Cabrini Cavaliers (5-2)

The Cavaliers stretched their win streak to four games with wins over #16 Gettysburg and FDU-The College at Florham. Cabrini's 8-1 win over Gettysburg was the first in school history over the Bullets. The Blue and White dominated play, outshooting the Bullets 37-18. **Bobby Thorp** led the Cavaliers with five points, on three goals and two assists. Thorp followed that with a six-point performance in Cabrini's 15-2 win over FDU-Florham. Senior **Brian Hill** joined Thorp with a hat trick, while freshman **Enrique Montoya** tallied a goal and four assists.

Centenary Cyclones (1-3)

The Cyclones fell 13-3 in a tough match against the #17 ranked Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute on Tuesday during a spring break matchup in Jupiter, Fla... This week, the Cyclones look to bounce back as they take to the road for two games, taking on Scranton on Wednesday before heading into CSAC action on Saturday at Immaculata University. With the two games ahead, the Cyclones are looking to bounce back into an even 3-3 record by week's end to put them in prime position to attack in the conference.

Gwynedd-Mercy Griffins (3-3)

Gwynedd went 1-1 last week in two close games. On Wednesday, two late goals in the fourth helped Marymount pull away from GM, 7-5. Sophomore **Nathan Pendleton** scored three times... On Saturday, the Griffins used an overtime goal from senior **Craig Trueblood** to knock off previously unbeaten Albright, 9-8.



Immaculata Mighty Macs (0-6)

Immaculata suffered a 27-8 loss to Richard Stockton and a 9-7 loss at Elizabethtown in non-conference action last week. **Jordon Smith** led Immaculata goal scorers with two goals while **Taylor Acree** added one goal and two assists to pace the Mighty Macs with three points against the Ospreys... Against Elizabethtown, **Joey Shallow** had a team-leading three goals while **Ben Tuscai**, **Ryan Cipriani** and Acree all finished with two points... Immaculata next plays Susquehanna on Wednesday, and opens CSAC action on Saturday hosting Centenary.

Marywood Pacers (3-2)

In Wednesday's home opener against King's College, **Sam Trill** recorded a game-high six points on four goals and two assists to lead the Pacers to a 10-6 win over the Monarchs in Marywood's home-opener. **Joe LaBella** added three goals in the victory while **Nicholas Cornella** made 13 saves in net to pick up the win. **Marcus Janda** recorded six points on three goals and three assists while Trill (3 goals) and **Jon Roerden** (1 goal, 2 assists) added three points apiece to lead Marywood to a 13-6 win over Richard Stockton College on Saturday.



Neumann Knights (3-4, 1-0 CSAC)

Neumann beat Rosemont College in its first conference game of the season 22-8. The Knights took a commanding 16-1 lead going into halftime, as **Mike Pantalone** scored five goals... The Knights lost to Utica College 19-11 and **Sam Maldou** led the team in points (2 G, 3 A). Utica took a 10-8 halftime lead, and then scored five fourth quarter goals to secure the victory... The Knights were defeated by Messiah College 13-5 and **Andrew Neubauer** made 15 saves in the loss. The Knights gave up two goals in the last two minutes of the first quarter to trail 3-2... Neumann will travel for their only match of the week against non-conference Albright College on Saturday.

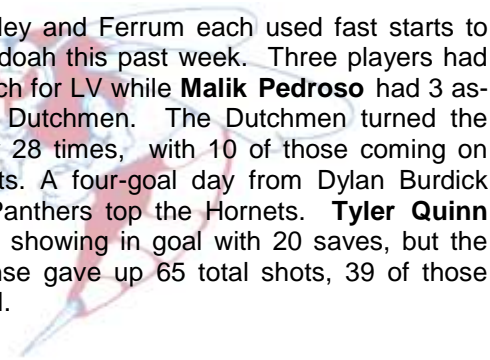
Rosemont Ravens (0-3, 0-1 CSAC)

The historic first season continued for the Ravens as they hosted the first game in the program's history, a 20-8 defeat to Alvernia University... Earlier in the week the team lost the first CSAC game played by the program, with Neumann bettering the Ravens 22-8... Freshman midfielder **Dean Grisoff** had a strong week, credited with 40 ground balls in the two games and winning 36 of 62 faceoffs (.581).



Shenandoah Hornets (0-8)

Lebanon Valley and Ferrum each used fast starts to beat Shenandoah this past week. Three players had two goals each for LV while **Malik Pedroso** had 3 assists for the Dutchmen. The Dutchmen turned the Hornets over 28 times, with 10 of those coming on clear attempts. A four-goal day from Dylan Burdick helped the Panthers top the Hornets. **Tyler Quinn** had a strong showing in goal with 20 saves, but the Hornet defense gave up 65 total shots, 39 of those being on goal.
