AROUND THE CSAC



CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (4-3, 0-0 CSAC)

An eight day break from competition did not slow the Cavaliers as they jumped out to an early 4-1 lead en route to topping #16 Union College 12-8 on Sunday. Sophomore **Damian Sobieski** led the Cavaliers with five points on three goals and two assists. Junior **Corey Elmer** and sophomore **Anthony DiSanzo** matched Sobieski with three goals on the day. Freshman goaltender **Chris Treat** recorded seven saves to improve to 2-1 on the year. Cabrini will hit the road this week for its sixth game against a nationally ranked opponent, as it visits #18 Ithaca College on Friday.



CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (6-0, 1-0 CSAC)

With the weather playing havoc on the schedule, the Cyclones played only one of the games they had scheduled for the week. None the less, Centenary made the most of it by picking up a victory in their first CSAC contest of the year defeating Gwynedd-Mercy 9-6. With that victory, Cyclones wrapped up a long home stand to kick off the year and will hit the road for the first time this season to take on DeSales next Saturday. **Cameron Gunn** scored his 100th career point vs. Gwynedd-Mercy on a goal late in the fourth quarter.



GWYNEDD-MERCY COLLEGE GRIFFINS (2-4, 0-1 CSAC)

Gwynedd-Mercy held off DeSales in a wild 13-12 non-conference win Tuesday afternoon. **William Beck** had a career-high five goals and two assists while **Dustan Mangin** added two scores and a personal-best four helpers. **Blase Cesarone** notched his first career tally for the Griffins as well. Goalie **Ryley O'Keefe** made four of his nine saves in the fourth quarter alone. Centenary downed the Griffins 9-6 in both team's CSAC opener. **Roy Bakeoven** and **Mason Risner** each notched a pair of goals. Defensively, **Reese Lachner** recorded nine ground balls and four caused turnovers, both game highs. O'Keefe finished with 14 saves. GM returns to action on Wednesday when they welcome Arcadia in a non-league affair here starting at 4 p.m. They will continue their home stand hosting Richard Stockton Friday at 4 p.m. and they will host CSAC rival Marywood on Saturday at 12 p.m.



IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (1-5, 0-0 CSAC)

Immaculata suffered an 18-14 loss to Elizabethtown in its only game of the week. Elizabethtown scored six goals during the first quarter, and was able to hold off a surging Immaculata team for the 18-14 win. Immaculata outscored Elizabethtown, 14-12, during the final three quarters of play. The Mighty Macs cut the goal margin to four (13-9) with a goal from **Rocco Piliero** with 1:10 remaining in the third quarter, as Immaculata used a five-goal third quarter to get back in the game. **Bhelly Bagbonon** and **Ben Tuscai** each recorded five points during the game. Bagbonon had four goals and one assist, while Tuscai recorded five assists. **Dante Tuscai** finished with three goals and one assist, and Piliero accounted for four of the Mighty Macs' goals.

Neumann play their next game on Monday, March 25 at home against non-conference opponents Albright College.
