CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Baptist Bible Defenders (0-5, 0-2 CSAC)



The Lady Defenders had just one game this week as they were handed a 99-42 loss by Arcadia University on Monday, December 9. **Maeghin Muller** led the way with 11 points and **Megan Wagner** came off the bench for 10 points. The December 14 non-conference game against Lancaster Bible College was postponed and will be played on February 3 at 7:00. The team's next game will be on January 6, as the Lady Defenders will take on Susquehanna University.

Cabrini Cavaliers (7-1, 3-0 CSAC)



After a three-week hiatus, the Cavaliers will return to action on December 30 with a trip to Albright College. The Blue and White will open 2014 with a trip to New York University for its Holiday Classic. Cabrini will face Juniata on Friday and the host Violets on Saturday.

Cairn Highlanders (0-6, 0-3 CSAC)



Cairn has been idle since Dec. 7. The Highlanders' next contest is slated for Jan. 8 versus Stevens Institute of Technology.

Cedar Crest Falcons (1-8, 0-3 CSAC)



Cedar Crest has been idle since Dec. 7. The Falcons' next contest is slated for Jan. 4 at Hollins University.

Centenary Cyclones (4-5, 2-0 CSAC)



Centenary lost a pair of road games during the last two weeks, falling at Moravian and New Jersey City. Freshman **Mallory George** led the Cyclones in both games, scoring a game-high 13 points against the Greyhounds and tallying 15 points and nine rebounds versus NJCU. Centenary was hurt by a season-high 31 turnovers against the Gothic Knights. The Cyclones close out their three-game road trip on Dec. 30 at Kean before returning home for the first time in over a month to face Gwynedd Mercy on Jan. 8.

Gwynedd Mercy Griffins (3-5, 1-2 CSAC)



Behind a career-high 26 points from senior **Lauren Smith**, Gwynedd Mercy was able to pull away from Richard Stockton in an 81-71 road win Tuesday night. Junior **Kelsey Yori** added 14 points, all coming in the second half. Senior **Nicole Dougherty** rounded out the Griffin scoring, finishing with 15 points and adding a team-high eight rebounds to give GM a 46-38 edge on the boards. As a team the Griffins connected on ten three pointers and shot (15-of-18) 83.3% from the charity stripe. The Griffins now will head West, as they travel to Las Vegas to participate in the Vegas Hoopla taking on Eastern Connecticut State on Sunday, December 29th at 2 p.m. and Vassar College the following day, also at 2 p.m.

CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Immaculata Mighty Macs (6-2, 3-0 CSAC)



Alison Zimny poured in 21 points and **Sara Smith** added 20 but it was not enough as Immaculata dropped its final game before the holiday break at Ursinus, 90-75. The Mighty Macs were paced by **Zimny's** career-best 21 points which included a career-high five three-pointers. **Smith** finished with 20 points, including a 12-for-13 performance from the foul line. It marked the fourth time this season **Smith** has eclipsed the 20-point mark in a game. **Brittany Merkle** led the team on the glass with eight rebounds while recording 12 points and three blocked shots, tying her career high. The Mighty Macs will be back in action on Jan. 3 taking on Wilkes at the Moravian Winter Classic.

Marywood Pacers (7-1, 3-0 CSAC)



Marywood dropped its first contest of the season, ending a seven-game winning streak to start the season. The Pacers fell to Delaware Valley 78-64 Thursday in Doylestown. **Nora Joyce** led the Pacers with 16 points. Two days earlier, Marywood toppled Misericordia 83-72 in a rescheduled game. The Pacers came back from a 16-point deficit in the second half. **Brittany Mang** led all scorers with 22 points. She went 12-of-13 from the line. **Danielle Terranella** battled early foul trouble to earn a double-double with 16 points and a team-high 11 boards. The Pacers travel to Las Vegas this week to face defending national champion Amherst College before taking on Eastern Connecticut State.

Notre Dame Gators (0-10, 0-3 CSAC)



The Notre Dame basketball team finished the first half of the 2013-14 season this past weekend by travelling to New York City Saturday and Sunday, and then went to Bryn Athyn on Tuesday. In Saturday's contest with Lehman, freshman **Erika Deppenschmidt** posted a career-high 22 points, hitting from behind the arc six times. Junior **Marylu Ortiz** grabbed 12 rebounds while sophomore **Kam Medina** notched 11 points, eight rebounds, five assists and five steals. On Sunday the team faced Yeshiva University and saw junior **Shaun-de' Jones** notched career-highs with 22 rebounds and five steals. **Deppenschmidt** added 12 points while **Medina** chipped in with 11 points and three blocks. The team travelled to Bryn Athyn Tuesday night to finish the first half of the season with **Medina** posting her fifth double-double of the season, scoring 14 points and 11 rebounds. She also tied a season high with six steals. The small team has continued to make strides and will look to re-grow after the holiday.

Keystone Giants (6-2, 3-0 CSAC)



Chantel Blake scored a career-high 27 points to lead Keystone to an 84-65 win at SUNY IT on Friday, December 13th. **Jazmyn Robinson** and **Ashley Evans** added 18 points apiece while **Alyssa Cuomo** netted 11 points in the win. **Jerica Rode** led the Giants with nine rebounds and four blocks against the Wildcats. **Robinson** (30 points) and **Evans** (26 points), both netted career-highs on Monday night in the Giants 92-82 loss to Albright College. **Blake** added 12 points and **Hayes** finished with 10 points against the Lions. Keystone will return from the semester break with a pair of away games the first weekend in January, visiting Drew University on Friday, January 3rd before traveling to Valley Forge Christian College on Sunday, January 5th.

Neumann Knights (3-5, 1-2 CSAC)



Neumann (3-5) fell in its only game at Rowan, 71-68. **Erica Marvel** led the Knights with 14 points. **Colleen Hinde** netted 11 points. **Johanna Metzger** and **Lauren Walker** each added 10. Rowan held a 12 points lead at the half, which Neumann erased and tied the game at 62 with 2:44 left in regulation. The Knights just could not get the go-ahead basket. Neumann gets back on the court on January 2 when it travels to Albright. The Knights then host Eastern on January 4 before heading back into conference action.

Rosemont Ravens (2-7, 1-2 CSAC)



On Tuesday the Aggies of Delaware Valley College claimed an 80-67 home win against the Ravens. Rosemont placed three players in double-figures. **Liz Coyne** continued her torrid pace, scoring 18 with 15 boards to earn her ninth double-double in as many games. **"Shortie" Reppert** (14) and **Curtrena Goff** (12) were the other high-scorers for the Ravens. Rosemont's next scheduled game is a non-conference home match-up against Lancaster Bible on 1/4 starting at 1:00pm.
