I Spy

<u>Using Illustrations</u> (RL7) <u>Conventions of Standard English</u> (L1, L2)

- Find the matching hats.
- What do the hats look like? Describe the hats as well as you can. Example: *two red hats with pointed tops*
- Can others find the hats that you describe?

Max and Kate

Key Ideas and Details (RL1, RL2, RL3)

- What do Max and Mo pretend to do?
- What is Kate pretending to be?
- What happens to Max's nose? What caused this to happen?

Regina and Eddie

Vocabulary Acquisition and Use (L4)

- Find these words or phrases in the story: *raft, jumble, trunk* (p. 8); *hyenas* (p. 9); *mast, sighed, hoist, steer* (p. 10); *sneered, urged, steady* (P. 11); *seaworthy craft, cruised* (p. 12).
- Using context clues (how the words are used in the story) and the illustrations, what do you think each word or phrase means? Use the dictionary if you need to.

Rhyming (RF2 [K]) Phonics and Word Recognition (RF3)

- Find the pairs of rhyming words on each page. Look carefully because some of the rhyming pairs are in the same line! Example: *She tied everything with a big ball of string.*
- Do they have the same spelling pattern?

Key Ideas and Details (RL1, RL3) Using Illustrations (RL7)

• Look carefully at the illustrations. What extra details do they give about this raft trip? What details do they give about Regina and Eddie?

Ghost Crabs

Key Ideas and Details (RL1, RL2, RL3)

- Why are the crabs called ghost crabs?
- How does the crab protect itself from danger?
- What's special about the eyes of ghost crabs?
- Why does Grandad say they shouldn't take a ghost crab home with them?
- What does Grandad say Mickey should take home?

Research to Build and Present Knowledge (W7) Comprehension and Collaboration (SL1)

• With a partner or small group, find a book about ghost crabs. What new information can you find out about them? Share the new information with your class.

Beach Secrets

Key Ideas and Details (RL1)

- Answer the question at the bottom of the page: Which objects might be washed out to sea by the next big wave? What could the girl do to solve this problem?
- What messages would you write on the sand??

- Do you have a place where you like to look at clouds? Draw a picture of your place.
