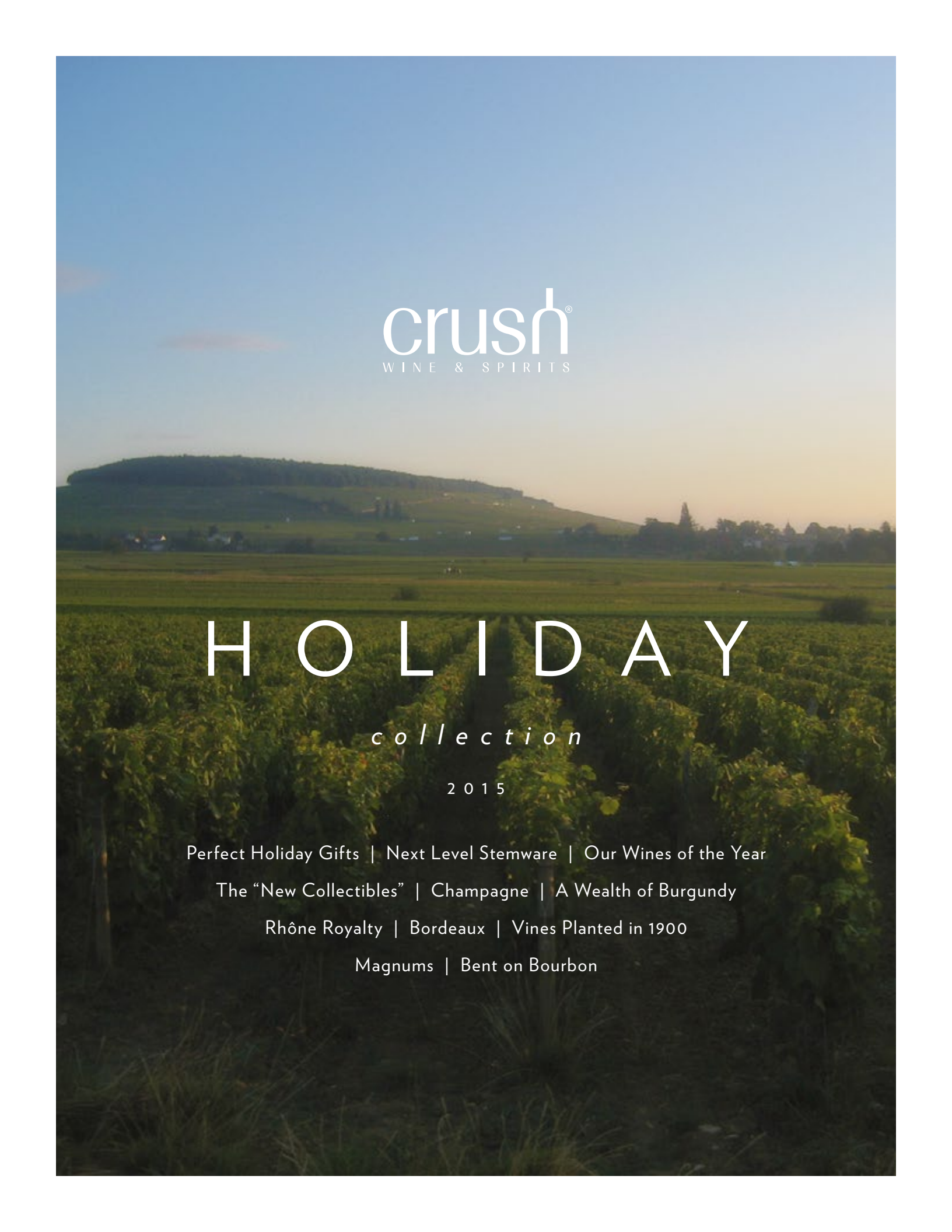

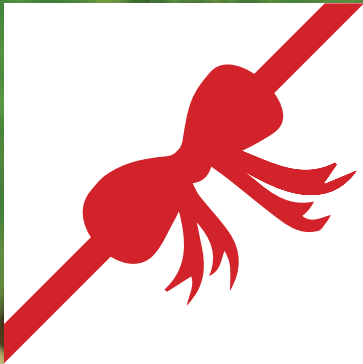

as criteria for a “wine of the year.” Instead, we’ve come up with a distinctly different set of guidelines, one that examines the honesty of a wine, its personality and – this is important – the sheer pleasure of drinking it. Yes, we prioritize quality and value, but the x-factor that we’re really looking for is that impossible-to-define, elusive quality that inspires and excites.

2014 Dominique Lucas Savagnin

The 2014 vintage marks a point where Lucas’ wines clicked into overdrive. Dominique Lucas’ 2014s are some of the most exciting wines I’ve tasted all year, especially the Savagnin.

Lucas is from a winegrowing family in Burgundy, but he bought land near Lac Léman (the French name for Lake Geneva) in an obscure and beautiful corner of the already obscure Savoie region. The wines almost immediately gained a cult following in France and we’ve been following them for some time. They are exhilarating wines, and it’s difficult not to take note of them.

Even for fans, in 2014 the wines hit a level that seemed unimaginable. There’s a shocking purity and mysterious depth to them.

The Savagnin grape is synonymous with the Jura, but if you use Jura as your point of reference, you’ll be blindsided when you taste Lucas’ Savagnin. (The vine material doesn’t even come from Jura, but instead from Switzerland.) The 2014 is purely mineral with a crystal clear cut and has a beautiful textural element that adds further complexity and intrigue.

I always agonize over my wine of the year. Frankly, selecting the wine seems impossible. Instead, I search my memory for the wines that caused me to step back wide-eyed. Lucas’ 2014 Savagnin did just that.

2008 Robert Moncuit Chétillons

When the wines of Robert Moncuit first arrived on our shores a few years ago, the Champagnes were virtually unknown in the states. That quickly changed. Personally, I was struck by the incredible energy and precision of everything I tasted and my obsession developed swiftly.

During my visit to Moncuit earlier this year, winemaker Pierre Amillet mentioned that 2008 would mark the inaugural release from the Chétillons vineyard. It wasn’t available to taste quite yet, but I immediately started angling to try the wine. When I finally landed a taste, the wine was simply killer.

It’s impossible not to set a high bar for Chétillons, especially when it’s from the 2008 vintage. Chétillons lies in the village of Mesnil, which produces some of the most profound expressions of Chardonnay on the planet. Pierre Peters’ gorgeous examples of Chétillons, which have been bottled separately since 1971, brought the hillside heaps of praise. Aided by 55+ year old vines, Moncuit’s delivers on all the promise of Chétillons.

The 2008 vintage in Champagne is shaping up to be one of the best of this century so far. Combine a banner vintage with an exceptional vineyard like Chétillons, and add to it the staggering quality of Moncuit and you get a truly captivating Wine of the Year.

The landscape has changed...



For years, collectible wine has gravitated around a handful of long exalted appellations. In recent years, the net has widened and astonishingly good wine is emerging from unlikely corners. Suddenly, wines that were hiding in plain sight have become drool-worthy snapshots on social media and are hunted down with ruthless fervor. For many, a first glance at our list

of “new collectibles” might seem odd: there’s no shortage of strange and previously unheralded appellations and plenty of the cult-iest of the bunch are meant for near-to-midterm drinking. Many of the wines have a nostalgic element - an appreciation for an old-fashioned style of making wine that seems impossible to recover. It’s a very exciting time.

Evidence of superlative quality can be found everywhere from their painfully rare single vineyard bottlings to the supremely overachieving Sainte Anne entry level non-vintage Champagne. After working with Anselme Selosse, Alexandre Chartogne returned to his family’s domaine in 2006 with huge ambitions and endless curiosity. Chartogne-Taillet had already been working at a very high

level for some time. However, since Alexandre’s return the wines have been elevated to an elite level. He’s one of the most thoughtful winemakers that we know, and it shows in the wines. Chartogne-Taillet’s wines are expansive, painstakingly precise and incisively mineral. These Champagnes are simply thrilling.

NV Chartogne-Taillet Cuvée Sainte Anne . . \$41.95
This is one of the most ridiculously impressive entry level non-vintages in the entire region. It’s serious with an intense coiled minerality.

2008 Chartogne-Taillet Vintage \$69.95
A Pinot and Chardonnay blend from the single vineyard Les Couarres. This is a mineral freight train. There’s tremendous energy and potential here.

2008 Chartogne-Taillet BdB Cuvée Heurtebise Extra Brut \$64.95
Heurtebises is a south-facing vineyard of sandy clay over limestone. It’s a deeply textured BdB boasting plenty of tension and dynamic minerality. In the great 2008 vintage, it’s especially sleek and stunning.

2010 Chartogne-Taillet Cuvée Lettre de Mon Meunier Extra Brut \$79.95
The 2010 vintage hit Meunier yields very hard. This is a blend of two Meunier vineyards that are usually bottled separately, Les Barres (an old-vine ungrafted site) and Les Alliées (another tiny older vine parcel.) This one-off cuvée is beautifully layered and profoundly long.

2010 Chartogne-Taillet Cuvée Orizeaux Extra Brut \$79.95
A single vineyard Pinot from a chalky site with sandy topsoil. Orizeaux boasts an incredible scale and intricate architecture. The finish is an endless study in nuanced minerality.

Chave’s Hermitage is one of the great wines of the world. When it comes to Syrah, there is simply no better expression on the planet than Chave Hermitage Rouge. No one can render the grape with the same combination of sophistication and depth. A truth that only becomes more obvious with time in the cellar.

The granite hillsides of Hermitage are some of the finest places to grow grapes. The Chave family holds parcels in Hermitage’s finest vineyard sites (Les Bessards, Meal, l’Ermite, Peleat, and Les Beaumes), and Jean-Louis blends these with an unparalleled mastery. Truly, the most apt comparison to this kind of artful, intuitive blending comes from Champagne’s chefs de caves.

We shouldn’t continue any further without shining the spotlight on Chave’s much more limited Hermitage Blanc. It’s one of the most majestic, long-lived and endlessly complex white wines around. Chave’s Hermitage Blanc effortlessly blends richness with a tense

stony core. As it ages, watch out. It becomes an epic journey through flowers, stone fruits, citrus oils and sleek minerals. All of this surrounds a waxy texture of incredible length and supreme elegance.

It’s a mistake to overlook Chave’s Saint-Joseph. When the Chave family first started tending vines in the Northern Rhône back in the 15th century, Saint-Joseph was their jumping off point. Jean-Louis Chave is extremely passionate and committed to the terroir of Saint-Joseph. When you taste the wines, it becomes very clear. It can easily compete with many producers’ Hermitage.

In The New France, Andrew Jeffords declares that the Chave family “could make a fair claim to be France’s winemaking royal family: in no other of France’s great terroirs is the largest individual landholder so deeply rooted in time and place, so supremely competent, and so modest a custodian of insights and craftsmanship of the past.” That sums it up nicely.

You have to reach back to the great 1947s for any worthy comparison.



Huet is one of the grand and historical estates of the Loire. When they hit a special vintage, it's something that will be talked about for many, many decades to come. Huet Moelleux from great vintages are all but immortal.

1989 was one such vintage. It's a magical vintage - the wines are mind-blowingly layered and beautifully elegant.

Along with their usual bottlings, the superlative vintage inspired Huet to issue stunning experimental bottlings, many of which were released

in exceedingly small quantities, as few as three hundred bottles in some cases. While 1989 was a very low botrytis vintage, many of these special bottlings represent amazingly clear and nimble examples of botrytis.

There's Clos du Bourg "Essai," from their experimental biodynamic plot, and for comparison, "Temoin" is intended to be a "reference" or control from a non-biodynamic parcel. They also bottled the first and last pressings of Le Mont.

1989 Huet Haut Lieu Moelleux \$99.95

The Haut Lieu site sports a fairly deep tuffeau bed-rock topped with brown clay and chalk; its reputation is for wines that are supple and generous. This was the first vineyard that the Huet family bought back in 1928.

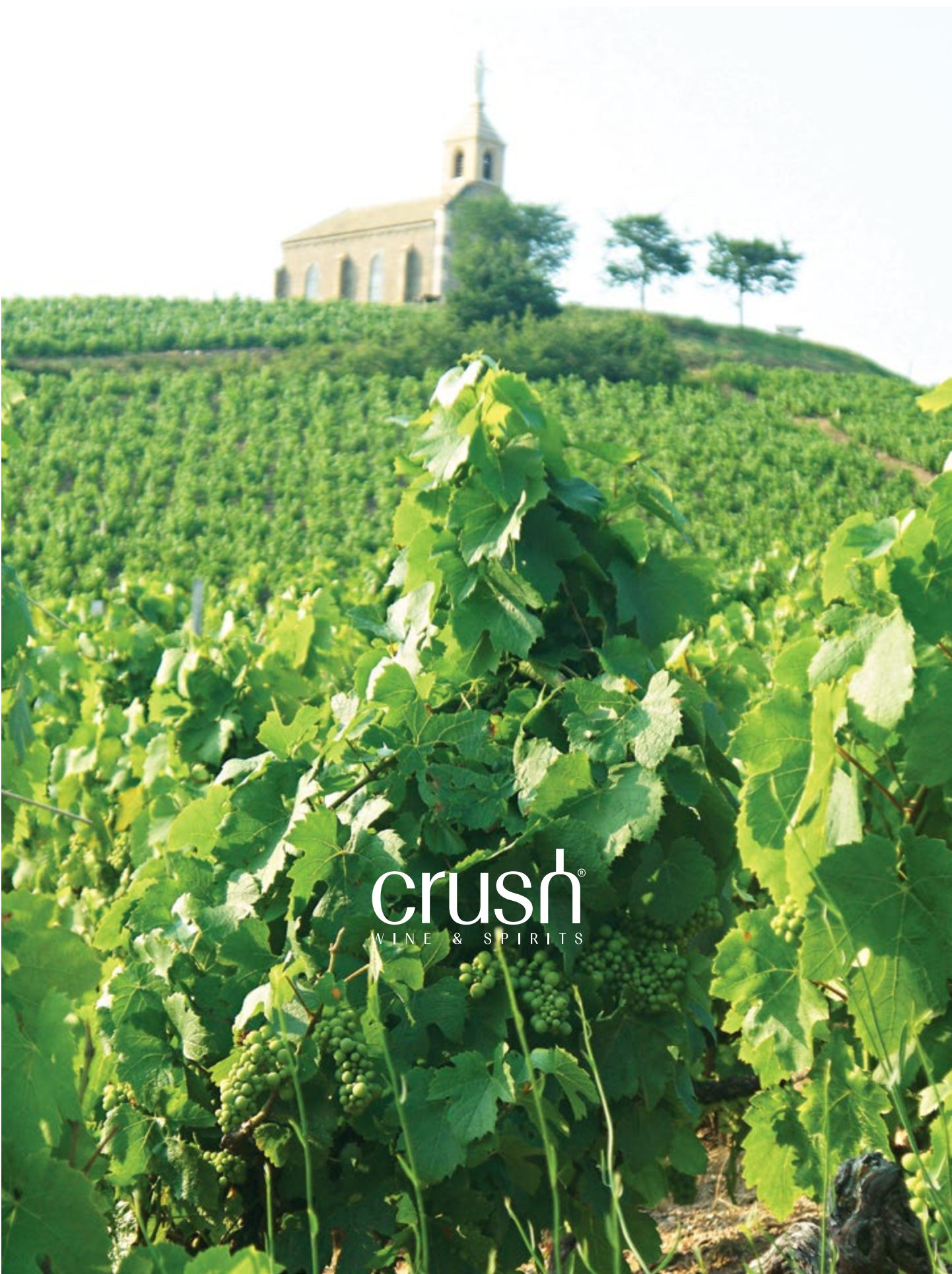
