CSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK



LIZ COYNE

Rosemont College

Fr - F/C - West Chester, PA/Downingtown West

Coyne closed out the season with a big week, leading the Ravens to a pair of victories. The freshman averaged 13.5 points and 9.5 rebounds, while going 9-for-12 from the foul line. In Monday's win over Valley Forge Christian, she went for 34 points, on a 16-for-24 effort from the field, while adding 10 rebounds. Two nights later, in an 83-69 victory over

Philadelphia Biblical, Coyne narrowly missed her second straight double-double, going for 13 points and nine rebounds, including seven on the offensive glass.

CSAC HONOR ROLL

Kelly Brown - Sr - G/F - Immaculata University

Brown averaged 16.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, and 3.0 steals as Immaculata posted a 2-0 week, clinching the third seed in the upcoming CSAC Championship Tournament. In the Mighty Macs' 68-66 win at Marywood on Monday, Brown netted 11 points, with five rebounds and five assists. Two nights later, in a 66-46 win at Notre Dame (MD), Brown went for a game-high 22 points, including the 1,000th of her career, while adding seven boards and four steals.

Jazmyn Robinson - Fr - G - Keystone College

Robinson propelled Keystone to a pair of wins, putting together a strong all-around week. The freshman point guard averaged 17.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists, and 4.0 steals. In the Giants' 55-50 upset of Baptist Bible on Monday, she scored 14 points, with six rebounds and four assists, before closing the season with 21 points, five rebounds, five steals, and three assists in a 81-67 win over Cedar Crest.

CSAC NORTH BASKETBALL NOTES



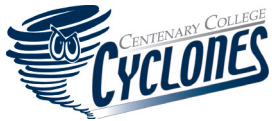
Baptist Bible Defenders (17-7, 12-4 CSAC)

The Lady Defenders went 1-1 in their final week of the regular season... Keystone upset BBC on Monday night, defeating them 55-50... Needing a win to gain a first round bye in the playoffs, the Lady Defenders overpowered the Knights of Neumann 85-71 on Wednesday. **Kacee Rava** recorded her 10th consecutive double double scoring 18 points and grabbing 15 rebounds.



Cedar Crest Falcons (7-18, 4-12 CSAC)

On Wednesday, Cedar Crest lost their season finale at home to Keystone, 81-67. Without Lizzy Sunderhaus, this was somewhat of a preview of next season, and sophomore **Amber Wehry** did not disappoint. Wehry led all scorers with a career-high 27 points including five three-pointers and led all rebounders with 14 boards. The Falcons kept the game within reach until just before halftime, when turnovers and some cold shooting allowed the Giants to put the game out of reach. Play was even in the second half, but the Falcons couldn't overcome their first-half deficit.



Centenary Cyclones (14-11, 7-9 CSAC)

The Cyclones finished the 2011-12 regular season with a 67-52 loss at Marywood on Wednesday. Centenary was led by **Danielle Trucksess** who produced 14 points and 9 rebounds including going 2-for-6 from three point range and 4-4 from the foul line.

Keystone Giants (11-14, 8-8 CSAC)



The Giants wrapped up their season on a four game winning streak to finish at .500 in the conference. **Jazmyn Robinson** capped off a great week leading the team in the scoring column in both games. One of the wins was a hard fought affair against Northern Division champion Baptist Bible. The team, along with the men's program, participated in the athletic department's annual "Pink" game breast cancer fundraiser, as the Giants raised \$3000 for the American Cancer Society.



Marywood Pacers (17-8, 12-4 CSAC)

Trailing by as many as 17 points in the second half, Marywood's rally fell just short against Immaculata on Monday night as the Pacers fell 68-66. **Maggie Presnal** scored a career-high 20 points in the loss and **Mariah Schaeffer** netted 10 points and moved into fifth place on Marywood's all-time scoring list...The Pacers locked up the #4 seed in the CSAC playoffs with a 67-52 win over Centenary on Wednesday. **Allison Bruet** recorded a double-double on a game-high 17 points and 10 rebounds.

Philadelphia Biblical Crimson Eagles (4-21, 1-15 CSAC)



The Crimson Eagles wrapped up the regular season with a hard-fought 83-69 loss to the Ravens of Rosemont on Wednesday. **Haley Weber** led Philadelphia Biblical with 18 points, while teammate **Ruth Nelson** had a team high 13 rebounds.

CSAC SOUTH BASKETBALL NOTES



Cabrini Cavaliers (12-13, 10-6 CSAC)

The Cavaliers captured the #5 seed in the CSAC tournament with their fifth consecutive win, a 71-60 win at Gwynedd-Mercy, on Wednesday. Sophomore **Brittany Sandone** led the Cabrini attack with 23 points, including 5-for-7 from three-point range. Fellow sophomore **Colleen Stewart** tied a career-high with 12 points over the first place Griffins.

Gwynedd-Mercy Griffins (18-7, 14-2 CSAC)



Cabrini defeated Gwynedd-Mercy, 71-60, in the regular season finale Wednesday snapping the Griffin win streak at 13 games. With the loss the Griffins still remain the top seed for the upcoming CSAC Tournament and will host a semi-final contest Wednesday night at the Griffin Complex at 7 p.m. Prior to the game, Gwynedd-Mercy honored its seniors, **Brittany Neill** and **Bryn Cotteta**. Both scored in double figures on the night with Cotteta finishing with 11 and dishing out five assists and Neill adding 10 with six rebounds. **Jess Rotella** and **Shea Wassel** also led the Griffins with double-digit performances. Rotella led the Griffins in scoring, netting 19 points and pulling down eight rebounds. Wassel contributed a double-double with 16 points and 11 caroms.



Immaculata Mighty Macs (14-11, 12-4 CSAC)

Leah Kuczynski scored 21 points, and **Bridget Welz** added 20, as visiting Immaculata University defeated host Marywood University, 68-66, in CSAC action on Monday... The Mighty Macs closed out the regular season on Wednesday with a 66-46 win against Notre Dame. Immaculata also welcomed another member to the 1,000-point club as **Kelly Brown** netted 22 points to reach the milestone.

Neumann Knights (11-14, 10-6 CSAC)



Neumann wrapped up the regular season with an 85-71 loss at Baptist Bible. **Erica Marvel** and **Sami Borcky** each had 13 points. **Colleen Hinde** netted 12 and **Laura Scott** added 10. The Knights finish the regular season 11-14 overall and 10-6 in the conference and will head into the postseason as the No. 6 seed. Neumann will travel to Immaculata on Monday for first round action.



Notre Dame of MD Gators (0-23, 0-16 CSAC)

Imani Stokes and **India Scott** recorded double-doubles in a 66-46 loss to Immaculata on Wednesday, which wrapped up CSAC play for the Gators. Stokes had 13 points and a game-high 16 rebounds, while Scott had a team-high 15 points and pulled down 12 boards... On Saturday, the Gators fell to Valley Forge Christian College, 75-54, to wrap up the 2011-12 season. Stokes finished with a team-high 16 points and a game-high 20 rebounds for her 13th double-double of her freshman season, while Scott had 14 points and 10 rebounds. Freshman **Julicel Crisostomo** had a breakout game, with 7 points, 3 boards, and a team-high 4 steals, while senior **Dee Waters** contributed 5 rebounds, 3 assists, and 1 steal in her final game in a Gator uniform.

Rosemont Ravens (13-12, 6-10 CSAC)



The Ravens finished their season with a 2-0 week with both wins coming on the road...Rosemont's **Liz Coyne** shot 14-for-25 from the field and 6-for-6 from the line to score a career-high 34 points as the Ravens won at Valley Forge Christian, 61-55. Coyne also pulled down 10 off the glass for her 11th double-double of the year...In their finale, Rosemont placed all five of their starters in double-figures as the Ravens defeated the Philadelphia Biblical Crimson Eagles 83-69. **Ashley Montecchio** led all scorers with 23 while **Vanessa Johnson** ended her collegiate play as a force underneath, grabbing 19 rebounds along with her 16 points to earn her fourth double-double of the year... Rosemont's 13 wins matched the most wins in a season for the program, and it was the first time the team finished over the ".500" mark since the 2004-2005 campaign.

If the Griffins were to get past their semifinal opponent, they would go on to host the CSAC championship game on Saturday at 6pm... Under head coach **Keith Mondillo**, the Griffins are entering the playoffs for the 16th straight year. Gwynedd-Mercy has won five league titles under Mondillo, and have appeared in seven NCAA Tournaments. The Griffins were last a number one seed in the 2007-08 season.

Immaculata Mighty Macs

Immaculata earned the third seed in the 2012 Colonial States Athletic Conference Tournament and will host a quarterfinal round contest at Alumnae Hall on Monday at 7 p.m. The two teams split the regular season meetings with Neumann winning, 80-78, in overtime, and the Mighty Macs winning their home game against the Knights, 69-61. The two squads are familiar foes in the CSAC Tournament, meeting in the championship game just a season ago as Neumann edged Immaculata, 66-60, to claim its second straight CSAC title.

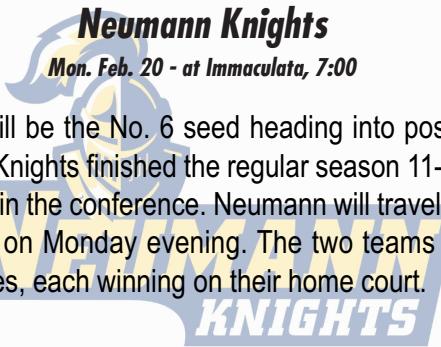
