Sarah Caughy's 13 points for the week led the Pacers to their first two wins of the season with victories over Rosemont and Cedar Crest... Caughy reached the 100-goal plateau for her career with four goals, along with three assists, as the Pacers earned the first shutout in program history in an 18-0 win over Cedar Crest. She becomes one of just five players in Pacer history to reach the mark. She also tied for the team lead with five ground balls... Earlier in the week, she tallied three goals and three assists against Rosemont, notching the Pacers' first win of the year.

AROUND THE CSAC

CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (1-5, 1-0 CSAC)

After a pair of nonconference losses, the Cavaliers secured their first win of 2013, topping Notre Dame (Md.) 18-6. Four players tallied at least five points in the win, led by freshman **Nathalie Basunga's** seven points (4G, 3A). Fellow rookie **Katie Lasater** scored a career best six goals, while senior **Christina Pasquariello** (3G, 2A) and sophomore **Lacie Doubet** (1G, 4A) recorded five points each. The Blue and White will look to continue its winning ways with a pair of home games this week against Cedar Crest and Alvernia.

CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS (0-5, 0-1 CSAC)

The Falcons saw their losing streak reach 5 games. **Kim Katsigianis** finished with 10+ saves for the 5th game in a row. **Amy Frey** would finish the week with two goals, and teammate **Emily Rodenberger** would also finish with two as well. The Falcons host Gwynedd-Mercy College in their 2013 Home Opener this Saturday at 1 PM.

CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (2-4, 0-2 CSAC)

The Cyclones played only one game this week and were defeated by Neumann University 17-5 in a CSAC matchup on Saturday. Centenary will look to bounce back this week, as they travel to Virginia for a non-conference matchup with Virginia Wesleyan College on Thursday.

GWYNEDD-MERCY COLLEGE GRIFFINS (2-3, 1-0 CSAC)

Gwynedd-Mercy fell to Widener, 18-6, in non-conference action on Saturday. **Danae Perrymond** led the Griffins with four goals while **Amy Powell** added a score and two assists. Goalie **Marina Hubbard** tied a personal-best with 16 saves. **Dani Horn** also tallied a score and an assist for the Griffins. GM returns to action on Tuesday evening when they host Albright in a 7 p.m. start under the lights. They will travel on the road on Thursday to Arcadia for a 7 p.m. start as well. On Saturday the Griffins will continue CSAC play traveling to Cedar Crest for a 1 p.m. start.

IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (4-3, 1-0 CSAC)

Immaculata got off to a strong start in conference play with a thrilling 17-16 win over Centenary on Tuesday ... The game was very back and forth until the second half when Immaculata took a 17-15 lead and held on in the final ten minutes for victory ... **Shannon Neill** had nine points on four goals and five assists while **Kelly Lapp** chipped in with a team-high five goals ... On Saturday, the Mighty Macs fell in non-conference play at Arcadia ... They led 8-7 at halftime, but Arcadia scored the first seven goals after half to pull ahead ... Immaculata will take on Notre Dame this Tuesday at home looking to move to 2-0 in conference play.



MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY PACERS (2-5, 2-0 CSAC)

Marywood University earned interim coach Lindsey Hendricks' first career wins with victories over Rosemont and Cedar Crest this week... **Kathy DiGiacomo** had seven points (three goals, four assists) and **Kimberly Commisso** scored four goals in the team's 18-5 win over Rosemont Wednesday. The Pacers outshot the Ravens by a 43-14 margin... Marywood recorded the first shutout in program history in a 16-0 victory over Cedar Crest Saturday in the team's home opener... **Sarah Caughy** became one of just five players to reach 100 career goals, netting four goals to go with her three assists. **Leigha Dolcemascolo** became the first Pacer to earn a clean sheet... Marywood is off this week and returns to action on April 4 against Neumann.

NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS (8-1, 2-0 CSAC)
