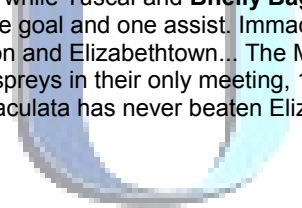
### **Gwynedd-Mercy Griffins (2-2)**

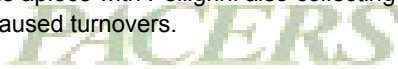
### **Immaculata Mighty Macs (0-4)**

Immaculata suffered a 13-8 loss to Albright and a 17-8 loss at Lebanon Valley in action last week. **Joey Shallow** scored three goals while **Ben Tuscai** added one goal and four assists for Immaculata against Albright... Against Lebanon Valley, Shallow again led the Mighty Macs with four goals and two assists for six points. **Taylor Acree** added one goal and two assists while Tuscai and **Bhelly Bagbonon** each finished with one goal and one assist. Immaculata next plays Richard Stockton and Elizabethtown... The Mighty Macs defeated the Ospreys in their only meeting, 15-11, last season, while Immaculata has never beaten Elizabethtown.

Cornella was sensational in goal, making 16 saves to earn the win while **John Pelligrini** and **Nick Johnson** recorded six groundballs apiece with Pelligrini also collecting a game-high five caused turnovers.

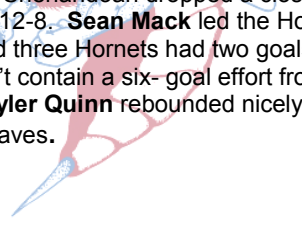
### **Rosemont Ravens (0-1)**
