LUKE PETERSON
Baptist Bible - Junior
Clarks Summit, PA/Abington Heights

Luke Peterson had a fantastic start to the spring season, as he was the medalist in both of his team's matches this week. On Wednesday the junior was just one over par, shooting a 73. On Thursday, Peterson shot a 76, with the next closest player five strokes behind giving him a 74.5 average on the week.

CSAC HONOR ROLL

Immaculata's **Todd Boisvert** (Milford, NH/Hollis Brookline) was runner-up at both tournaments last week. Immaculata fired its lowest round in program history of 309 to place second at the Rutgers-Camden Invitational. Boisvert fired the lowest round of his collegiate career, 74, to lead the Mighty Macs and place third overall.

Cabrini 's **Rob Bass** (Lafayette Hill, Pa/Plymouth-Whitemarsh) shot the low score at the Cabrini Spring Invitational. The junior fired a 73 (+2) to take the individual title at the Spring Classic by 3 strokes.

AROUND THE CSAC



BAPTIST BIBLE

The Defenders dropped their season opening match to Marywood 350-325. **Luke Peterson** led all golfers by shooting a 73 (+1). The very next day Peterson had the low score in a tri-match with the University of Scranton and King's College by shooting a 76(+). The team tied for second with King's College, as both teams shot a 373.



CABRINI

While the Cavaliers White and Blue teams took 3rd and 4th at the Cabrini Spring Classic, for the second consecutive week, junior **Rob Bass** posted the lowest score of the day. The junior carded a +2, 73 on the day, three strokes better than sophomore **Tommy Breslin** and Moravian's **Aaron Theime**. The Blue and White return to the course this week with a busy week, playing in events hosted by Swarthmore, Ursinus and Immaculata.



CAIRN

The Highlanders placed 14th as a team in the field of 18. Cairn shot a combined 351, their best score of the 2012-2013 season. Cairn will compete in the Franklin & Marshall Invitational in Lancaster, PA this week.



CENTENARY

After a week off from the course, the Cyclones return to action this week with two events in a two day period as they head out to the Ursinus Invitational on Tuesday before returning home Wednesday to host Farmingdale State and St. Joseph's College in their lone home match of the 2013 spring season. With the season winding down, the Cyclones are looking to rely on their top two performers **Rob Linepensel** and **Steve Kluemper** to continue to lead the pack in hopes for a 2013 CSAC Championship title.



IMMACULATA

Immaculata came in runner-up at both tournaments it competed in last week. Immaculata fired its lowest round in program history of 309 to place second at the Rutgers-Camden Spring Invitational, five strokes off Messiah. Individually, **Todd Boisvert** fired the lowest round of his collegiate career, 74, to lead the Mighty Macs and place third overall. Immaculata's second-place showing at the Cabrini College Spring Classic came with a team total of 325. Immaculata had two players finish in the top 5 individually as **Bryan Missimer** fired a 77 for fourth place, and **Pete Kotula** carded a 78, which was good for fifth.

AROUND THE CSAC



Finished 10th out of 17 teams after the first day of the Mike Bellow Invitational hosted by LeMoyne College on Sunday. **Sam Stewart** tied for 24th in the field with a five-over 77 on the day while **Collin McAndrew** shot a 78 to tie for 27th overall. The Giants will close out the two-day tournament on Monday before taking part in the Susquehanna University Invitational on Friday in the team's final tune-up before the CSAC Championships.



KEYSTONE

Marywood downed Baptist Bible College by 27 strokes after shooting a 323 at Scranton Municipal on Wednesday. **Paul Kania** and **Shane Davis** led the Pacers with 80s on the par 72, 6,274 yard course. Marywood plays in three events this coming week, first at the Glenmaura National Invitational (Sunday-Monday), then in a tri-match with Scranton and FDU-Florham before closing the week with another match against Baptist Bible.



MARYWOOD

Neumann competed at two meets last week. **Matt Redfield** led the Knights at the Cabrini Classic, shooting an 82. **Brandon Gagne** was just a stroke behind with an 83. At the Scarlet Raptors Invitational, Neumann finished eighth out of 18 team. Gagne led Neumann with a score of 76. **Ryan Dreger** shot an 83 and **Dave Gervais** had an 85. The Knights are idle this week and will compete in the Swarthmore Invitational on April 22.
