ANNIE RIVITUSO

Cabrini - Jr - Forward

Rivituso helped Cabrini to a 4-1 record over the holiday break. The junior forward averaged 10.2 points and 7.8 rebounds per game, scoring in double figures four times and grabbing seven or more rebounds in three of the contests. In two wins at the Land of Magic Classic, she averaged 11.0 points and 6.0 rebounds, before opening up the 2013 calendar year with a 12-point, 7-rebound performance in a win over Albright, and a 13-point, 16-board showing in Saturday's conference win over Keystone. She also totaled eight steals and three blocks in the five contests, as the Cabrini defense surrendered fewer than 50 points four times.

After posting 11 points and 11 rebounds in a Dec. 18th loss to Richard Stockton, she exploded for 20 points and 19 boards in a 70-66 win over Salisbury in the opening round of the Gettysburg Day's Inn Tournament. She wrapped up the week with seven points and nine boards in a tight defeat to Gettysburg in the tourney's championship.

BAPTIST BIBLE (1-9, 1-4 CSAC)

The Lady Defenders struggled against the Ravens of Rosemont on Saturday, as they lost 87-31. **Kelly Bargfeldt**

scored 14 points and accounted for a third of her team's field goals... BBC is in the middle of a five game losing streak but are looking to turn things around next this week as they host Cedar Crest at home on Monday night.

CABRINI (9-3, 4-0 CSAC)

After a disappointing loss at Delaware Valley, the Cavaliers have responded by winning their last four contests...

While juniors **Brittany Sandone** and **Annie Rivituso** have combined to average over 25 points in the last five games, the defense and rebounding that have been the keys to Cabrini's win streak. The Blue and White have held opponents to 31% shooting from the field, including less than 15% from three point range. The Cavaliers have also outrebounded its opposition by nearly 15 rebounds per game, with 21 offensive rebounds per game.



CAIRN (0-7, 0-4 CSAC)

Cairn continues to search for its first win of the season... The Highlanders played a pair of matches just prior to

New Year's Day... On Dec. 29, against out-of-staters Eastern Mennonite, the Highlanders fell 93-40. The next day at Arcadia, Cairn was defeated 75-48. **Hannah McArdle** posted 20 points in each game... Jumping back into the conference schedule, the Highlanders hosted the Pacers of Marywood on Thursday, but were defeated 68-25... After tonight's non-conference affair with Penn State-Hazleton, the Highlanders will host Gwynedd-Mercy on Wednesday and travel to Keystone on Saturday.

CEDAR CREST (2-9, 1-2 CSAC)

After a 27-day layoff over the holiday break, the Falcons returned to action on Saturday, falling on the road to conference foe Notre Dame (Md.) by a 38-34 score in a

defensive affair. **Amber Wehry** scored a team-high 18 points, while teammate **Kayleigh Keggan** grabbed 12 rebounds... Cedar Crest will play three CSAC games over the next six days, as they face Baptist Bible on Monday, Immaculata on Wednesday, and Neumann on Saturday.



CENTENARY (2-11, 0-4 CSAC)

With a tough three game homestead over the Christmas break, the Cyclones opened with a bang, earning their second

victory of the season as they dominated Wesley College 71-49 back on December 29th. Unfortunately for the Cyclones, the remainder of the break schedule was against two highly competitive programs in Moravian College and Kean University who both defeated the Cyclones... This week, the Cyclones look to earn their first CSAC victory on the road as they take on Baptist Bible College on Wednesday before heading to Maryland to take on Notre Dame on Saturday afternoon.

GWYNEDD-MERCY (7-4, 3-0 CSAC)

Richard Stockton ended Gwynedd-Mercy's five-game win streak at the Griffin Complex as the Griffins fell, 72-56. **Shea Wassel** collected her third double-double of the year, finishing with 11

point and 11 rebounds. **Nicole Dougherty** was the only other Griffin in double figures with 10 points. **Kristen Fuery** totaled eight points and added five assists... Gwynedd opened 2013 with a 70-66 win over Salisbury at the Days Inn Tournament hosted by Gettysburg. Wassel paced the offense with game highs of 20 points and 19 rebounds. Dougherty and **Lauren Smith** added 15 and 13 points respectively while **Natasha Matthews** chipped in 11. Wassel's 19 rebounds, along with her five assists, were a career high. Dougherty dished out a team-high seven assists while Smith tacked on five steals... The Griffins fell in the championship game of the tourney to host Gettysburg, 58-52. Matthews led GM with 15 points. **Jordan Dominic** added 13. Wassel posted seven points and nine boards in the game, and was named to the all-tournament team.

IMMACULATA (4-8, 3-1 CSAC)

Immaculata opens the 2013 portion of the season hosting Rowan in the Mighty Macs' final non-conference game of the season. Immaculata is hoping to snap its current four-game losing streak after dropping its two most recent contests at the ECAC Holiday Festival to Ramapo (59-47) and Saint Joseph's (LI), 63-61. Sophomore guard **Sara Smith** posted a career-high 20 points while freshman forward **Allison Murphy** grabbed a season-best 14 rebounds against St. Joe's... After a month off from league play, Immaculata also returns to CSAC action with two road contests at the end of the week at Cedar Crest and Marywood.

KEYSTONE (7-3, 2-2 CSAC)

Keystone closed the fall semester with a 98-47 win at Yeshiva University on December 18th with all 14 Giants recording points. **Tiana Cuttino** (13), **Valetta Richardson** (13), **Samantha Donahue** (12), and **Charlene Hook** (12) all scored double-digit points. **Frances Gonzalez** led Keystone with eight rebounds while **Jazmyn Robinson** added team season-highs of nine assists and eight steals in the win... Cuttino scored a game-high 19 points on Saturday, but it wasn't enough as the Giants dropped a 58-46 decision at Cabrini in the team's first game of the New Year. Jazmyn Robinson added a game-high six assists to go along with 10 rebounds and three assists.



MARYWOOD (6-5, 3-0 CSAC)

Marywood remained undefeated in CSAC play with a 68-25 win over Cairn on Thursday. The 25 points were the fewest allowed by Marywood in over six seasons... Some new faces instantly made an impact for Marywood over its last two games. **Nora Joyce**, a transfer from Susquehanna, scored 20 points in Saturday's loss to Delaware Valley, while **Danielle Terranella** came off the bench to score 13... The Pacers have a trio of conference games this week, hosting Keystone on Monday, traveling to Rosemont on Wednesday, and playing host to Immaculata on Saturday.

NEUMANN (4-8, 2-2 CSAC)

Neumann went 2-3 in non-conference games over the break. The Knights picked up a 54-49 win over Rowan on Dec. 20. **JoHanna Metzger** had 13 points for the Knights, who pulled away in the final minutes of the game for the win... At the Moravian Winter Classic, Neumann defeated Valley Forge Christian in the consolation game, 74-55. **Erica Marvel** hit 23 points, including six three-pointers. Metzger and **Bethany Humenik** each had 12 points... Neumann gets back into conference action this week with games against Cabrini and Cedar Crest.



NOTRE DAME (1-9, 1-5 CSAC)

The Gators picked up their first win of the season over Cedar Crest College on Saturday... Freshman **Kamelya Medina** scored a career high 19 points and recorded five steals in the effort... Sophomore **Shaun-de' Jones** recorded a career high 14 rebounds in the win, while sophomore **Marylu Ortiz** added nine and freshman **Danielle Hipkins** chipped in with eight... The game marked the first time the Gators have outrebounded an opponent, as Notre Dame owned a commanding 55-37 edge on the glass.

ROSEMONT (6-4, 4-0 CSAC)

Liz Coyne scored 22 with 19 boards, and **Ashley Montecchio** added 22 points as the Ravens cruised to an 87-31 win over Baptist Bible on Saturday to push their winning streak to five. The last time the program had five straight wins in a single season was in 1991/1992... After tonight's non-conference match up with Delaware Valley, the Ravens host CSAC foe Marywood on Wednesday before making the short trip to another conference rival, Cabrini, on Saturday afternoon.
