Cabrini Cavaliers (11-2, 5-0 CSAC)

The Cavaliers posted a 22-4 win at Neumann in their only action of the week. Freshman **Damian Sobieski's** 4 goals led a balanced offense that featured 14 Cavaliers who found the net. Junior **Bobby Thorp** led the Blue and White attack with 6 points on 3 goals and 3 assists.

Centenary Cyclones (5-8, 3-3 CSAC)

The Cyclones picked up another vital conference win this week in a 25-4 victory over Rosemont, breaking the three-way tie for fourth place as they push ahead of both Immaculata and Neumann to take the spot. With a win over the Knights on Saturday, the Cyclones should earn themselves a spot in the CSAC Tournament this May, their first appearance since the 2009 season.

Gwynedd-Mercy Griffins (9-4, 5-1 CSAC)

Gwynedd-Mercy clinched a playoff berth after defeating Immaculata, 13-10, on Saturday for their fifth-straight win. Three goals each from junior **Roy Bakeoven** and sophomore **Nathan Pendleton** along with 11 saves from goalie **Ryley O'Keefe** helped pace Gwynedd to their ninth win on the year.

Immaculata Mighty Macs (2-12, 2-4 CSAC)

Immaculata fell in its only game last week to Gwynedd-Mercy, 13-10. The Mighty Macs scored three of the first four goals of the game for an early 3-1 lead but, the Griffins netted two goals just 19 seconds apart to tie the score at 3-3 after the first quarter. Gwynedd-Mercy led at halftime, 7-4. The Mighty Macs came within one goal of the Griffins (8-7) with 11:19 left in the third quarter. Unfortunately, after Gwynedd-Mercy scored four consecutive goals, Immaculata could not come any closer than the final three-goal margin at the end of the game. **Ben Tuscai** amassed six goals and one assist for seven points. **Joey Shallow** finished with a hat trick. IU goalkeeper **Max Bonhage** recorded 20 saves.

Marywood Pacers (8-6, 5-1 CSAC)

The Pacers suffered a 10-6 loss at cross-town rival the University of Scranton on Wednesday night. **Marcus Janda** led the Pacers' attack with two goals while defenseman **Nick Johnson** led all players with seven groundballs and four caused turnovers in the loss. **Nicholas Cornella** made 11 saves in the Pacers cage. **Riley Dobel** and **Greg Nester** both recorded hat tricks to lead Marywood to a 14-7 win over Shenandoah University on Saturday as the Pacers clinched home field advantage for the CSAC Semifinals.

Neumann Knights (5-9, 2-4 CSAC)

Neumann split two contests this week, picking up a win against Wesley and dropping a loss in CSAC action to Cabrini. Freshman sensation **Ryan O'Kane** led the Knights against Wesley in the win with five points (3 goals, 2 assist). **Andrew Neubauer** made 20 saves both games last week... The Knights travel to Centenary on Thursday and host La Roche on Saturday.

Rosemont Ravens (0-12, 0-5 CSAC)

The Ravens were overmatched last week, dropping a pair of games by identical 25-4 scores vs. Richard Stockton and Centenary.

Shenandoah Hornets (2-13, 1-5 CSAC)

Host Marywood used a strong third quarter to put away the Hornets this past Saturday. The Hornets managed to tie the score at 6 to end the half on goals by **Courtney Ledden** and **Bryan Pope**, but Marywood came out firing to start the second half. MU tallied six straight goals before the Hornets could answer but that was the deciding run. The Hornets were out-shot 56-28, but **Tyler Quinn** had a strong showing in goal with a career high 20 saves. SU is back in action to finish their CSAC membership this Thursday with a home contest against Immaculata.
