Rosemont - Sr - G/F
Aston, Pa./Sun Valley



Montecchio had a big week for the 1-1 Ravens, averaging 33.5 points, 13.0 rebounds, and 4.0 blocked shots. In Tuesday's defeat to Lancaster Bible, she eclipsed a 21-year old Rosemont record by scoring 37 points, while also adding game-highs with 12 rebounds, five steals, and three blocks. In Thursday's 71-60 CSAC win over Centenary, Montecchio led all players with 30 points, 14 rebounds, and five blocks.

CSAC HONOR ROLL

SHEA WASSEL

Gwynedd-Mercy - Sophomore - Forward North Wales, Pa./Landsdale Catholic

Wassel led the Griffins to a 2-0 week, averaging 15.5 points and 7.5 rebounds. In Monday's 80-70 win over King's, she tied a career high with 23 points, going 7-for-12 from the floor and 9-for-12 from the line, while adding seven rebounds and two blocks. In Saturday's CSAC win over Centenary, she totaled eight points and eight rebounds, along with two steals and a block.

JACKIE DEEGLER

Immaculata - Senior - Forward Bensalem, Pa./Bensalem

Deegler averaged 17.5 points and shot .593 (16-for-27) from the floor to help Immaculata to a 2-0 week. After scoring 10 points in Monday's conference win over Notre Dame (Md.), she erupted for 25 points, on a 12-for-19 effort from the floor, in just 24 minutes in Wednesday's win over Penn State-Berks.

BAPTIST BIBLE (1-4, 1-0 CSAC)

The Lady Defenders opened up CSAC play by defeating Notre Dame of Maryland University for their first win of the season. After averaging 43 ppg over the first four games of the year, BBC had an offensive outburst, defeating the Gators 85-53. Five Lady Defenders scored in double digits, led by **Chi Boggs'** 19 points... The team hopes to continue its winning ways in the CSAC as it takes on Keystone College, Marywood University and Cabrini College this week.

CABRINI (2-2, 0-0 CSAC)



The Cavaliers fell to 2-2 on the season after losing at Scranton, 57-53. A **Brittany Sandone** three tied the score at 37 with 7:28 on the clock, but the Royals tallied five quick points to take a lead they would not relinquish. Sandone matched a career-high five three pointers, en route to 19 points. Junior **Colleen Stewart** added a career-best 15 points in the loss.



CAIRN (0-4, 0-1 CSAC)

The Highlanders are still searching for their first win of the season, as they have opened their 2012-2013 season with four straight losses.... This past week saw Cairn drop decisions to non-conference Penn St.-Abington, 32-63, and CSAC foe Neumann University, 55-87. **Hannah McCardle** has been a bright spot and the team's most consistent threat, as she averaged 16 points per game for the week.

CEDAR CREST (1-6, 0-0 CSAC)



The Falcons dropped to 1-6 after going 0-3 on the week... In Tuesday's 75-53 loss to Penn St-Harrisburg, **Amber Wehry** scored 19 points, with **Megan DeMutis** adding 12... On Thursday, Cedar Crest fell 82-50 to St. Joseph's-Brooklyn. **Danielle Spingola** led the Falcons with 14 points... Cedar Crest wrapped up the week with an 80-49 defeat to St. Elizabeth. Wehry narrowly missed a double-double, scoring a game-high 25 points to go with eight rebounds... The Falcons open CSAC play this week, with games vs. Neumann (Mon) and Cairn (Wed), before facing Penn St-Abington on Saturday.



CENTENARY (0-7, 0-2 CSAC)

Danielle Trucksess led Centenary in points in two of the Cyclones three games this week as she scored 12 and 16, versus NYU and Rosemont, respectively. The Cyclones went 0-3 on the week, despite Trucksess' efforts... Centenary will once again be tested with three games this week as the Cyclones host New Jersey City on Monday and Keystone on Wednesday, before heading back on the road to face Immaculata on Saturday.

GWYNEDD-MERCY (3-2, 1-0 CSAC)



Gwynedd-Mercy defeated King' 80-70 on Monday night, behind four players in double figures and 12 three-pointers. **Shea Wassel** led all scorers with 23 points, tying a career high. **Lauren Smith** knocked down four treys to finish with 16 points. **Kristen Fuery** and **Kelsey Yori** each knocked down three long balls apiece, as each scored in double figures, with 13 and 11 points respectively... The Griffins won their CSAC opener on Saturday, defeating Centenary, 81-34. Fuery scored 11 points and **Jackie Crowley** added 10 as GM had their entire lineup register a point. Gwynedd hit eight of its 10 three-pointers in the first half, to help start the game on a 42-4 run. **Cara McArdle** led the Griffins with a career-high 10 rebounds and dished out six assists... Gwynedd-Mercy will welcome Neumann on Wednesday as part of a CSAC doubleheader, as the women tip it off at 6:00pm.



IMMACULATA (2-3, 1-0 CSAC)

Immaculata is on a two-game winning streak after winning both its contests last week... The Mighty Macs began the CSAC slate with a 94-29 win against Notre Dame, and Immaculata defeated Penn State Berks, 68-37, in non-league action... **Chrissy Esbensen** became the 21st IU women's basketball player to reach the 1,000 career point mark after netting 23 points in the win opposite Notre Dame. The Mighty Macs shot 55.9 percent (38-68) from the field, and were 16-for-17 (.941) from the free throw line. It was their highest shooting percentage from the field since Dec. 8, 2008, when the Mighty Macs were 24 of 42 (.571) against Marywood... **Jackie Deegler** scored 25 points for the Mighty Macs against PSU-Berks. It marked a career best for the senior and the most points scored by an Immaculata player this season.

KEYSTONE (3-1, 0-0 CSAC)

The Giants got a game-high 21 points from **Tiana Cuttino**, who went 4-5 from three-point range, and 13 points off the bench from **Charlene Hook**, on their way to a 71-59 victory at Cazenovia College on Tuesday night as the Giants won their third-straight game heading into CSAC play. **Chantel Blake** led the team with 12 rebounds as Keystone held a 51-33 advantage on the glass for the game... Keystone opens up conference play with three games this week, facing Baptist Bible on Monday, Centenary on Wednesday, and Gwynedd-Mercy on Saturday.



MARYWOOD (2-3, 0-0 CSAC)

Marywood began the week by nearly upsetting Scranton (60-73) and stayed within a possession of the undefeated Royals until late in the second half... On Friday, the Pacers outscored Penn State-Hazleton by 26 points in the second half to get back to the win column (66-39). **Carly Leitzel** produced a double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds in the win, and **Brittany Mang** manufactured her fourth consecutive double-digit scoring affair with 16 points against the Lions.

NEUMANN (1-3, 1-0 CSAC)

Neumann picked up its first win of the season, 87-55, at Cairn University. The win was a total team effort, as all 16 players put points on the board. **Colleen Hinde** and **Jessica Schlesman** led the Knights with 10 points each... The Knights have three conference games this week, starting with Cedar Crest and Gwynedd-Mercy on the road before hosting Rosemont on Saturday.



NOTRE DAME (0-6, 0-2 CSAC)

Freshman **Briawna Jones** scored a career high 27 points in a conference matchup with Baptist Bible College on Saturday, while also posting a team-high three assists... Against Wesley on Wednesday, **Shaun-de' Jones** grabbed eight rebounds to lead the Gators... **Marissa Wright** posted a team-best five stals in Notre Dame's conference opener against Baptist Bible on Monday... The Gators play a trio of conference games this week, with home contests with Cabrini (Mon) and Marywood (Sat) sandwiched around a Wednesday road game at Rosemont.

ROSEMONT (2-4, 1-0 CSAC)

The Ravens split their games this week, including a win in their first conference game of the season... **Ashley Montecchio** set a new Rosemont record, scoring 37 points, and **Liz Coyne** scored 19 in the Raven's loss to Lancaster Bible on Tuesday... At Centenary, Rosemont set a new team record, converting 23 of 25 free throw attempts (92%) while Montecchio scored 30 and Coyne added 17 as the Birds held off the Cyclones down the stretch to earn the 71-60 victory. It was the fourth double-double of the season for each player... This week, Rosemont has a busy slate, traveling to Penn St-Berks (Mon), hosting Notre Dame of Md. (Wed), and visiting Neumann (Sat).
