AROUND THE CSAC

CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (0-3, 0-0 CSAC)

The Cavaliers find themselves still searching for their first win of the season after suffering home losses to Rowan 19-12 and Scranton 16-10. Sophomore **Lacie Doubet** and **Melissa Scanzano** led the team in both games with five goals. The Blue and White will look for its first win this week as it visits Ursinus, Swarthmore and Notre Dame (Md.).

CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS (0-3, 0-0 CSAC)

The Falcons ran into a tough team in Wilkes University last week, losing 18-1. On the other side **Chelsea Thompson** scored her first NCAA goal of her career and **Kim Katsigianis** finished with 15+ saves for the 3rd game in a row. **Amy Frey** would finish the week with four groundballs, and teammate **Emily Rodenberger** would also finish with four as well. The Falcons host Gwynedd-Mercy College in their 2013 Home Opener this Wednesday at 4 PM.

CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (2-2, 0-0 CSAC)

The Cyclones fell to Worcester by the final score of 16-13 in an exciting game on Saturday. The Cyclones fell behind 7-1 early but managed to come scratch and claw their way back behind a strong performance from **Brittlyn Dendy** and **Allie Swartz**, who both scored hat tricks. **Alysia Pinkerton** also had a memorable day for the Cyclones, as she won her 200th career draw control to further extend her all-time record. This week Centenary College will take on a pair of CSAC foes in Immaculata and Neumann, in the hopes they can snap their two-game losing streak.

GWYNEDD-MERCY COLLEGE GRIFFINS (2-2, 1-0 CSAC)

Gwynedd-Mercy defeated Penn State-Abington 21-3 Tuesday afternoon for their first win of the season. Sophomore **Dani Horn** paced GM with a game-high 11 points (7 goals/4 assists). Senior **Jenna Gaydosh** added a career-best five goals in the victory. Junior **Amy Powell** finished with a career-high four goals. Junior **Erin Janzekovich** recorded three saves in net to earn the win. The Griffins picked up their first conference win in Thursday's 19-6 win over Rosemont in CSAC action. Gaydosh paced the GM attack with a game-high five goals. Horn added four tallies and three helpers while Powell also poured in four goals. The goalie tandem of juniors **Tori Peacock** and **Janzekovich** combined to make six saves. Lycoming defeated GM, 14-3, in a snowy affair on Saturday. Horn scored a pair of goals. **Marina Hubbard** recorded eight saves. The Griffins return to action on Wednesday with a CSAC matchup at Cedar Crest starting at 4 p.m. They will also host Widener on Saturday face-off is scheduled for 12 p.m.

IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (3-2, 0-0 CSAC)

Immaculata saw their win streak get up to three after wins over Maritime (19-5) and Misericordia (21-15)...Against Maritime, the Mighty Macs started the game on a 10-0 run and never looked back...**Kelly Lapp** and **Allison Jakavick** each had four goals...Against Misericordia, Immaculata tallied a season-high 21 goals led by **Shannon Neill's** six goals and two assists for eight points, tied for most this season...On Saturday, the win streak was snapped by Albright by a score of 17-5... The Mighty Macs will play their third straight home game and CSAC opener on Wednesday when they host Centenary before getting back into non-conference play on Saturday at Arcadia.



MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY PACERS (0-5, 0-0 CSAC)

Marywood University dropped two games this week to Lycoming College and Lebanon Valley College... Lycoming used two six-goal streaks to oust Marywood 14-7 Tuesday... **Kimberly Commisso** led the Pacers with five goals against the Warriors... **Leigha Dolcemascolo** stopped 10 Lycoming shots. **Samantha Akshar** and **Stacy Griffing** each picked up three ground balls... Marywood was defeated by Lebanon Valley 16-2 in a game that was shortened by snow and ice pellets with 10:13 remaining in the second half.

NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS (6-1, 0-0 CSAC)

Neumann went 2-1 in the week with wins over Sweet Briar 10-5, Eastern 9-7 and the loss against Scranton 14-7. Neumann had good balance from top to bottom with the scoring being shared and the defense playing solid in front of **Chrissy Hughes** in goal. The Knights are 6-1 and off to a great start, as they start conference play this week against Notre Dame and Centenary on the road.

NOTRE DAME OF MD. UNIVERSITY GATORS (2-1, 0-0 CSAC)

The Gators defeated Calvin College to gain their second win of the season...scored three goals in the first eight minutes of the game to gain early control of the contest...took a 7-0 lead into the half...Senior **Alli Terry** (Baltimore, Md./Catholic) notched three goals in Saturday's win over Calvin College...Terry's hat trick marked her second time achieving the feat this season...Sophomore **Brittany Peddicord** (Timonium, Md./Dulaney) added two goals, giving her five in the last two games... Notre dame will host in-state foe Frostburg State to open the week before opening their CSAC schedule with two home games, hosting Neumann University and Cabrini College.

ROSEMONT COLLEGE RAVENS (0-2, 0-1 CSAC)

Rosemont had three players each scoring two goals, but it was not enough as the Ravens fell to Gwynedd-Mercy 19-6. This week's Ravens' schedule sandwiches a conference game between two non-conference contests. Rosemont is 1-2 overall against Lancaster Bible, the team they will face on Monday.
