*Romans 11:1-10*

- God has not completely and totally rejected Israel. (11:1-6)
  - Paul is proof that God has not completely and totally rejected Israel. (11:1)
  - The remnant of believing Israelites are proof that God has not completely and totally rejected Israel. (11:2-6)
    - The remnant of believing Israelites were chosen by God (individual election, not corporate election). (11:5)
    - The remnant of believing Israelites were chosen by God's grace (unconditional election, not conditional election). (11:5-6)
- God has hardened the Israelites that weren't chosen to be part of His remnant. (11:7-10)
  - Doesn't God want everyone to be saved?
    - God's will of decree: that which God ordains or decrees.
    - God's will of desire: that which pleases/delights God.
  - What are the implications for our lives?
    - We should trust the Lord.
    - We should worship the Lord.
    - We should share the gospel.
