MEXICO 2018 ELECTION UP-DATE

Having completed the full tally of all voting precincts throughout the country in accordance with Mexican election laws, yesterday (August 8, 2018), Andrés Manuel Lopez-Obrador, the candidate for *Juntos Haremos Historia* ("JHH"), was legally declared the victor of last month's presidential election. With this declaration, the election is legally concluded and the official transition begins.

López-Obrador won the July 1 election with an unprecedented 53% of the popular vote, and his coalition, JHH, won majority of the Senate and the Lower Chamber of Congress, as well as five of nine governorships up for ballot.

The new administration will take office on December 1, 2018, for the period 2018-2024.
