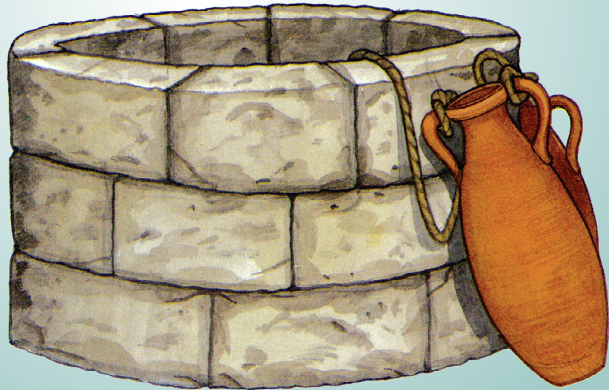

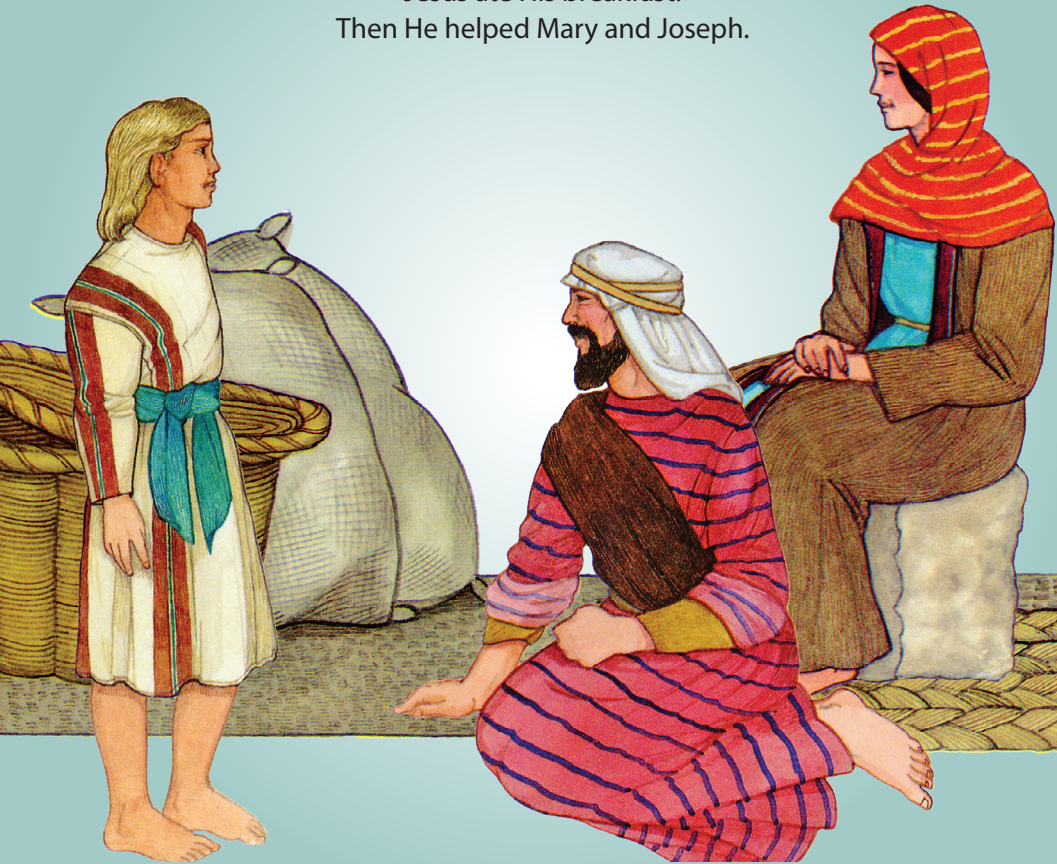
Jesus thanked God for taking care of Him all night.

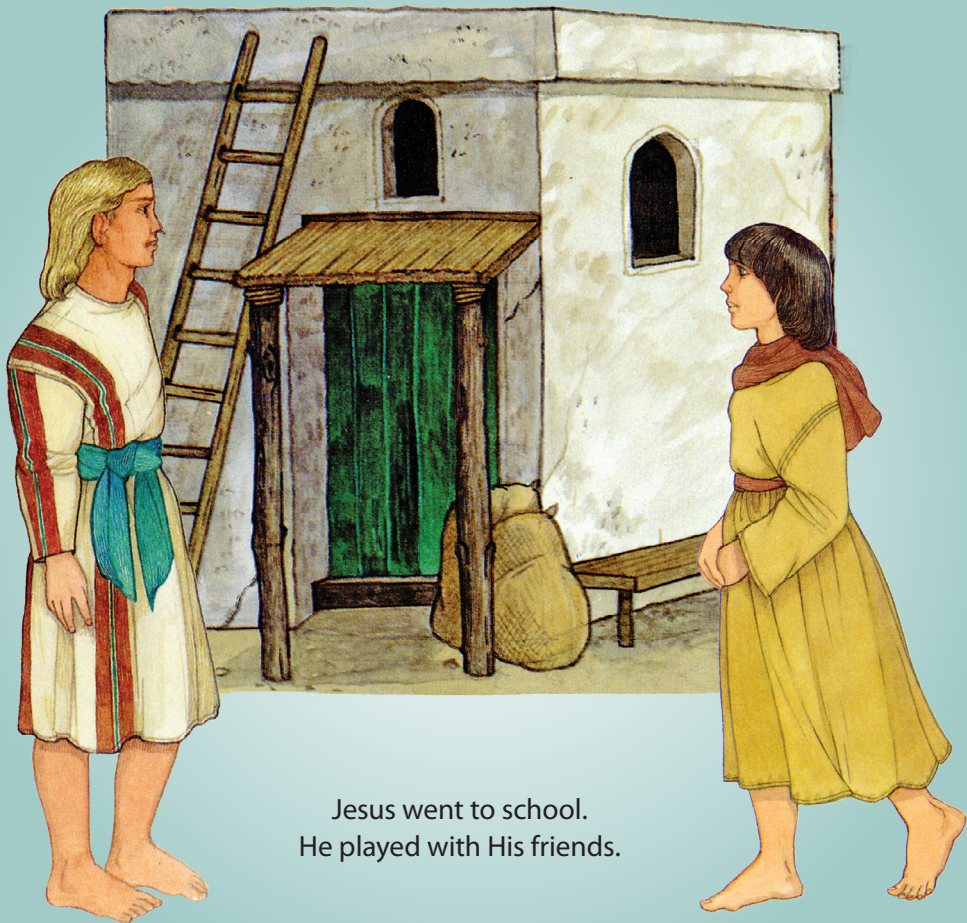


Jesus washed His hands and face.
