Brittany Mang averaged 18 points and seven rebounds to lead the Pacers to three CSAC wins over

Cairn, Gwynedd Mercy and Rosemont. Mang notched a double-double with 29 points and 10 rebounds against the Ravens. She scored 16 points in the Pacers' first victory over the Griffins since 2008-09. The Carbondale, Pa. native shot 50 percent from the field on 20-for-40 shooting. Mang leads the Pacers with 14.8 points per game and 11 steals.

SARA SMITH, IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY

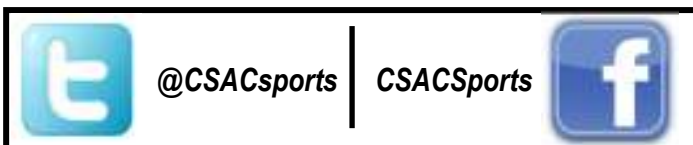

Smith helped Immaculata start CSAC play 3-0 by leading the Mighty Macs in scoring (20.3) and rebounding (8.7) during their three games last week. She had team highs in points (23) and rebounds (11) against Cedar Crest. She added 18 points against Rosemont and 20 points in the Neumann contest.

JAZMYN ROBINSON, KEYSTONE COLLEGE

Jr. - G - Hyattsville, Md.

Robinson led Keystone to a 3-0 CSAC week by leading the Giants with 18.3 points and 7.3 rebounds per game. Also led the squad with 27 assists (7.0/game) and 13 steals. She scored 24 points to go along with 8 assists and 7 rebounds on Monday in an 89-86 win over Neumann, the Giants first-ever win over the Knights. Robinson added 18 points and 8 assists in Wednesday's 100-55 win at Baptist Bible before closing the week with a triple-double on 13 points, 11 rebounds, and 11 assists in Saturday's 87-37 win over Notre Dame of Maryland, while also recording a game-high five steals in the win over the Gators.



CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Baptist Bible Defenders (0-4, 0-2 CSAC)



The Lady Defenders were handed two lopsided defeats this past week, both by CSAC opponents. On Wednesday, Keystone used their transition game to take down BBC 100-55. **Maeghin Mueller** scored 15 points and **Megan Wagner** came off the bench to add 14 points in the losing effort. Gwynedd Mercy University came to BBC on Saturday used the three ball to get past BBC, 85-38. Freshman **Erika Longwell** led the Lady Defenders with 13 points.

Cabrini Cavaliers (7-1, 3-0 CSAC)



The Cavaliers pushed their win streak to 7 with at victories at Notre Dame (Md.) and Cairn. Four players scored in double figures in an 87-27 win at Notre Dame, led by sophomore **Kristina Startare's** 12 points. Cabrini's 92 points in a win at Cairn marked the team's highest scoring game since the 1998-98 season. Fourteen players notched the scoring column, led by 14 points from senior **Brittany Sandone** and juniors **Megan Decker** and **Amber Keys**. The Blue and White will break for final exams before returning to action on December 30 when they visit Albright College.

Cairn Highlanders (0-6, 0-3 CSAC)



The conference schedule has gotten off to a rocky start for the Lady Highlanders as they fell to Marywood, Centenary, and Cabrini. The backcourt of **Amie Eppolito** and rookie **EJ Hartzler** continue to drive the offense, but it is defensive struggles that is proving to be the Achilles heel for the women this season. The Highlanders have given up more than 80 points for four games in a row.

Cedar Crest Falcons (1-8, 0-3 CSAC)



The Cedar Crest College Falcons finished their last week of the year 0-3 overall. The Falcons fell to Immaculata, Neumann and Centenary. A positive for the Falcons, **Amber Wehry** netted her 1,000th point of her career against Centenary. **Wehry** would also finish with a team high 15 points in that game. **Wehry** is the 10th player to net 1,000 points in Cedar Crest College history.

Centenary Cyclones (4-3, 2-0 CSAC)



Centenary posted a pair of blowout victories to begin CSAC play, besting Cairn and Cedar Crest. The Cyclones' 84 points against Cairn were their most in a game since scoring 90 against the Highlanders in 2011. Sophomore guard **Ally Fugnitti** recorded a career-best 20 points and added eight steals, six rebounds and four assists in just 24 minutes of action. Her eight steals were the sixth-highest, single-game total in school history and the most by a Cyclone since **Jen Vasta** swiped nine steals in 2011. Freshman forward **Kelsey Barofski** recorded her first-career double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds. Senior **Klarissa Perry** netted a career best 18 points and added a 15-point, 10-rebound double-double against Cedar Crest. The Cyclones outrebounded their opponents 108-59 and forced 52 turnovers during the week.

Gwynedd Mercy Griffins (2-5, 1-2 CSAC)



The Griffins went 1-2 in three CSAC games last week. On Monday, they headed to Cabrini but came up short in a 63-55 defeat. Senior **Nicole Dougherty** was the only Griffin in double figures with 11. In Wednesday's matchup with Marywood, junior **Natasha Matthews** would score a game-high 21 points, but it would be the Pacers escaping with an 80-78 win. Gwynedd got back on track on Saturday, in a win at Baptist Bible, 85-38. Senior **Jordan Dominic** led four players in double figures with 15 points. Sophomore **Jackie Crowley** added 10 points, seven boards, two steals and a block.

CSAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Immaculata Mighty Macs (6-1, 3-0 CSAC)



Immaculata had a perfect 3-0 record last week as it improved to 6-1 overall and started the CSAC slate 3-0. Immaculata defeated Cedar Crest (94-41), Rosemont (76-66) and Neumann (70-61) to begin the league schedule. **Sara Smith** recorded a double-double against Cedar Crest with 23 points and 11 rebounds, while **Brittany Merkle** had double-double performances against both Rosemont (19 points, 11 rebounds) and Neumann (23 points, 11 rebounds). Immaculata hosts Haverford on Saturday in its only contest of the week.

Marywood Pacers (6-0, 3-0 CSAC)



Marywood remained unbeaten on the season with three CSAC wins over Cairn, Gwynedd Mercy and Rosemont. **Brittany Mang** scored 29 points and 10 rebounds to lead Marywood to a 97-84 victory over the Ravens. **Morgann Haduck** hit a go-ahead 3-pointer with 39 seconds left to lead the Pacers to an 18-point second half comeback against the Griffins. The Pacers' 80-78 win is their first over the Griffins since 2008-09. **Danielle Terranella** netted a double-double with 20 points and 10 boards. The Pacers forced 31 turnovers in an 81-32 victory over the Highlanders. Marywood is 6-0 for the first time in five seasons. The Pacers are idle until a Dec. 17 make-up date with Misericordia.

Notre Dame Gators (0-7, 0-3 CSAC)



The Gators opened CSAC play by facing Rosemont, Cabrini and Keystone and fell to three of last year's playoff teams. Notre Dame dropped the contest with Rosemont 26-72, fell to Cabrini 27-87, and were defeated 37-87 at Keystone. Sophomore **Kam Medina** averaged 17 points in the three contest, and also grabbed six rebounds per game as the team's point guard. In Saturday game at Keystone, **Medina** posted 18 points, 10 rebounds and six steals for her fourth double-double of the season. Junior **Marylu Ortiz** grabbed ten rebounds Monday night at Rosemont.

Keystone Giants (5-1, 3-0 CSAC)



Keystone opened CSAC play on Monday night with their first-ever win over Neumann University, 89-86, led by 24 points and eight assists from **Jazmyn Robinson**. **Chantel Blake** added a double-double on 15 points and 12 rebounds and **Alyssa Cuomo** also scored 15 points in the win. In Wednesday's 100-55 win at Baptist Bible, **AAliya Hayes** led all players with 22 points and 14 rebounds while **Ashley Evans** (20), **Robinson** (18), **Blake** (15), and **Cuomo** (12) all reached double-figures in the win. In Saturday's 87-37 win over Notre Dame of Maryland University, **Robinson** recorded a triple-double on 13 points, 11 rebounds, and 11 assists. **Blake** led all scorers with 21 points while **Cuomo** and **Evans** scored 14 points apiece in the win. Keystone will visit SUNY IT on Saturday for their lone contest of the coming week.

Neumann Knights (3-4, 1-2 CSAC)



Neumann went 1-2 in CSAC action last week as it opened conference action. **Erica Marvel** netted 31 points on Monday, but the Knights could not defeat the Giants and fell 89-86. **JoHanna Metzger** notched a double-double with 18 points and 13 rebounds. Neumann then defeated Cedar Crest at home on Wednesday, 82-49. **Marvel** and **Metzger** each had 18 points. **Metzger** added 12 rebounds for another double-double. To wrap up the week, Neumann fell to Immaculata, 70-61. **Metzger** netted 14 points. **Jessica Schlesman** added 12. Neumann is now 3-4 overall and 1-2 in CSAC play. The Knights are off for finals and will travel to Rowan on December 19 for non-conference action.

Rosemont Ravens (2-6, 1-2 CSAC)



The Ravens went 1-2 in CSAC games this week. On Monday, Rosemont had little difficulty dispatching the Notre Dame Gators, 72-26 in Rosemont's first home game of the season. Back on the road the Ravens were not as successful. Rosemont dropped their game at Immaculata 76-66, in what was a close game until the last few minutes of the second half. On Saturday the Ravens lost a shootout at Marywood. **Liz Coyne** scored a season-high 30 points and earned her eighth double-double in eight games, but Rosemont was defeated 97-84.
