AROUND THE CSAC

CABRINI COLLEGE CAVALIERS (5-5, 4-0 CSAC)

The Cavaliers extended their current win streak to five games with a pair of CSAC wins. After surrendering the game's first goal, the Blue and White rattled off 14 consecutive goals, en route to an 18-5 win at Gwynedd-Mercy. Senior **Christina Pasquariello** and freshman **Katie Lasater** tallied five goals each. Cabrini scored 10 unanswered goals in the first half, as it improved to 4-0 in conference with Saturday's 19-5 win over Marywood. Lasater and sophomore **Katie Lasater** posted four goals each.

CEDAR CREST COLLEGE FALCONS (0-9, 0-5 CSAC)

Six different Falcon players scored this past weekend against Notre Dame. **Amber Wehry** finished with a hat trick against Notre Dame and the Falcons finished with 10 goals against the gators. The Falcons are playing better and their skills are continuing to improve game after game. The Falcons play both Centenary and Rosemont this upcoming week.

CENTENARY COLLEGE CYCLONES (3-6, 1-2 CSAC)

The Cyclones split this week going 1-1 in their two games. The Cyclones began their week by finally breaking their five game losing streak with an emphatic 20-5 victory over Rosemont College on Thursday. In the victory, Centenary was paced by **Arden Wright**, **Nicole Judd** and **Alysia Pinkerton** who each scored four goals. However, in the second game of the week, the Cyclones fell to Wesley College in a hard fought game. Despite the loss, the Cyclones played very tough and goalie **Andrea Senkarik** recorded a career-high 13 saves.

GWYNEDD-MERCY COLLEGE GRIFFINS (3-7, 2-2 CSAC)

Gwynedd-Mercy suffered their first conference loss of the season as Cabrini gave the Griffins an 18-5 setback Thursday night. **Dani Horn** and **Danae Perrymond** each tallied two goals apiece for the Griffins. Neumann jumped ahead early to go on and defeat Gwynedd-Mercy, 15-7, Saturday afternoon in a Colonial States Athletic Conference matchup. Perrymond had two goals for GM while Horn added a score and an assist. **Lucy Hud**, **Jill MacDonald**, **Sarah Nance** and **Brianna Greer** also registered goals for the Griffins. Goalie **Marina Hubbard** made 10 saves in net. GM will look to rebound on Tuesday when they travel to Notre Dame (Md.) in a 4 p.m. start.

IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY MIGHTY MACS (7-3, 3-0 CSAC)

Immaculata established a school-record for wins in a season already with seven thus far ... The Mighty Macs enjoyed a 3-0 week including two conference victories to improve their conference mark to 3-0 ... On Tuesday, the Mighty Macs were led by six goals from **Allison Jakavick**, a season-high for the team, in an 18-6 triumph over Lancaster Bible ... On Thursday, Immaculata cruised to a 21-2 win over Cedar Crest behind eight points from junior Katie Cook ... On Saturday, the Mighty Macs capped a great week with a 19-1 win over Rosemont ... Immaculata scored the first fifteen goals of the game to take control ... They had nine different goal scorers ... This week, Immaculata will stay in conference play with a home matchup against Marywood before travelling to Gwynedd-Mercy on Saturday.



MARYWOOD UNIVERSITY PACERS (2-7, 2-2 CSAC)

Marywood picked up its first two CSAC losses of the season, falling to Neumann and Cabrini... A 13-8 loss to Neumann Thursday snapped a 14-game regular-season CSAC winning streak that dated back to April 9, 2011. It also broke an 11-game regular-season CSAC home winning streak that goes back to a loss versus Centenary in 2010... Marywood's defense and goalkeeping held the Knights to a 2-for-10 performance on free-position attempts. **Kimberly Commisso** added six ground balls and caused five turnovers to go with two points. **Leigha Dolcemascolo** made 11 saves... Commisso scored four goals in a 19-5 loss to Cabrini on Saturday... The Pacers look to get back in the win column with a game at Immaculata Tuesday and versus Notre Dame (Md.) Saturday.

NEUMANN UNIVERSITY KNIGHTS (11-1, 5-0 CSAC)

Neumann (11-1, 5-0) won their sixth consecutive win last week with wins against CSAC opponents Marywood University 13-8 and Gwynedd-Mercy 15-7. The Knights have relied on not relying on any one person. The scoring has been spread out between the freshman and upper classmen. The team defending and goalkeeping success has been divided amongst the classes, as well. Neumann will battle with Cabrini College on Tuesday, as both teams are undefeated in conference play. The Knights will host non-conference opponents Swarthmore on Thursday.

NOTRE DAME OF MD. UNIVERSITY GATORS (3-3, 1-2 CSAC)

Opened up play after the spring break with a big 20-10 victory over Cedar Crest College...win marked teams first CSAC victory of the season...Senior **Alli Terry** (Towson, Md./Catholic) scored nine goals in a game for the second time of her career...Terry also notched an assist...Senior **Molly Murray** (Aberdeen, Md.) scored four goals while sophomore **Brittany Peddicord** (Timonium, Md./Dulaney) scored three goals and an assist...senior **Emily Langton** recorded five saves in her first start of the season in goal.

ROSEMONT COLLEGE RAVENS (0-9, 0-5 CSAC)

The Ravens avoided being shut out by the Mighty Macs thanks to a free-position shot from **Powell Davis** on Saturday. This week's schedule has one home non-conference game against the Scarlet Raptors of Rutgers-Camden on Tuesday and a CSAC contest at Cedar Crest in Allentown on Thursday.
