## AROUND THE LEAGUE

### **Cabrini Cavaliers (6-2, 1-0 CSAC)**

The Cavaliers stretched their win streak to five games with a dominant 24-1 win over Shenandoah on Saturday... Fifteen players found the net, but the story of the day was senior **Brian Hill**. The senior recorded career highs in goals (5), assists (4) and points (9). He also became the 6th Cavalier to surpass the 100 career goal playeau.

### **Centenary Cyclones (2-4, 1-0 CSAC)**

The Cyclones opened up conference play this week with a hard fought 11-9 victory over Immaculata on Saturday after suffering a tough 13-8 loss to Scranton earlier in the week... Centenary was led by junior **Robert Nuzzolese** who finished the week with eight goals and an assist, including a six goal performance against the Mighty Macs. This week, the Cyclones look to pick up two more conference wins with matchups against Gwynedd-Mercy on Wednesday and their home opener against Marywood on Saturday afternoon.

### **Gwynedd-Mercy Griffins (4-4, 0-1 CSAC)**

The Griffins got defensive in an 11-5 win at DeSales on Tuesday, allowing just one second-half goal. Senior **Craig Trueblood** led all attackers with four goals. **Nick Coan** and **Dustan Mangin** added a score and three assists apiece... Marywood would nip Gwynedd on Saturday, 9-8, in the conference opener for both teams. Trueblood added two goals in the loss.

### **Immaculata Mighty Macs (0-8, 0-1 CSAC)**

Immaculata opened the Colonial States Athletic Conference slate with an 11-9 loss to Centenary on Saturday... The Mighty Macs had also lost a non-conference game at Susquehanna (19-7) earlier in the week... Against the Cyclones, the Mighty Macs were led by **Joey Shallow's** three goals and two assists. **Mike Boyd** recorded two goals, and **Jordon Smith**, **Ben Tuscai** and **Bhelly Bagbonon** all finished with one goal and one assist each. Immaculata is on the road for two games this week, a non-league game at King's on Wednesday before returning to conference play opposite Neumann on Saturday.

### **Marywood Pacers (4-3, 1-0 CSAC)**

**Brandon Terlizzi** scored a pair of goals and **Sam Trill** added a goal and an assist as the Pacers suffered a 16-6 loss to fifth-ranked Amherst College on Tuesday night. Goalie **Nicholas Cornella** made 10 saves in the loss while **Nick Johnson** led the team with four caused turnovers and four groundballs... Marywood got three points apiece from **Marcus Janda** and Trill in a 9-8 win over Gwynedd-Mercy in Saturday's CSAC opener. Cornella made 16 saves to pick up the win in net for the Pacers.

### **Neumann Knights (3-5, 1-0 CSAC)**

Neumann dropped its only game this week against non-conference Albright College 21-7 on Saturday. The Knights were down 6-3 after the first quarter and 12-5 at halftime... **Sam Maldou** and **Ryan O'Kane** had three points to lead the Knights. **Alex Becker** made 12 saves... The Knights have two CSAC games this week, traveling to Shenandoah on Wednesday before hosting Immaculata on Saturday.

### **Rosemont Ravens (0-5, 0-1 CSAC)**

In a "Battle of the Birds" the Eagles of Eastern University won convincingly over the Ravens, 22-2. In Rosemont's second game of the week, the Lebanon Valley Dutchmen cruised to a 20-3 victory over the Ravens... **Dean Grisoff** continues racking up ground balls, adding another 27 this week, giving him 76 on the season (15.2/game).

### **Shenandoah Hornets (0-9, 0-1 CSAC)**

Shenandoah faced nationally ranked Cabrini College this past week and Cabrini lived up to its ranking. This game marked the start of Shenandoah's last season in the CSAC. Cabrini held Shenandoah scoreless for the first 47 minutes of the contest with Shenandoah's lone goal coming from **Bryan Pope**. Brian Hill led the attack for the Cavaliers, scoring 5 goals and dishing out 4 assists with a total of 9 points on the day... Shenandoah is back in action twice this week versus CSAC opponents Neumann and Gwynedd-Mercy.
