### **CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (0-1, 0-0 CSAC)**

The Cavaliers traveled to Florida for its annual Spring Training trip... The Blue and White returns to action on Wednesday when it welcomes Rowan University to Edith Robb Dixon Field for a 6:30pm game... The University of Scranton will then pay Cabrini a visit on Saturday for a 12:00pm contest.

### **CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS (0-2, 0-0 CSAC)**

The Falcons returned from their spring training trip looking for a fresh start after their season opening loss, but would have no luck, falling 15-3 at Mount St. Vincent... For the second straight game, **Kim Katsigianis** finished with 25 saves in goal, while adding eight ground balls. **Amy Frey** scored a goal for the second straight game, and **Emily Rodenberger** finished with six ground balls... 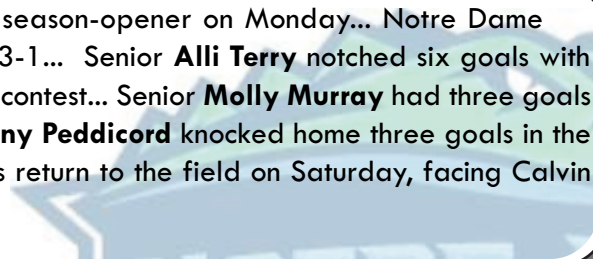
### NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS (4-0, 0-0 CSAC)

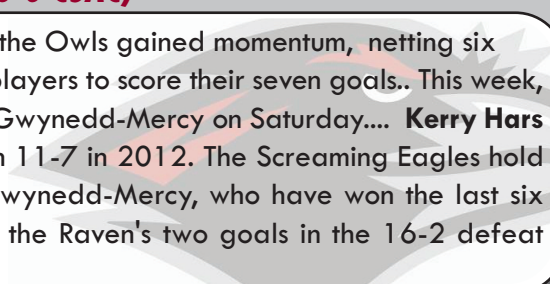
### NOTRE DAME OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY GATORS (1-1, 0-0 CSAC)

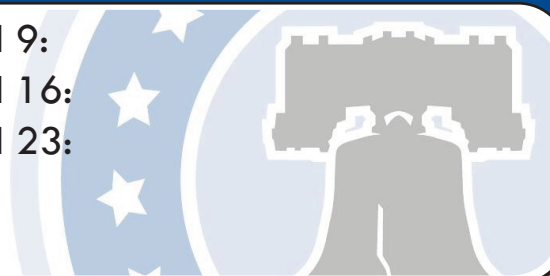
### ROSEMONT COLLEGE RAVENS (0-1, 0-0 CSAC)
