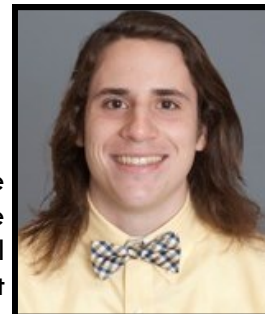

AROUND THE CSAC



CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (3-3, 0-0 CSAC)

The Cavaliers split a pair of games against Top 10 teams, winning at #10 Gettysburg 12-11 before falling to #1 SUNY Cortland 10-7. Junior **Corey Elmer** and sophomore **Ethan Heisman** led the Cavaliers with 5 points each against Gettysburg. Heisman scored a career best 5 goals, while Elmer found the net once with four helpers. Senior **Bobby Thorp** added 4 goals in the win. Led by Elmer's 3 goals, the Blue and White were tied with Cortland at 6-6 with 10 minutes to play, before the Red Dragons tallied four goals in the final six minutes.



CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (5-0, 0-0 CSAC)

The Cyclones played an excellent week of lacrosse, going 2-0 with wins over Lebanon Valley College and Penn State Abington. Centenary played their most challenging game of the season against Lebanon Valley holding on for a 10-8 victory. The Cyclones continued to ride their momentum, as they defeated Penn State Abington 24-0 in blizzard-like conditions and the game was called in the third quarter. Against Penn State Abington five Cyclones scored their first-ever collegiate goals, while **Robert Nuzzolese** recorded five goals en route to scoring this 100th career goal. This week Centenary College will be put to the test, as they welcome the University of Scranton before kicking off CSAC play with Gwynedd-Mercy College.



GWYNEDD-MERCY COLLEGE GRIFFINS (1-3, 0-0 CSAC)

Marymount spoiled Gwynedd-Mercy's home opener as the Griffins fell, 9-6, in non-conference action Wednesday afternoon. Senior **William Beck** paced GM with a game-high three goals while freshman **Tony McCraw** added two. The Griffins won 14-of-18 face-offs with senior **Jonathan Figliola** winning 12-of-16 and McCraw was a perfect 2-for-2. Senior goalie **Ryley O'Keefe** made 13 saves for GM. O'Keefe tied a school single-game record with 19 saves but GM dropped a 15-6 decision at Albright on Saturday afternoon. Beck found the net twice and assisted on another while **Dustan Mangin** and McCraw each had a goal and an assist. The Griffins will look to get back on track when they host DeSales on Tuesday in a 4 p.m. start. They begin league play on Saturday traveling to Centenary for a 3 p.m. start.



IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (1-4, 0-0 CSAC)

Immaculata had its week cut short with its scheduled Saturday contest at DeSales postponed until April 3. The Mighty Macs' lone game of the week was a 16-7 loss to Widener to Wednesday. **Dante Tuscai** led the Mighty Macs against the Pride with three goals and two assists for five points. **Ben Tuscai** was second in scoring with one goal and two assists. IU goalkeeper **Jon Diodati** made 20 saves in the loss. Immaculata has another one-game week upcoming as it takes on Elizabethtown on Wednesday looking for its first win in the series.



MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY PACERS (1-5, 0-0 CSAC)

Marywood University split a pair of games against northeastern Pennsylvania opponents to earn its first victory of the season... The 10 goals in the Pacers' 6-4 victory over King's mark lowest-scoring game in program history. The Pacer defense kept King's to four goals - its best outing since holding Gwynedd-Mercy to the same total during the CSAC semifinals in 2011... **Scott Slater** one-timed the go-ahead goal, breaking a 3-3 tie, at the 9:05 mark in the fourth quarter against the Monarchs... The Pacers outshot King's by a 35-20 margin... **Riley Dobel** matched a school record with five goals as a late Pacer charge fell short to Scranton 9-7 on Saturday. Dobel also led the game with six ground balls... **Nicholas Cornella** made 13 saves against the Royals... The Pacers matched the Royals in shots (35) and held a 27-25 advantage in ground balls... Marywood has a pair of away games at York and Neumann this week.



NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS (1-5, 0-0 CSAC)

Neumann (1-5) lost to DeSales University 10-8. **Chris Scott** scored four goals and added one assist in the first half of the game to tie the game 6-6. DeSales scored three goals in the beginning of the third period and never looked back. **Patrick Rose** had three assist and five ground balls, while **Alex Becker** made 18 saves. The Knights start conference play against Marywood at home on Saturday.



ROSEMONT COLLEGE RAVENS (1-5, 0-0 CSAC)

After winning the program's first game in the prior week the Ravens went 0-3, all in non-conference play this week. The Ravens keep up their busy early-season schedule with two more non-conference games this week. On Wednesday the Ravens face Arcadia for the first time while on Friday they travel to Richard Stockton, a team that defeated Rosemont in their first encounter last season by a 25-4 score. Freshman **Stephen Licata** scored seven goals this week and currently leads the Ravens with 19 goals. **Will Lawlor** leads his team with 11 ground balls and 27 ground balls. **Tom Bottoms** also has 27 ground balls to lead the Ravens in that category.
