
SAGITTA





Sagitta is a golden red, slow-growing, broiler and its female is very suitable for egg laying as well. The Sagitta birds are favored for its solid gold red feather cover. They will reach 4-5 pounds in about 10-12 weeks. The hen can also be used for egg production, she is a strong and robust egg layer, on average able to lay 5-6 eggs per week in the period between 25 and 50 weeks of age. Sagitta is an excellent forager on the range and is well-liked for its versatility and superior meat quality.
