Eight Characteristics of a Sluggard

- You put things off and procrastinate. (Proverbs 20:4; 24:30-34)
- You make up excuses for not doing things. (Proverbs 22:13; 26:13)
- You love to sleep, too much. (Proverbs 26:14)
- You're lazy even in the simple things. (Proverbs 19:24; 26:15)
- You think you're smarter than everyone else, even though you don't do anything. (Proverbs 26:16)
- You have a lot of dreams and desires, but nothing to show for them. (Proverbs 13:4; 21:25)
- Your laziness has filled your life with trouble and difficulty. (Proverbs 15:19)
- You aren't reliable and others have a hard time depending on you. (Proverbs 10:26)

Three Ways to Respond

- Repent of your selfish, self-centered heart.
- Repent of your idolatry.
- Preach the gospel to yourself.
