CSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LIZ COYNE

Rosemont - So - F

West Chester, Pa./Downingtown West Coyne led the Ravens to three wins on the week, averaging 26.0 points and 13.7 rebounds, while shooting .592 from the field. In Monday's non-conference win over Penn State-Berks, the sophomore posted 26 points, 11 rebounds, five steals, and four assists. Two nights later, in a CSAC win over Notre Dame (Md.), she went for 24 points (on 11-for-15 shooting) with 14 rebounds in 24 minutes of action. In Saturday's victory over Neumann, Coyne wrapped up the week with 28 points and 16 rebounds for her seventh double-double.

Mang led Marywood to a 3-0 week, including a 2-0 mark in conference play, as she averaged 21.3 points with a .527 field goal percentage. In Monday's win over previously unbeaten Misericordia, Mang scored 24 points, with five assists, five rebounds, and four steals. In Wednesday's win over Baptist Bible, Mang scored 19 points, going 9-for-12 from the floor, before she wrapped up the week with 21 points and three steals, in just 20 minutes of action, in a win over Notre Dame (Md.).

SHEA WASSEL

Gwynedd-Mercy - So - F

North Wales, Pa./Landsdale Catholic

Wassel averaged 16.5 points and 11.5 rebounds in two conference wins for the Griffins. In Wednesday's 89-75 win over Neumann, she recorded a 21-point, 14-rebound double-double, shooting 8-for-13 from the floor. In Saturday's 66-65 victory at Keystone, Wassel scored 12 points, while adding nine rebounds, four assists, two steals, and two blocks.

BAPTIST BIBLE (1-7, 1-3 CSAC)

After winning their CSAC opener on Dec. 1st, the Lady Defenders dropped three games this past week... Keystone College won 54-35 on Monday night and Marywood won on Wednesday 90-49. In their final home game before the break, Cabrini defeated BBC 74-46... The Lady Defenders will travel to Lancaster Bible College on Saturday for their final game of the first semester.

CABRINI (5-2, 3-0 CSAC)



The Cavaliers captured three CSAC wins last week to improve to 5-2 on the year... The Blue and White used a balanced offense and tough defense and rebounding in the wins. Junior **Brittany Sandone** led Cabrini with 14 points and 4.3 assists per game, while sophomore **Amber Keys**, who recorded a career high 20 points and 11 rebounds against Immaculata, posted 12.3 points and 7.0 rebounds... Cabrini held its opponents to 33% shooting and maintained a +50 rebound advantage on the week... The Cavaliers will take a break from competition for finals and return to action on December 17 when they travel to Delaware Valley College.



CAIRN (0-6, 0-3 CSAC)

The Highlanders put forth a fantastic shooting display in the 2nd half of their road game against Cedar Crest College but their comeback bid fell just short, 53-60. **Ruth Nelson** had 15 rebounds in the loss, while **Hayley Weber** went 3-for-3 from long range... Earlier in the week, Cairn lost to Immaculata 34-66... **Hannah McCardle** had a strong showing, averaging 17.5 pts/gm this week, while Nelson averaged 11 rebounds... The Highlanders will be off for the holiday break until hosting Eastern Mennonite on Dec. 29th.

CEDAR CREST (2-8, 1-1 CSAC)



The Falcons went 1-2 overall (1-1 CSAC) on the week... **Amby Wehry** scored 13 points to lead Cedar Crest in a 92-35 defeat to Neumann on Monday... The Falcons rebounded with a 60-53 win over Cairn on Wednesday. **Kayleigh Keggan** had 17 points, going 3-for-3 long range, while posting a team-high five assists... Cedar Crest stepped out of conference on Saturday, and were edged 64-58 by Penn State-Abington. **Megan DeMutis** narrowly missed a double-double, with 19 points and nine rebounds, while she added four steals...The Falcons are now idle for the holiday break until a January 5th matchup with Notre Dame (Md.)



CENTENARY (1-9, 0-4 CSAC)

The Cyclones picked up their first win of the under new Head Coach **Rachel Weidensaul** on Monday as they took down New Jersey City University 52-46 at home... Following the win, the Cyclones dropped a pair of games to conference foes Keystone College and Immaculata University, but look toward the upcoming break as a time to regroup and gain back their momentum moving forward with two games upcoming at the end of December.

GWYNEDD-MERCY (5-2, 3-0 CSAC)



Gwynedd-Mercy defeated visiting Neumann 89-75 on Wednesday night. **Shea Wassel** had game-highs of 21 points and 14 rebounds, as she was one of five Griffins to hit double digits. **Natasha Matthews** also posted a double-double, with 19 points and 10 boards... The Griffins held off Keystone 66-65 on Saturday to win their third straight CSAC contest. Matthews, and **Lauren Smith** each had 16 points, while Wassel scored 12 points and grabbed nine rebounds to go with a career-best four assists, as well as two blocks and two steals. Smith connected on four of the team's five treys... Gwynedd-Mercy is off until Saturday, when they host Emory & Henry out of the Old Dominion Athletic Conference.



IMMACULATA (4-4, 3-1 CSAC)

Immaculata had its three-game winning streak ended at Cabrini on Wednesday, 73-52... However, the Mighty Macs were able to rebound with a comeback win against Centenary on Saturday, 70-66, to cap the 2012 portion of the CSAC slate.... Immaculata began the week with a 66-34 win against Cairn. **Sara Smith** led Immaculata in scoring against both Cairn (18) and Cabrini (8), and finished the week averaging 14.3 points per game. **Chrissy Esbensen** posted 22 points in the win against Centenary to average 13.3 points for the week. **Katie Durkin** recorded five blocked shots opposite the Cyclones, which was the most blocks by an IU player against a CSAC opponent since *Leah Kuczynski* also blocked five shots against Centenary on Feb. 21, 2011.

KEYSTONE (5-2, 2-1 CSAC)

Keystone opened CSAC play with a 54-35 win over Baptist Bible on Monday. **Chantel Blake** led the Giants with 10 points and added seven rebounds, as did **Jenna Downs**. **Jazmyn Robinson** led all players with six steals and **Alexis Jones** and **Tiana Cuttino** led the team with four assists apiece... Robinson led the Giants with 15 points and Downs added a double-double on 12 points and 10 rebounds to lift Keystone to a 59-53 win at Centenary on Wednesday... Cuttino led the Giants with 14 points and Robinson added 13 points and six assists on Saturday against Gwynedd-Mercy, but the Giants dropped a tight, 66-65 decision to the Griffins.



MARYWOOD (5-3, 2-0 CSAC)

Marywood extended its winning streak to four games with three victories on the week... **Brittany Mang** scored 24 points and tallied four steals in a win (67-57) over previously undefeated Misericordia... The Pacers posted wins in their first two CSAC contests with 40-plus point victories over Baptist Bible (90-49) and Notre Dame (Md.) (77-33). Marywood held the Defenders to a 32.1 field goal percentage and the Gators to a 21.6 shooting percentage in their CSAC wins... The Pacers are off until Monday, Dec. 17 when they host No. 13 Lebanon Valley.

NEUMANN (2-5, 2-2 CSAC)

Neumann went 1-2 in conference action last week... On Monday, the Knights picked up a convincing 92-35 win at Cedar Crest. **Bethany Humenik** netted 18 points while **Brittany Wood** had 13. All 16 members contributed to the scoring... In an 89-75 loss to Gwynedd-Mercy, **Erica Marvel** scored 17 points... In the first home conference game, the Knights fell to the Ravens 87-68. Marvel again led the team with 14 points... Neumann is off until after finals when they host Manhattanville on December 17.



NOTRE DAME (0-9, 0-5 CSAC)

Freshman **Marissa White** led the team in points and rebounding twice this past week... White had a career day against Marywood on Saturday, putting up career highs in points, 12, and rebounds, 8... Sophomore **Marylu Ortiz** recorded eight rebounds in the team's game with Rosemont... The Gators are now idle for the holiday break until a January 5th conference match up with Cedar Crest College.

ROSEMONT (5-4, 3-0 CSAC)

The last time the Ravens had a four game winning streak was between 11/22/2005 and 12/03/2005. Rosemont's three wins this week were impressive, defeating all of their opponents by an average of 33 points... **Liz Coyne** averaged 26 points for the week and added three more double-doubles to her résumé, making it seven double-doubles in nine games played... Rosemont's win at Neumann on Saturday snapped a 14-game winning streak that the Knights held against Rosemont.
