CSAC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Madsen became Centenary's All-Time leader in both saves and complete game shutouts this past week after recording a 1.10 ERA with eight strikeouts in her four games played. With a 2-0 record on the week, Madsen only allowed two runs while holding opponents to a .217 batting average.

CSAC HONOR ROLL

Keystone's **Karissa Worobey** (Scranton, PA/Scranton) in four starts, posted a 3-1 record with three complete games and allowed just six earned runs while striking out 17 batters. In Keystone's 3-2 win over Centenary on Saturday, the sophomore allowed just three runs while striking out seven as the Giants clinched the sixth and final berth in the CSAC playoffs.

Baptist Bible's **Karin Mowry** (South Auburn, PA/Elk Lake High School) went 15-for-21 from the plate, hitting .714, with 9 RBI's and 11 runs scored from the lead off spot. On Saturday, in her team's double header with Notre Dame of Maryland University, the senior had a perfect offensive day, getting 9 hits in 9 plate appearances. The shortstop had 4 RBI's and scored 7 runs.



AROUND THE CSAC

BAPTIST BIBLE COLLEGE DEFENDERS

On Monday, the Lady Defenders split with Cairn University, winning game one 9-4 and then losing a slug fest 15-19. In a makeup game, Keystone College downed BBC on Tuesday 2-10. The Lady Defenders split on their final two games of the season, as they took down Notre Dame of Maryland University 14-6 and then turned around and loss 9-10.

CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS

The Cavaliers completed their regular season on a high note as the Blue and White won their final four games to improve to 13-9 in league play. For the second consecutive season, Cabrini narrowly missed qualifying for the CSAC postseason tournament. Sophomore **Steph Diegel** hit .571 on the week with 3 doubles and 5 RBI. Senior **Marcell Crist** allowed three earned runs in 19 innings last week, topping Marywood 9-2 and Cedar Crest 9-1.

CAIRN UNIVERSITY HIGHLANDERS

The Highlanders earned their second CSAC win this past week with a 19-15 win over Baptist Bible in the nightcap of a doubleheader. **Kristen Hubler** went 4 for 6 with 3 RBIs while **Kelly Hendrickson** went 3 for 5 with 3 runs and 3 RBIs. Hendrickson also earned the win, her fourth of the season, going to full seven innings. Later in the week, Cairn were swept in two doubleheaders against non-conference Eastern University and CSAC rivals Rosemont College.

CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS

The Falcons finish their season 10-18 overall and 8-14 in the conference. **Shannon Wenner** finishes her junior season batting .388 with 3 home runs, and teammate **Jeniffer Hallowell** finished with an even .400 batting average with 7 doubles, 1 triple and a homer.

CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES

The Cyclones had a big week to close out the regular season, winning five of their last six games including three in conference to secure their spot in the 2013 CSAC Tournament. Although the Cyclones will not be hosting this year, the two-time defending champions are looking for a big set of road victories to bring home their third consecutive title under Head Coach Kim Broking.

AROUND THE CSAC



GWYNEDD-MERCY COLLEGE GRIFFINS

Gwynedd-Mercy pounded out 35 hits in sweeping Cedar Crest on Wednesday in CSAC action. The Griffins took game one, 7-0, and exploded for a 22-0 win in game two. In game one, **Kaitlyn Johnson** went the distance, striking out four. Offensively, **Kelsey McDonough** and **Megan Kelly** each had three hits apiece. Kelly was a home run shy of the cycle. Game two saw the bats come alive for 22 runs on 21 hits, sparked by **Ashley Lamont** who was 4-for-4 with four runs, two homers, a double, and seven RBIs. McDonough also was 4-for-4 with four runs and three driven in and a home run. The Griffins capped their regular season on Saturday with two losses to Immaculata. Gwynedd clinched the #4 playoff seed and will host a first-round game on Wednesday, May 1st against #5 Marywood.

IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS

Immaculata went 3-3 overall last week, with two of its losses coming to the tournament's top-seed Neumann. Immaculata swept its final regular-season CSAC twinbill Saturday at Gwynedd-Mercy to claim the No. 2 seed in the CSAC Tournament. The Mighty Macs clinched the bye into the weekend's championship round with 5-4 and 7-4 victories against the Griffins. Immaculata has never entered the conference tournament seeded as high as No. 2. The Mighty Macs were seeded third in 2011, and entered the tournament as the No. 5 seed in 2009 when they finished as runner-up.

KEYSTONE COLLEGE GIANTS

Kaitlyn Sawicki went 3-3 with four RBIs including a two-run home run on Tuesday to lift Keystone to a 10-2 win over Baptist Bible College. **Samantha Hartman** scored three runs while **Karissa Worobey** struck out three in a complete game to earn her 12th win of the season. **Katie Marro** went 4-7 with four runs scored and **Sara Schraden** went 6-8 with four RBIs to lead Keystone to a doubleheader sweep at Cedar Crest on Friday. Worobey and Schraden both picked up complete game wins on the afternoon. The Giants clinched the sixth and final playoff berth on Saturday with a 3-2 win over Centenary College. Trailing 2-0 heading into the bottom of the seventh, **Lisa Ostrander** doubled home the Giants first run before **Stephanie Puckett** delivered a two-run walkoff single to lock up Keystone's playoff berth.

AROUND THE CSAC

MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY PACERS

After starting the week with three straight losses, Marywood clinched a berth into the CSAC post-season with a win over Neumann in the second game of the doubledheader. Marywood beat the Knights 3-2, handing Neumann their first and only loss of the CSAC regular season. Marywood will be the #5 seed and travels to #4 Gwynedd-Mercy College Wednesday.

NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS

Neumann went 4-2 overall and 3-1 in CSAC action in the last week of the regular season, coming within one game of an undefeated conference schedule. The Knights swept Immaculata to clinch the No. 1 spot in the playoffs. Neumann the split with Widener and Marywood. **Lauren Wilkie** went 2-0 from the circle. **Allie White** batted .500 while **Becca Reinhart** hit .435. **Danielle Grayson** led the Knights with six RBI and **Mariah Ripken** knocked in five. Neumann is the No. 1 seed in the playoffs and will host the Championship Tournament on Friday and Saturday.

NOTRE DAME OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY GATORS
