### Three Truths About Deceit

- Deceit does not provide what it promises. (19:1)
  - Deceit promises to provide you satisfaction.
  - The truth: You have everything you need in Christ.
  - Turn from the empty promises of deceit to the immeasurable joy of Christ.
- Deceit does not avoid judgment. (19:5, 9)
  - Deceit promises to spare you from the judgment of your actions.
  - The truth: Christ received the punishment that you deserved for your actions.
  - Freely tell the truth knowing that you have been justified by God.
- Deceit does not think about others. (19:22)
  - Deceit promises that saying kind but untrue words is for the good of others.
  - The truth: Christ's words are both kind and true.
  - Follow Jesus' example and speak kind and true words to others.
