AROUND THE CSAC

CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (9-5, 8-0 CSAC)

The Cavaliers extended their current win streak to 9 games and clinched the program's 10th undefeated conference schedule with wins over Immaculata and Rosemont. Sophomore **Melissa Scanzano** led the Cavaliers with 11 points on the week on 7 goals and 4 assists. Fellow sophomore **Lacie Doubet** scored a season high 6 goals and 7 points in Tuesday's 18-8 win over Immaculata, while freshman **Katie Lasater** matched a career high with 6 goals in a 19-1 victory at Rosemont on Saturday. The Blue and White will close the season with a pair of nonconference road tilts, at Widener on Tuesday and at No. 9 TCNJ on Thursday.

CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS (2-11, 1-7 CSAC)

The Falcons finished their season with a big win over Bryn Mawr 17-8. Junior **Erin Studer** lead the way for the Falcons with 5 goals and 5 groundballs while taking 2 draw controls. **Emily Rodenberger** also would net 4 in the win against Bryn Mawr while senior **Kim Katsigianis** would net her second win of the season in goal by only allowing 8 goals.

CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (5-9, 3-5 CSAC)

The Cyclones kicked off the last week of their last week of regular season play with a big victory over Gwynedd-Mercy on Tuesday with a 16-15 overtime over Gwynedd-Mercy. The conference game was tight from the opening draw control but a **Charlie Schmitt** goal with 30 seconds remaining gave the Cyclones the victory. The rest of the week would not go in Centenary's favor however, as they lost two big CSAC tilts against Marywood on Thursday and NDMU on Saturday. With the conference tournament less than a week away, the Cyclones will be keeping an eye on each remaining game.

GWYNEDD-MERCY COLLEGE GRIFFINS (3-12, 2-6 CSAC)

Centenary scored with 30 seconds remaining in overtime as Gwynedd-Mercy suffered a tough 15-14 loss to the Cyclones on Tuesday. **Dani Horn** scored a game-high seven goals. Goalie **Marina Hubbard** finished with 15 saves. **Danae Perrymond** and **Amy Powell** totaled three scores and an assist apiece. The Griffins fell at King's, 17-6, Thursday night. GM got three goals from Perrymond, two from Horn and one from **Casey Gaughan**. Marywood used a late goal to go on and defeat Gwynedd-Mercy on Saturday in a CSAC matchup. **Jenna Gaydosh** finished with a team-high six points on three goals and two assists. Horn and **Danae Perrymond** also had three tallies each. The Griffins will close out the 2013 season with a road match-up at Drew University on Tuesday starting a 6 p.m.

IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (8-6, 4-3 CSAC)

Immaculata faced off with the top two teams in the CSAC this past week and came away with two defeats ... Against Cabrini, **Allison Jakavick** and **Katie Cook** scored three goals each, but it was not enough to get past the Cavaliers ... Against Neumann, Cook (4 G, 2 A) and **Kelly Lapp** (3 G) led the offense, but Neumann was too much in handing the Mighty Macs their second defeat of the week ... Immaculata will wrap up their CSAC schedule tonight against Notre Dame ... With a win tonight, the Mighty Macs will lock up the number four seed in the CSAC playoffs and host Notre Dame again this coming Saturday in the CSAC quarterfinals ... Immaculata will play Bryn Mawr tomorrow in a non-league contest.



MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY PACERS (6-7, 6-2 CSAC)

Marywood extended its winning streak to four games with conference wins over Centenary and Gwynedd-Mercy... **Kimberly Commisso** set a program record with 17 ground balls, smashing the previous record of 10 ground balls, in a 16-5 victory over the Cyclones Thursday. **Sarah Caughy** led the Pacers with seven goals, and **Leigha Dolcemascolo** made eight saves for the victory... Commisso scored a game-winning goal with 42 seconds remaining to top Gwynedd-Mercy 15-14 on Saturday. Commisso scored six goals on six shots... Before it begins the CSAC playoffs as the No. 3 seed, Marywood finishes its regular season schedule against No. 12 Susquehanna on Wednesday.

NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS (13-4, 7-1 CSAC)

Neumann (13-4, 7-1) won two games this week against Immaculata and Cedar Crest, while dropping a game to No. 9 TCNJ. **Rebecca Dolenti** led the Knights with eight goals and one assist on the week. The win against Immaculata on Friday sealed a No. 2 seed in the CSAC and they get a first round bye in the CSAC playoffs.

NOTRE DAME OF MD. UNIVERSITY GATORS (7-5, 4-3 CSAC)

Secured CSAC Conference Tournament appearance with conference victories over Rosemont and Centenary...Senior **Alli Terry** recorded 22 goals during the week...Terry became the school's all-time goals scored leader in Wednesday's win over Hood College by scoring her 250th goal, and has improved her mark to 264 career goals...Senior **Molly Murray** notched her 100th career goal in Wednesday's win...sophomore goalkeeper **Mary Briggs** returned to goal to gain eight saves in her first appearance in nearly a month...team will face Immaculata University Monday afternoon, winner will host the other Saturday for the first round of the CSAC Conference Tournament.
