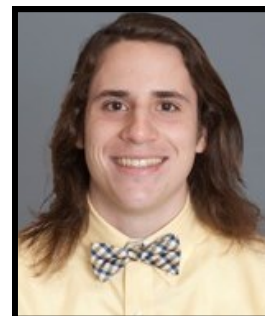

AROUND THE CSAC

CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (7-3, 1-0 CSAC)



The Cavaliers extended their win streak to 4 games with a pair of wins last week. The Blue and White opened its CSAC slate with a resounding 25-5 win at Centenary before a wire to wire 13-8 win over #12 Denison. Junior **Corey Elmer** led Cabrini with an astounding 17 points in the two games, including six assists at Centenary and 7 goals against Denison.

CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (8-1, 2-1 CSAC)



Centenary College began their week by falling from the ranks of the unbeaten as they fell 25-5 to a powerful #11 Cabrini College. The Cyclones responded however with a huge victory over Rosemont, defeating them 26-3 on Saturday. In the victory over Rosemont, the Cyclones received hat tricks from three different players, while 13 different players recorded at least one point. This upcoming week Centenary will take on Neumann and Immaculata in a pair of crucial CSAC contests.

GWYNEDD-MERCY COLLEGE GRIFFINS (5-4, 1-1 CSAC)



Gwynedd-Mercy won their third in a row after a 13-10 CSAC win over Marywood on Senior Day. Seniors **Roy Bakeoven** and **William Beck** along with freshman **Tony McCraw** all had three goals apiece to help Gwynedd defeat the Pacers for the first time during the regular season. GM outshot Marywood, 36-29, and won the groundball battle, 23-22. Goalie **Ryley O'Keefe** made eight saves. Prior to the game, the team's six seniors were honored in a special ceremony: **Mason Risner, Beck, Bakeoven, O'Keefe, Jonathan Figliola** and **Dustan Mangin**. GM resumes action on Wednesday, April 10th when they welcome Immaculata in another CSAC tilt here in a 4 p.m. start.

IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (2-7, 1-0 CSAC)



Immaculata opened the CSAC schedule on Saturday defeating Neumann, 13-12. Immaculata poured in six goals during the third quarter to erase an early deficit for the Mighty Macs. The win also marked the fifth-straight victory for the Mighty Macs opposite the Knights. Immaculata fell behind early, and trailed 9-5 at halftime. However, the Mighty Macs opened the third quarter with six straight goals to take an 11-9 lead on the Knights with 5:04 remaining. Immaculata was then able to stay a goal ahead the rest of the way. **Bhelly Bagbonon** lead the Mighty Macs with five goals and one assist for six points, and **Ben Tuscai** added five assists.



MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY PACERS (3-8, 2-1 CSAC)

Marywood University split a pair of CSAC games this week with a win against Rosemont and a loss at Gwynedd-Mercy... The Pacers broke several scoring records en route to a 19-11 victory over Rosemont Wednesday. **Riley Dobel** set a school mark with six goals, and **Dylan Swope** contributed a program-high six assists. **Sam Trill** tied a Marywood record with 11 shots... The Pacers outshot the Ravens 60-27... **Nicholas Cornella** earned his third victory of the season with four saves... In a 13-10 come-from-behind loss to the Griffins, **Nicholas Cornella** stopped 15 shots in goal. Trill and **Greg Nester** added three goals, and Swope made three assists... Marywood travels to Cabrini College Saturday in its only outing this week.



NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS (1-8, 0-2 CSAC)

Neumann (1-8, 0-2 CSAC) lost in their only game of the week to CSAC foe's Immaculata 13-12 on Saturday afternoon. The Knights scored seven goals in the first period to take a 7-2 lead. But the Mighty Macs fought back and scored six unanswered goals in the third period to take a one goal lead and they held on for the win. The Knights were led by **Ryan Eber** with four goals, two assist and five ground balls. The Knights host Centenary on Wednesday in CSAC action.



ROSEMONT COLLEGE RAVENS (1-10, 0-2 CSAC)

The 11 goals scored by Rosemont at Marywood were the most the program had scored in a game in a losing effort in the program's short history. Freshman **Stephen Licata** leads the Ravens with 24 goals and 30 points. **Will Lawlor** has 26 points from 12 goals and 14 assists.
