No Cavemen Here!

Genesis 2, like Genesis 1, tells us about the week of creation. But it goes back to Day 6 to fill in some details.
How did God make Adam? (Genesis 2:7)
God saw only one thing that was "not good." What was it? (Genesis 2:18)

COVENANT CONNECTION

(Genesis 2:16-17)

The story of creation is not an isolated event; God did not create the world and then walk away from it. That was just the beginning of the covenant relationship between God and His people. In Exodus 6:7, God said, "I will take you to be My people . . . and you shall know that I am the Lord your God." This promise was repeated again and again, as in Jeremiah 31:33–34; Zechariah 13:9b; and Luke 1:68, which all point to the promise fulfilled in Christ Jesus.
