CSAC HONOR ROLL

Gwynedd-Mercy sophomore pitcher **Kaitlyn Johnson** (Milford, NJ/Delaware Valley) struck out a career-high 16 in seven innings in a 9-3 win in game 2 of a DH sweep over Cairn on Saturday. She allowed just three runs on four hits without yielding a walk.

Cabrini freshman shortstop **Kaitlyn Cooper** (Buena, NJ/Buena Regional) led the Cavaliers to a 4-0 week with team highs of 7 hits and 5 runs scored, while hitting .500. The rookie also hit her first career home run and swiped 3 bases. Defensively, Cooper posted 16 assist and a fielding percentage of 0.957.



AROUND THE CSAC

BAPTIST BIBLE COLLEGE DEFENDERS

The Lady Defenders dropped a pair of games to Cabrini College. In the first game of the double header, BBC fell 1-3, giving up three unearned runs. The Cavaliers broke things open in the top of the fifth, scoring four runs and blowing the game wide open. **Karin Mowry** went 5-6 on the day, including a home run, a triple, and a double. She also scored four runs for the Lady Defenders.

CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS

The Cavaliers continued their hot play, extending their win streak to 7 games after wins at Cairn and Baptist Bible. Three pitchers, **Marcelle Crist**, **Bethany Feinberg** and **Missy Miller**, combined for a 1.61 ERA on the week, after allowing just 5 earned runs in 28 innings. Freshman **Kaitlyn Cooper** and sophomore **Steph Diegel** led the club with 7 hits each, while sophomores **Jessica Irvin** and **Becca Miles** combined for 11 of the Blue and White's 21 RBI. The Blue and White will look to continue its streak as it visits Notre Dame (MD.) on Wednesday for a make-up game.

CAIRN UNIVERSITY HIGHLANDERS

Cairn University played four games this past week all within conference play, dropping all four and will have their games with Eastern University postponed later in the season. The Highlanders were out-scored 7 to 35 last week. Their closest game was a 1-3 loss against Cabrini. The Highlanders are currently 0-6 in conference play and 0-11 overall. This week the Highlanders will face two out of conference opponents in the College of St. Elizabeth and Swarthmore College

CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS

Cedar Crest split a pair of conference doubleheaders falling to Neumann while defeating Rosemont. Against Rosemont with **Natalia Dial** (Kannapolis, PA/Jesse C. Carson) pitching both games, the strikes came early in game 1. **Shannon Wenner** (Drums, PA/MMI Preparatory) would score in the first off a Rosemont error that would allow Dial to reach. Later in that inning, **Laura Swanhall** (Cobleskill, NY/Cobleskill-Richmondville) would also reach on an error that would allow Dial to score the games second run. Game 2 featured more of the same for Cedar Crest who's bats would go quiet until the fourth inning. The Falcons would put up a five spot against Maurer and take a 6-1 lead at that point.
