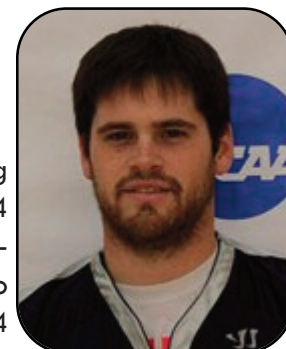

AROUND THE CSAC

CABRINI COLLEGE (1-2, 0-0 CSAC)



The Cavaliers suffered a pair of road losses to top-10 teams last week, falling 12-6 at #7 Dickinson and 11-9 at #3 Lynchburg. After trailing 3-2 at halftime against Dickinson, the Red Devils outscored the Cavaliers 4-2 in the third to pull away, before closing the game with five goals in the fourth quarter... The Blue and White fired 52 shots at Lynchburg, including a 30-13 advantage in second half shots, but could only must two second half goals. Junior **Corey Elmer** and sophomore **Anthony DiSanzo** tallied three goals each in the loss... Cabrini will return to action on Saturday as it visits Swarthmore College at 1:00 p.m.

CENTENARY (2-0, 0-0 CSAC)



Centenary kicked off its 2013 season in impressive fashion last week by thoroughly defeating the Alvernia Crusaders 23-4 on Wednesday. A six goal, four assist effort from **Cameron Gunn** helped lead the offensive surge for Centenary. The Cyclones also received a big effort from **Robert Nuzzolese** (five goals) and **Conor Nolan**, who distributed six assists in the big win... The team followed up its first win by defeating the Richard Stockton Ospreys on Saturday to move to 2-0. In a fiercely competitive game, the Cyclones did all the little things necessary to be successful, as Nolan picked up 12 groundballs and goalie **Grant Nice** made 10 saves in the second half to preserve the 14-9 triumph... This week Centenary will look to improve their record when they welcome Lebanon Valley College and Saint Joseph College to Cyclone Field in non-conference matchups

GWYNEDD-MERCY (0-1, 0-0 CSAC)



The Griffins fell 13-7 at Lycoming on Saturday afternoon. **Roy Bakeoven** scored four goals, while **Dustan Mangin** and **William Beck** added two assists apiece... Gwynedd-Mercy returns to action on Wednesday, hosting Richard Stockton at 4:00pm. The Griffins return to the road on Saturday, traveling to Mount St. Mary for a 1:00pm start.

IMMACULATA (1-1, 0-0 CSAC)



Immaculata began the 2013 season with a 1-1 mark during the opening week... The Mighty Macs had a 10-7 road setup in the opener to Wesley while winning their home opener against Arcadia, 10-8. **Belly Bagbonon** led the team in scoring during the week with seven points off five goals and two assists. Bagbonon recorded five of those points in the loss to Wesley... **Dante Tuscai** helped Immaculata to its first win of the 2013 season against Arcadia (10-8) by leading the team with three goals. Tuscai scored twice during the final five minutes to break an 8-8 tie, and lift the Mighty Macs the victory. Tuscai recorded the game-winning goal at the 4:43 mark, which also eclipsed the 100-point mark for his career... The Pacers crawled back from an early five-goal deficit, but came up short 13-10 to Shenandoah this past Saturday. Trill had four goals in the loss, while **Dylan Swope** added two assists and Terlizzi went 15-for-23 in the circle... The Pacers continue their Blue Ridge Mountains Spring Break Trip this week, facing #3 Lynchburg on Wednesday and McDaniel on Saturday.



NEUMANN (0-4, 0-0 CSAC)

Neumann lost both their games last week, falling 17-9 to Richard Stockton and 7-2 to Elizabethtown... In the Stockton contest, **Chris Scott** had a hand in six goals, grabbing six assists, and Goalie **Alex Becker** made 31 saves. The Knights jumped out to 6-2 lead against the Ospreys, but the lead was short lived and the Ospreys out ran the Knights in the second half. **Drew Millard, Ryan Lee, Ryan O'Kane** and **Kevin Fonio** each scored two goals for the Knights... O'Kane continues to score for the Knights with two goals against Elizabethtown... The Knights travel to Messiah on Wednesday and then to Hood on Friday.



ROSEMONT (0-2, 0-0 CSAC)

The Ravens were outscored 7-1 in the third quarter, propelling the Rivier Raiders to a 14-9 win on Saturday afternoon. Freshman **Stephen Licata** led the Ravens with four goals and an assist. For Rosemont, the team's nine goals tied the program record for goals scored in a game, while the 14 goals ceded were the fewest allowed for the second-year program's defense... The Ravens' lone action this week comes on Saturday, when they host Penn State-Abington at 3:00pm.
