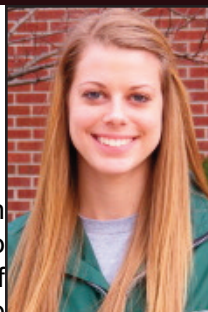

CSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kimberly Commisso - Marywood
Sophomore - Midfield
Milford, PA/Delaware Valley



After scoring three goals in a 22-11 win over Immaculata on Tuesday, Commisso scored seven goals, including the 100th of her collegiate career, to lead Marywood to a 20-11 victory over Lycoming College on Thursday. The sophomore then scored four goals as the Pacers clinched the top seed in the CSAC Playoffs with an 18-16 win over Centenary on Saturday. Commisso finished the week with 14 goals, 15 groundballs, 12 caused turnovers, and 20 draw controls.

In two Cabrini wins, Doubet posted 12 points, on nine goals and three assists. After going for two goals and two assists in Tuesday's win over Cedar Crest, Doubet exploded for a career-high seven goals, along with an assist, in Saturday's win over defending CSAC champ Gwynedd-Mercy.

Morgan Hosler - Sr - Att - Gwynedd-Mercy

Hosler registered 16 points, on 12 goals and four assists, in three games for the 2-1 Griffins. She scored four goals in each of the three games, while adding a career-high three assists in Thursday's win over King's College.

CSAC TOURNAMENT FIRST ROUND

Cabrini Cavaliers (7-8, 7-1 CSAC)

Cabrini secured a first round bye, and at least the #2 seed, in the upcoming CSAC tournament with a pair of conference wins this week... In Tuesday's 18-2 win at Cedar Crest, six Cavaliers scored two goals each... On Saturday, freshman **Lacie Doubet** set career highs with seven goals and eight points, leading the Blue and White to a 21-18 win over Gwynedd-Mercy.

Cedar Crest Falcons (1-14, 1-7 CSAC)

Cedar Crest's 2012 season drew to a close with two CSAC losses last week. After the previous week's first win of the season, there was reason for optimism that things were headed in the right direction, but the squad just seemed unable to get all the pieces in place in time to capture another victory... One highlight was senior **Tara Fikes'** 100th career goal, scored against Cabrini last week.

Centenary Cyclones (9-4, 5-3 CSAC)

The Cyclones dropped their only contest of the week, an 18-16 heartbreaking defeat to Marywood University. **Danielle Bay** scored seven goals in the game, as the Cyclones tied the game once and brought the game to within a one goal difference six times in the second half... This week, Centenary will host the College of Mount Saint Vincent in a makeup of a game that was postponed on Monday, 4/16.

Gwynedd-Mercy Griffins (7-7, 5-3 CSAC)

The Griffins had their five-game win streak come to an end in Saturday's loss at Cabrini. Senior **Brigid Dowling** registered a career-high seven goals in the loss... Earlier in the week, Gwynedd-Mercy had a strong first half in defeating Notre Dame, 17-8... Gwynedd celebrated Senior Day on Thursday, downing King's, 22-12. Five players had three or more goals, led by senior **Morgan Hosler** and freshman **Kelsey Yori** with four each.

Immaculata Mighty Macs (4-12, 2-6 CSAC)

Immaculata closed out the 2012 season last week posting a 1-2 overall and 1-1 mark in conference play... The Mighty Macs' secured an 18-1 win against Cedar Crest while they dropped their other CSAC contest to Marywood, 22-11... Immaculata was also topped by Arcadia, 13-9, in its other contest of the week... **Alyssa Petito** paced Immaculata with five goals and seven assists for 12 points during the three games. **Emily Hallett** scored eight goals and two assists for 10 points. Hallett also reached the 100 point mark for her career against Cedar Crest with four goals and one assist in the game.

Marywood Pacers (11-3, 7-0 CSAC)

Leading by one early in the second half, Marywood rattled off eight unanswered goals on their way to a 22-11 win over Immaculata on Tuesday night. **Taylor McKeown** and **Diana D'Achille** scored five goals apiece to lead Marywood and McKeown recorded the 300th point of her collegiate career in the win... **Kimberly Commisso** scored seven goals, including the 100th of her career, to lead the Pacers to a 20-11 win over Lycoming on Thursday. **Sarah Caughy** recorded the 100th point of her career by assisting on Commisso's 100th goal while D'Achille recorded eight points on five goals and three assists in the win... Commisso, D'Achille, and **Brooke Bondurant** each had four goals to lead Marywood to an 18-16 win over Centenary on Saturday as the Pacers clinched the top seed for the CSAC playoffs.

Neumann Knights (10-4, 5-2 CSAC)

Neumann went 2-0 last week, that included a victory over CSAC foe Notre Dame to give the Knights a 5-2 CSAC record... On Wednesday, **Alex Bohan** helped the Knights beat Bryn Mawr with a four goal performance, while **Amanda Fedak** led the way with three goals against Notre Dame... The Knights final regular season game is against league leaders Marywood on Monday at home.



Notre Dame of MD Gators (7-7, 3-5 CSAC)

On Tuesday, the Gators fell 17-8 to Gwynedd-Mercy. **Allison Terry**, currently 5th among Division III players in goals per game, led all scorers with five goals, while **Ashley Cumberland**, **Molly Murray**, and **Dee Waters** had one goal apiece for Notre Dame. **Katie Johnston** had a team-high five draw controls, while **Kate Donadio** led the Gators with 4 groundballs. **Mary Briggs** made 7 saves in goal... Two days later, the Gators snapped their two game skid with a 14-12 win over Bryn Mawr. Terry led all scorers with six goals and a team-high six groundballs, while also winning four draw controls... The Gators dropped their regular season CSAC finale at Neumann, 11-4, on Saturday. Terry had two goals, while Johnston had a team-high five groundballs and Cumberland had three draw controls. Briggs made 11 saves to close out the 2012 CSAC regular season with a 3-5 mark. Notre Dame last qualified for postseason play in 2010, when the #4 seeded Gators hosted Marywood, the #5 seed, in the CSAC quarterfinals.

Rosemont Ravens (0-13, 0-8 CSAC)

On Tuesday, the Arcadia Knights scored the first 10 goals of the game on their way to a rout of the Ravens in Rosemont.
