AROUND THE LEAGUE

Cabrini Cavaliers (10-2, 4-0 CSAC)

The Cavaliers improved to 10-2 with a 24-5 win over Immaculata on Senior Day. After honoring seniors **Joe Arrell, Brian Hill, John McSorley** and **Andrew Zelin-ski**, Hill led the way with four goals and an assists. Sixteen Cavaliers tallied goals in the win, including junior **Andres Layne's** hat trick.

Centenary Cyclones (4-7, 2-3 CSAC)

The Cyclones picked up a must-needed win against CSAC foe Shenandoah University on Saturday as they defeated the Hornets 9-4. Leading the way was the offensive trio of **Cameron Gunn, Conor Nolan**, and **Robert Nuzzolese** who combined for eight goals and five assists in the victory. **Steve Orsini** also recorded his 100th career faceoff win in the game while picking up a goal, a caused turnover, and 18 groundballs on the day for the Cyclones... Moving forward, the Cyclones take on Drew University on Wednesday before returning to conference play on Saturday against Rosemont.

Gwynedd-Mercy Griffins (8-4, 4-1 CSAC)

Nineteen different Griffins registered a goal as Gwynedd-Mercy won its fifth game in a row defeating Rosemont, 28-3, setting game records for most goals scored on Senior Day. Prior to the game, **Ben Brown, Nick Coan, Stefan Hetland, Zach Richter, Craig Trueblood, Ryan Bracalenti, Corey Lutts, Jon-Eric Lane**, and **Michael Henry** all were honored in a pregame ceremony. The nine seniors were the first recruiting class in the program's short history and helped lay the foundation of the Griffin Men's Lacrosse Team for years to come.

Immaculata Mighty Macs (2-11, 2-3 CSAC)

Immaculata went 1-1 in CSAC play last week with a 31-9 win at Rosemont before falling to league-leader Cabrini, 24-5... The Mighty Macs shattered five team records and two more individual marks during their win over the Ravens. Immaculata's 31 goals, 44 points and 22-point margin of victory were all school records, as was the Mighty Macs' 65 ground balls in the contest. **Joey Shallow** finished the game with 10 points to establish a new school mark. His seven assists on the day also tied the school record as well. In all, nine different Mighty Macs scored a goal, led by six goals from **Ben Tuscai** and **Ryan Cipriani**.

Marywood Pacers (7-5, 4-1 CSAC)

The Pacers surrendered two goals in the final 1:15 in a 10-8 loss at Susquehanna University on Wednesday. **Sam Trill** scored four goals to lead Marywood while Marcus Janda added three points on two goals and one assist. **Nicholas Cornella** made 13 saves in the loss. Marywood scored three goals in the final 2:17 to rally for a 13-12 win over Neumann on Saturday with **Joe La-Bella** scoring the game-winner with just 15 seconds left in regulation. **Riley Dobel**, who set up the game-winning goal, also added four goals for a five point game to lead the Pacers, who got eight saves from Cornella in the win.

Neumann Knights (4-8, 2-3 CSAC)

Neumann lost its only game of the week to Marywood, 13-12, on Saturday. In a wild game that saw the Knights down 6-3 at halftime, Neumann drew level 9-9 at the end of three quarters. **Mike Pantalone** would score his fourth and fifth goals at the beginning of the fourth quarter to take a 11-9 lead. The Knights took a 12-10 lead with less than three minutes left in the game, but the Pacers would score three goals in the final 2:13 to win 13-12. **Andrew Neubauer** saved 20 shots in the game... The Knights will play at Wesley on Wednesday and then they host Cabrini on Saturday.

Rosemont Ravens (0-10, 0-4 CSAC)

The Ravens went 0-2 on the week, falling 31-9 to Immaculata on Monday and 28-3 to Gwynedd-Mercy on Saturday... The nine goals scored against the Mighty Macs mark the highest output by the first-year Ravens so far... **Dean Grisoff** continues to rake in the ground balls, notching 33 for the two games combined this week.

Shenandoah Hornets (2-12, 1-4 CSAC)

On Saturday, host Centenary rode a strong first quarter to down the Hornets 9-4. Four of the nine goals Centenary would score on the day were in the first quarter, one of those with a man advantage. Shenandoah had man-up opportunities on a total of 4:30 in Centenary penalties but no one could capitalize... Shenandoah travels to Marywood this upcoming Saturday for another CSAC contest.
