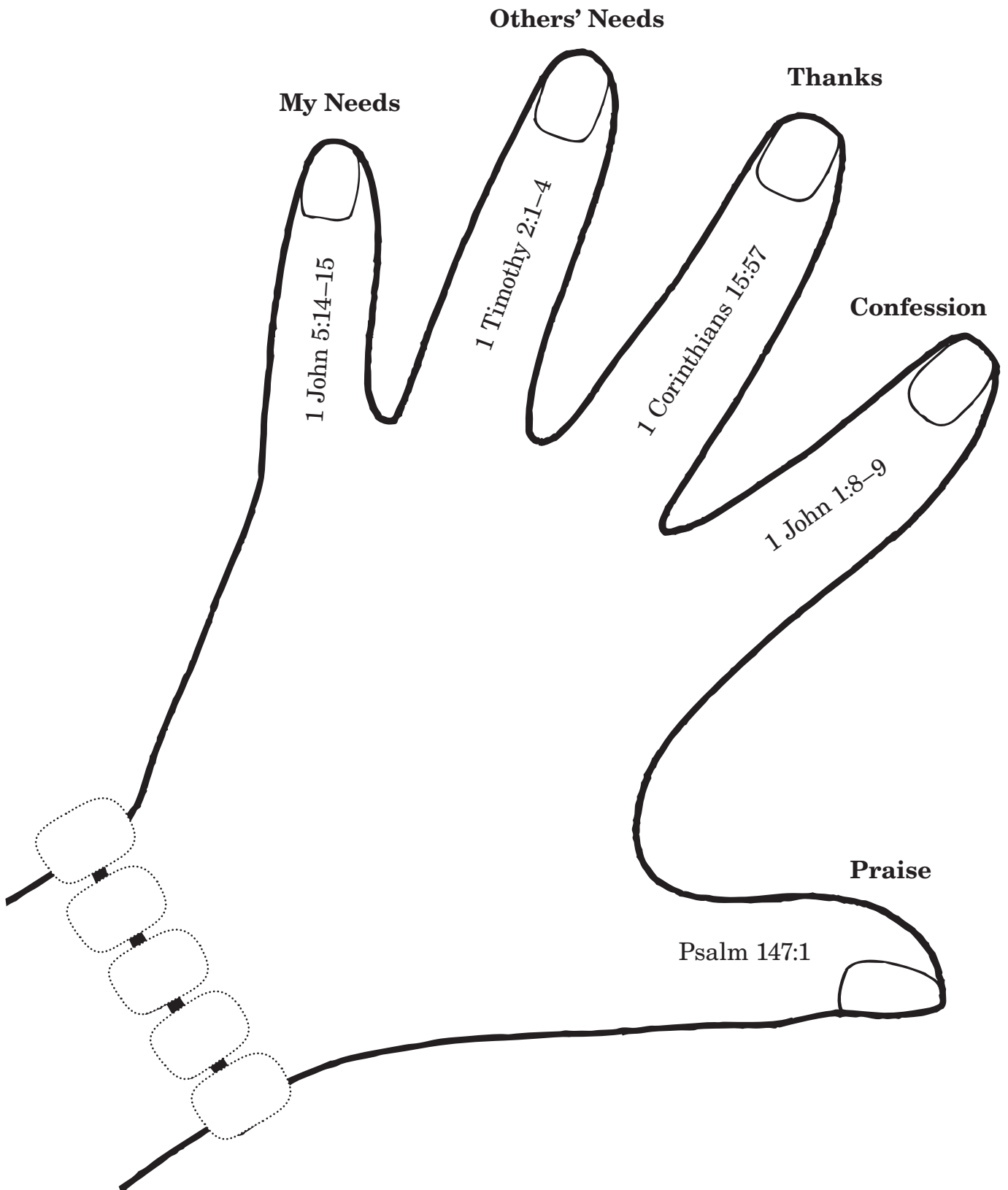



Praying Hands


We can use our hands to remind us of what to pray for.




