AROUND THE CSAC

CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (7-5, 6-0 CSAC)

The Cavaliers extended their current win streak to seven games with a pair of CSAC wins. The Cavaliers scored a 20-9 win at Neumann before topping Centenary 18-2 on Saturday. Senior **Christina Pasquariello** recorded another career week, tallying seven goals at Neumann and four assists against Centenary, both career highs. Freshman **Nathalie Basunga** also scored a career high five goals and seven points against the Cyclones.

CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS (1-10, 1-6 CSAC)

The Falcons picked up their first win of the season against Rosemont on Thursday. **Emily Rodenberger** led the way with three goals as five different Falcon players scored. **Erin Studer & Vivanna Samite** both netted two in the victory. **Kim Katsigianis** also recorded her first win of the season in goal. With the 15 saves against Rosemont, Katsigianis currently ranks 5th overall in D-III in saves & 1st overall in Saves per game.

CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (4-7, 2-3 CSAC)

After a big 17-2 victory over Cedar Crest earlier in the week, the Cyclones took a tough 18-2 loss to Cabrini College on Saturday to put them into a 2-3 record heading into the final week of action. This week, the Cyclones look to round out their 2013 regular season scheduled with a pair of home games against Gwynedd-Mercy College and Marywood University before taking to the road to take on the Notre Dame of Maryland University Gators in the final game of the regular season on Saturday.

GWYNEDD-MERCY COLLEGE GRIFFINS (3-9, 2-4 CSAC)

Notre Dame downed Gwynedd-Mercy, 14-12, in CSAC action on Tuesday. **Dani Horn** had four goals and an assist while **Danae Perrymond** added three and a helper. **Marina Hubbard** recorded six saves. GM fell to Immaculata 15-12 on Senior Day on Saturday. **Jenna Gaydosh** totaled two goals and an assist. Horn had a game-high eight points on four goals and two assists and Perrymond added three second-half goals. Hubbard made 12 saves. The Griffins resume action on Tuesday in a must-win game at Centenary to keep their playoff hunt alive.

IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (8-4, 4-1 CSAC)

The Mighty Macs started the week by taking their first CSAC loss in an 18-17 loss in double overtime to Marywood ... The game went back-and-forth all night as the score was tied 6-6 at half, 15-15 at the end of regulation, and 17-17 at the end of the first overtime period ... **Allison Jakavick** had seven points on five goals and two assists ... On Saturday, Immaculata bounced back with a 15-12 win over Gwynedd-Mercy ... The Mighty Macs took a 2-1 lead early and never looked back the rest of the way as they improved to 4-1 in CSAC play ... This week, the Mighty Macs will play two road games against two of the top teams in the conference in Cabrini and Neumann.



MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY PACERS (4-7, 4-2 CSAC)

Marywood survived a pair of tight CSAC battles this week, coming on top in the final minutes of both games... **Sarah Caughy** scored the game-winning goal with 13 seconds remaining in double-overtime to lead the Pacers to an 18-17 win at Immaculata. Caughy led the Pacers with a team season-best seven goals. **Stacy Griffing** had four goals and an assist, and **Mary Ninivaggi** made her season debut with a team-high six caused turnovers. **Leigha Dolcemascolo** made eight saves and six ground balls... Marywood broke open an 8-8 tie with four consecutive goals midway through the fourth quarter to oust Notre Dame (Md.) 14-11 Saturday. **Kimberly Commisso** led the Pacers with four goals, seven ground balls and 13 draw controls. Dolcemascolo made seven saves... Marywood faces Centenary College on Saturday.

NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS (11-3, 5-1 CSAC)

Neumann plays three games this week, as they host Cedar Crest on Tuesday, travel to TCNJ on Thursday and host Immaculata on Friday.
